**DEFINITIONS**

**Annulment:**

Retrospective and prospective cancellation of the practitioner's authorization to practice.

**Conditions:**

A term used to indicate restrictions, requirements, or limitations placed on the practitioner.

**Consent Order:**

An order of the Board stating an agreement between the Board and the practitioner regarding the annulment, revocation, suspension, or surrender of authorization to practice, or the conditions placed on authorization to practice, or other action taken by the Board relative to the practitioner. (A method for resolving a dispute without a formal hearing.)

**Denial:**

Decision denying an application for practice authorization or reconsideration of a Board action.

**Dismissal:**

Board action dismissing a contested case.

**Inactive Medical License:**

To be "active," a medical license must be registered on or near the physician's birthday each year. By not registering his or her license, the physician allows the license to become "inactive." The holder of an inactive license may *not* practice medicine in North Carolina. Licensees will often elect this status when they retire or do not intend to practice in the state. (Not related to the "voluntary surrender" noted below.)

**NA:**

Information not available or not applicable.

**NCPHP:**

North Carolina Physicians Health Program.

**Public Letter of Concern:**

A letter in the public record expressing the Board's concern about a practitioner's behavior or performance. Concern has not risen to the point of requiring a formal proceeding but should be known by the public. If the practitioner requests a formal disciplinary hearing regarding the conduct leading to the letter of concern, the letter will be vacated and a formal complaint and hearing initiated.

**Reentry Agreement**

Arrangement between the Board and a practitioner in good standing who is "inactive" and has been out of clinical practice for two years or more. Permits the practitioner to resume active practice through a reentry program approved by the Board to assure the practitioner's competence.

**RTL:**

Resident Training License. (Issued to those in post-graduate medical training who have not yet qualified for a full medical license.)

**Revocation:**

Cancellation of authorization to practice. Authorization may not be reissued for at least two years.

**Stay:**

Full or partial stopping or halting of a legal action, such as suspension, on certain stipulated grounds.

**Summary Suspension:**

Immediate withdrawal of authorization to practice prior to the initiation of further proceedings, which are to begin within a reasonable time. (Ordered when the Board finds the public health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action.)

**Suspension:**

Withdrawal of authorization to practice for a stipulated period of time or indefinitely.

**Temporary/Dated License:**

License to practice for a specific period of time. Often accompanied by conditions contained in a Consent Order. May be issued as an element of a Board or Consent Order or subsequent to the expiration of a previously issued temporary license.

**Voluntary Surrender:**

The practitioner's relinquishing of authorization to practice pending or during an investigation. Surrender does not preclude the Board bringing charges against the practitioner. (Not related to the "inactive" medical license noted above.)

#### **GRAY, Michael Allen, MD**

Location: Morehead City, NC (Carteret Co) | DOB: 09/27/1956  
License #: 0000-28198 | Specialty: GP (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: University of Texas at Houston (1983)  
Cause: Dr. Gray admitted to the Board that he is suffering from depression and manic episodes and that he is unable to remember the last few weeks of his life. In email correspondence, Dr. Gray indicated to the Board that he intended to surrender his medical license. This was not done, and Dr. Gray has declined to be available to the Board. The Board received numerous complaints from Dr. Gray's patients that they are unable to contact Dr. Gray or have been unable to retrieve their medical records. This constitutes patient abandonment, as well as failure to make adequate provision to ensure availability or transfer of medical records and failure to ensure continuity of medical care.  
Action: 07/28/2008. Summary suspension of NC medical license.

#### **BECKER, Robert Lee, MD**

Location: Rockville, Md. | DOB: 10/26/1950  
License#: 0000-27425 | Specialty: Pathology (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: Duke University School of Medicine (1979)  
Cause: Dr. Becker has not practiced clinical medicine since 2004, and he let his North Carolina license lapse when he failed to renew it in January 2007. In May 2008, Dr. Becker appeared before the Board for an interview

to discuss his application for reinstatement of his license. He has no present plans to return to the clinical practice of medicine.

Action: 08/19/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Becker is granted a limited administrative license and required to limit his practice to administrative medicine only.

**BLOCK, Matthew, MD**

Location: Laurinburg, NC (Scotland Co) | DOB: 05/29/1964

License#: 2001-00308 | Specialty: CD (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: New York University (1990)

Cause: A NC Division of Public Health Investigation linked an outbreak of hepatitis C to possible unsafe medical practices during myocardial perfusion studies, or nuclear stress tests. Seven patients who had nuclear stress tests at Dr. Block's practice tested positive for hepatitis C.

Action: 08/28/2008. Interim consent order executed. Dr. Block's practice is restricted to exclude invasive office-based procedures, including but not limited to nuclear stress tests. Dr. Block shall also supervise the drawing of blood and enforce the use of standard precautions.

**COFIELD, Trina Lashawn, MD**

Location: Greenville, NC (Pitt Co) | DOB: 02/11/1971

License#: NA - RTL | Specialty: IM (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: Howard University College of Medicine (2003)

Cause: Dr. Cofield served as a resident physician at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center from June 2004 to March 2005. In April 2005, the Colorado Board of Medical Examiners issued an order of suspension regarding Dr. Cofield's training license. The suspension was based on allegations that Dr. Cofield failed to meet generally accepted standards of medical practice. The Colorado Board lifted the suspension on Nov. 17, 2005. Dr. Cofield was also issued a letter of admonition by the Colorado Board outlining the Board's concerns about Dr. Cofield's performance. Dr. Cofield applied for a NC resident training license on April 18, 2008, to allow her to participate in the training program in internal medicine at Pitt County Memorial Hospital. Dr. Cofield has interviewed with a subcommittee of the Board to discuss her public record in Colorado and alleged performance issues.

Action: 08/18/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Cofield is issued a resident training license.

**COOPER, Joseph Litton, MD**

Location: Kenansville, NC (Forsyth Co) | DOB: 12/15/1969

License#: 0097-00907 | Specialty: OB/GYN (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: Tulane School of Medicine (1996)

Cause: A Board review of patient medical records concluded that Dr. Cooper's care of two laboring mothers fell below accepted and prevailing standards of care, resulting in injuries and complications in the mothers and their babies. Dr. Cooper denies that his care and treatment of one of the laboring mothers fell below the standard, however he agrees the Board has sufficient information from which it could conclude otherwise. Dr. Cooper agreed with an independent review of his practice that concluded, although these two incidents were isolated events, his workload was greater than can be reasonably sustained by a solo practitioner. Effective Sept. 1, Dr. Cooper will provide office-based prenatal and gynecological services and retain his gynecologic privileges at Pender Memorial Hospital. Dr. Cooper resigned his hospital privileges at Duplin General Hospital effective August 31.

Action: 07/18/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Cooper's license is suspended for 12 months, but stayed immediately. He is placed on probation and must comply with terms and conditions.

**CRUMP, Carolyn Faydene, MD**

Location: Lexington, NC (Davidson Co) | DOB: 01/27/1950

License#: 2005-01115 | Specialty: GP (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: George Washington University School of Medicine (1976)

Cause: Dr. Crump entered into a consent order with the Board in June 2005 that specified the terms of her reentry into the active practice of medicine after a number of years out of active clinical practice.

Action: 08/25/2008. Amendment to consent order executed. Dr. Crump's order is amended to allow her to work 30 hours a week provided she has coverage by her supervising physician.

**DRUCKER, Michael Stuart, MD**

Location: Jacksonville, Fla. | DOB: 11/25/1942  
License#: 2008-01183 | Specialty: FP (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: Boston University School of Medicine (1969)  
Cause: In August 1990, while practicing in Florida, Dr. Drucker entered into a stipulated order with the Florida Board of Medicine wherein he neither admitted nor denied that he owned a smoking-cessation clinic that he inadequately supervised. In that order, he agreed to pay a fine, accept a reprimand and be monitored by another physician. Dr. Drucker disclosed this action in a recent application for a NC medical license.  
Action: 07/09/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Drucker shall be issued a NC medical license, with a reprimand in response to his Florida Board action.

**GARLISI, Andrew Peter, MD**

Location: Ohio | DOB: 06/30/1954  
License#: 2008-01333 | Specialty: EM/IM (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: Medical University of Toledo, Ohio (1978)  
Cause: Dr. Garlisi submitted an application for a North Carolina medical license that did not disclose the fact that he was admonished and fined in 1983 by the Florida Board of Medicine for failing to return his medical license renewal form in a timely manner. Dr. Garlisi reports the form was not sent to the correct address. Dr. Garlisi met with members of the Board in March 2008 and satisfied the Board at that time that he did not understand the need to report the event.  
Action: 07/24/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Garlisi is issued a full and unrestricted license, with a reprimand.

**GREGORY, Ginger Dobbins, PA**

Location: Fuquay-Varina, NC (Wake Co)| DOB: 08/30/1963  
License#: 0001-01410  
PA Education: Wake Forest University, Bowman Gray School of Medicine (1991)  
Cause: Ms. Gregory entered into a consent order with the Board in April 1998 to address substance abuse concerns. Ms. Gregory completed three months of inpatient treatment and seven months of a three-quarter-time program. She also participated with the NCPHP and was compliant with that program. However, since 2004, Ms. Gregory tested positive for alcohol consumption. Ms. Gregory denies that she has relapsed but admits that the Board has evidence from which it could conclude otherwise.  
Action: 07/25/2008. Consent order executed. Ms. Gregory's PA license is indefinitely suspended, but the action is immediately stayed provided she comply with conditions.

**KINZIE, Daniel Harpine, IV, MD**

Location: Midland, Tex. | DOB: 07/08/1935  
License#: 0000-26113 | Specialty: FP/EM (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: University of California, Los Angeles (1961)  
Cause: Dr. Kinzie entered into a mediated agreed order with the Texas Medical Board that placed certain restrictions on his Texas medical license. Those conditions included requiring Dr. Kinzie to successfully complete a medical record-keeping course and requiring that Dr. Kinzie's medical practice be monitored by a physician monitor.  
Action: 07/15/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Kinzie is placed on probation for one year under the conditions agreed upon in the Texas order.

**LANGLEY, Dawn Tracy, PA**

Location: Lumberton, NC (Robeson Co)| DOB: 11/18/1965  
License#: 0001-02637  
PA Education: Wake Forest University (1998)  
Cause: Ms. Langley did not register her PA license as required by law, causing the Board to place her license on inactive status effective February 6, 2008. On her application for reactivation Ms. Langley falsely answered "No" to a question that asked whether she had ever had privileges limited, suspended, placed on probation, etc. by any facility where she has been on staff. In 2000, Ms. Langley was put on probation and later terminated from her position at a hospital.  
Action: 08/08/2008. Consent order executed. Ms. Langley is reprimanded. Her PA license is reinstated effective the date of this order.

**LOZEVSKI, Jonathan Leonid, MD**

Location: Chapel Hill, NC (Orange Co) | DOB: 07/12/1974  
License#: 2006-00451 | Specialty: Radiology (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: University of Arizona College of Medicine (2003)  
Cause: Dr. Lozevski suffers from neuropathy of the leg, for which he is under the care of a physician. On two occasions, Dr. Lozevski altered a prescription given to him by another physician, adding pain medicine that the prescribing physician did not authorize. Dr. Lozevski then took this medicine seeking relief from pain. In 2008 Dr. Lozevski self-referred to the NCPHP seeking help with his use of pain relievers. He had completed a 16-week residential treatment program.  
Action: 08/21/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Lozevski's license is suspended for two years. However, the action is immediately stayed and Dr. Lozevski is placed on probation and subject to conditions.

**MENDOZA, Stephen Victor, MD**

Location: Charlotte, NC (Mecklenburg Co) | DOB: 02/05/1969  
License#: 2002-00573 | Specialty: A (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: University of Texas Health Sciences (1994)  
Cause: Dr. Mendoza failed to disclose a history of alcohol abuse on his application for a North Carolina medical license. He also did not disclose, when expressly asked on license application and renewal forms, three prior arrests, including a 1987 arrest for driving while intoxicated and a 1997 arrest for public intoxication. The third arrest, for disorderly conduct/engaging in fighting, occurred in January 2006.  
Action: 07/18/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Mendoza's license is suspended for two years. However, the action is immediately stayed except for a period of 60 days beginning on Sept. 1, 2008, and ending on October 30, 2008. Dr. Mendoza must also comply with conditions.

**PAUL, Robert Allen, Jr., PA-C**

Location: Raleigh, NC (Wake Co) | DOB: 12/28/1968  
License#: 0001-02781  
PA Education: Rutgers University (1996)  
Cause: Mr. Paul was arrested by the Raleigh Police Department on June 13, 2008, on evidence that he had forged prescriptions for Vicodin in the names of patients who were seen at his place of employment. Mr. Paul, who suffers from alcohol and substance dependency, then diverted the drugs obtained for personal use. Mr. Paul surrendered his PA license on June 13, 2008.  
Action: 08/12/2008. Consent order executed. Mr. Paul's license is indefinitely suspended.

**PENDERGRAFT, James Scott, MD**

Location: Orlando, Fla. | DOB: 07/04/1957  
License#: 0000-28301 | Specialty: OB/GYN (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: Meharry Medical College (1982)  
Cause: On August 10, 2006, the Florida Board of Medicine issued an emergency order suspending Dr. Pendergraft's Florida medical license, alleging that Dr. Pendergraft performed a third trimester abortion in violation of Florida law. Allegations against Dr. Pendergraft were presented at an administrative hearing, which resulted in a final order that was adverse to Dr. Pendergraft. That order is now on appeal.  
Action: 07/09/2008. Interim consent order executed. Dr. Pendergraft agrees that he shall not practice medicine in North Carolina without prior written approval from the Board.

**ROSENFELD, Jeffrey, MD**

Location: Charlotte, NC (Mecklenburg Co) | DOB: 05/03/1957  
License#: 0098-00375 | Specialty: N (as reported by physician)  
Medical Ed: University of Maryland (1990)  
Cause: Dr. Rosenfeld performed physical exams on some of his medical students for the stated purpose of providing them with additional instruction on neurological exams and incorporating neurologic examinations into physical exams. Dr. Rosenfeld denies any intentional contact of an inappropriate nature, but acknowledges that such exams are not common practice and regrets that any student may have felt uncomfortable during the examinations.

Action: 07/18/2008. Consent order executed. All charges previously issued against Dr. Rosenfeld, including those charges that he engaged in performing student exams for personal gratification, are dismissed. Dr. Rosenfeld is reprimanded.

**VILLAREAL, Andrea Currin, PA**

Location: Sanford, NC (Lee Co)| DOB: 11/24/1975

License#: 0001-03377

PA Education: East Carolina University (2001)

Cause: Ms. Villareal has applied for reissuance of her PA license, which became inactive on March 14, 2007 after she failed to register her license as required by law. Ms. Villareal continued to practice as a PA until May 22, 2008. An audit of Ms. Villareal's practice also found that she was out of compliance with requirements that her license number appear on prescription blanks, and that she have a written policy in place for periodic review of written instructions for prescribing.

Action: 08/21/2008. Consent order executed. Ms. Villareal's PA license is reinstated. However, her license is suspended from May 22, 2008, until the date this order is executed.

**WARD, Amy Elizabeth, MD**

Location: Pfafftown, NC (Forsyth Co) | DOB: 09/19/1969

License #: 0096-00833 | Specialty: Allergy and Immunology (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: Bowman Gray School of Medicine (1995)

Cause: Dr. Ward, who has a history of substance abuse, surrendered her medical license in April 2005. Her license was indefinitely suspended by the Board in October 2005. Dr. Ward met with a committee of the Board in May 2008 to discuss her re-entry into the practice of medicine. She has completed inpatient treatment and has signed a contract with NCPHP. Additionally, she has agreed to a comprehensive plan of re-entry to ensure her safe transition back into active practice.

Action: 07/30/2008. Temporary medical license issued.

**ZASLOW, Ely David, MD**

Location: Waynesville, NC (Haywood Co) | DOB: 02/13/1954

License#: 0000-30885 | Specialty: FM (as reported by physician)

Medical Ed: University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill (1985)

Cause: Dr. Zaslow worked as an independent contractor for two corporations that render telemedicine services to patients in North Carolina. During that time, Dr. Zaslow issued a limited number of prescriptions, including a few prescriptions for controlled substances, without performing a physical examination or any prior physician-patient relationship. On advice from the telemedicine companies, Dr. Zaslow believed a telephone evaluation and subsequent prescriptions were consistent with the Board's position. They are not. One telemedicine company's manner of compensating Dr. Zaslow involved splitting fees collected from patients, which is also in violation of Board positions.

Action: 07/18/2008. Consent order executed. Dr. Zaslow's license is suspended for 30 days; however, the suspension is stayed provided he comply with conditions. For example, he must complete CME in prescription writing.

Cause: The Board is concerned that Mr. Chance obtained advanced degrees from an Internet diploma mill wherein individuals pay money and obtain degrees without doing any meaningful or legitimate academic work. Mr. Chance then listed the advanced degrees on a resume he submitted in an attempt to obtain employment. The Board is also concerned that Mr. Chance submitted an intent to practice form that listed two putative supervising physicians without first obtaining permission from those physicians.  
Action: 07/07/2008. Public letter of concern issued.

### **CHAUVIN, Robert Silas, Jr., PA**

Location: Burlington, NC (Alamance Co)| DOB: 09/04/1951  
License#: 0001-00869  
PA Education: Duke University (1985)  
Cause: The Board is concerned that Mr. Chauvin's care of a patient who presented with a swollen and painful ankle fell below the standard of care. Mr. Chauvin diagnosed the patient with gouty arthritis and prescribed steroids to treat inflammation. The following day the patient was seen in a hospital emergency room, where the patient was diagnosed with necrotizing fasciitis, necessitating an emergency above-the-knee amputation. The incident led a malpractice payment to be made on Mr. Chauvin's behalf.

Cause: The Board reviewed an action taken in 1994 against Dr. Cutler's Pennsylvania medical license, whereby Dr. Cutler was fined for slapping an uncooperative patient upon whom he was attempting to perform a physical examination.

However, the Board is concerned about some aspects of the care Dr. Philips provided these 10 patients, many of whom were terminally ill and had chronic, co-morbid medical problems. Dr. Philips has agreed to take appropriate CME courses.
