Denney, Investigator; Mr. Don Pittman, Investigator; and Sibyl Lamoreaux, Secretary.

Oscar Sanchez Cunanan, M.D., Cary, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that the proper procedures be instituted to prefer charges against Oscar Sanchez Cunanan, M.D., that he be so notified in writing, and that he be advised he will be given a hearing on such charges that will be presented against him.

Robert Earl Williford, M.D., Asheboro, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that the proper procedures be instituted to prefer charges against Robert Earl Williford, M.D., that he be so notified in writing, and that he be advised he will be given a hearing on such charges that will be presented against him.

Lloyd Damsey, M.D., Bristol, Tennessee

The Board adopted a motion that, unless this physician makes a definite decision to move to North Carolina to practice medicine at a specific site, no action be taken on his application for licensure; and that, if Dr. Damsey decides to practice medicine at a specific site in North Carolina, his application be re-activated at that time.

Nashiha Ahmad, M.D., Durham, North Carolina

The Executive Secretary presented to the Board this physician's request that the document with her photograph affixed be returned to her. The Board adopted a motion that her photograph be returned and that her furnishing the Board with the photograph will satisfy the photographic requirement for the North Carolina examination FLEX.

Henderson County Surgical Associates, P.A. - Proposed Corporation Name

The Board reviewed a request from this professional corporation to utilize a proposed corporation name. The Board adopted a motion that this proposed name not be approved because it is too similar to Hendersonville Surgical Associates, P.A., and that the other proposed names not be approved because they are too broad and do not indicate the geographical location of this practice.

Data Request from Elaine Martin, Durham, North Carolina

The Board reviewed a data request from this individual. The Board adopted a motion that this request not be approved and that Elaine Martin be informed that the Roster of Registered Physicians should be available at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Data Request from Respiratory Home Care, Incorporated, Raleigh, North Carolina

The Board reviewed a data request from this organization and adopted a motion that this request not be approved.

DEA Verifications

The Board reviewed information indicating that DEA no longer completes routine DEA inquiries. The Board adopted a motion that a question asking whether an applicant knows of any information that has caused an investigation to be instigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration be added to the routine questions for licensure, that requests for DEA verification still be sent, and that a record be maintained of inquiries to which no reply has been received.

Commentary Revisions

The Executive Secretary discussed reprinting the Commentary. The Board adopted a motion that the revised version apply to physician extenders and that it not be reprinted until the nurse practitioner supervision guidelines have been formulated.

Proposed Rewording for Approved Formulary Regarding Refills

The Board reviewed proposed rewording for the Approved Formulary. The Board adopted a motion that the wording: "A prescription may not indicate a refill. Every prescription must be entered on the patient's chart. A second prescription for the same medication may be authorized by telephone and must be entered on the patient's chart and countersigned by the physician within 72 hours. Amount of drug can be no more than 100 dosage units or a one month supply" replace the second and third paragraphs under "Other Criteria" on the Approved Formulary.

James Donald Thullen, D.O., Chapel Hill, North Carolina

The Board reviewed a request from Dr. Thullen. The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Thullen be sent a letter confirming the previous letter and stating that the Board cannot add to its letter of December 20, 1979.

Restricting Number of Physician Extenders a Physician May Supervise

The Board adopted a motion that the Executive Secretary with the advice of the Board's attorney compose a letter to Tom Adams stating that the Board is planning either by regulation or legislation to impose a limitation of two upon the number of physician extenders who may be supervised by one physician. The Board adopted a further motion that Audrey Rogers be written a letter requesting that she supply twenty-five copies of "Recommendations for Nurse Practitioners Applying for Approval to Practice in North Carolina" and that, when these publications are received, copies be sent to all Board members.

Questions from the Attorney General Regarding Practice of Chiropractic

The Board reviewed questions from the Attorney General regarding the practice of chiropractic. The Board adopted a motion that the Attorney General be written the following letter:

At its recent meeting on August 22, 1981, the Board of Medical Examiners considered your letter of August 6 requesting an opinion concerning the practice of chiropractic.

It is the opinion of the Board that each of the questions posed in your letter should be answered in the negative.

The members of the Board of Medical Examiners are of the opinion that the penetration of the human body for the purpose of withdrawing blood, the withdrawal of blood from the human body, and the interpretation of the results of a chemical analysis of human blood constitutes the practice of medicine which is not within the scope of the practice of

not in chiro
scope of practice*



chiropractic, as defined by the General Statutes and the chiropractic exemption in G.S. 90-18 (10), and that no scientific or legal basis exists to support a contention that a chemical analysis of human blood might be used by a chiropractor "within the limited scope of chiropractic."

In support of these opinions, the members of the Board also expressed the following opinions: A chemical analysis of the content of human blood has no scientific significance in determining the existence or non-existence of a misalignment or so-called subluxation of the human spine or the so-called effect of such a condition upon the nerves of other portions of the human body. The expression to a patient of the significance of the results of an analysis of the contents of human blood would not be within the scope of chiropractic as defined by our General Statutes.

Heriberto Alfredo Ferrari, M.D., Charlotte, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that the license which Dr. Ferrari voluntarily surrendered be returned to him and that the previous action of the Board regarding instituting the proper procedures to prefer charges against Dr. Ferrari be re-affirmed.

Alfred Lee Coles, M.D., Statesville, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Coles' license be reinstated, that the proper procedures be instituted to prefer charges against Alfred Lee Coles, M.D., that he be so notified in writing, and that he be advised he will be given a hearing on such charges that will be presented against him, and that Dr. Coles be sent the charges preferred against him at the same time he is notified of the reinstatement of his license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina.

Steven Edmunds Bentley, M.D., Whiteville, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that its previous action to institute the proper procedures to prefer charges against Steven Edmunds Bentley, M.D., be re-affirmed.

The Board adopted a motion that these applications be approved with the exception of Marion White, EMT-I, Barbara Overby, EMT-I, and Robert Kelly, MICN; that these three applications not be approved because they lack educational course records, and that these applications be completed prior to presentation for the Board's consideration.

Tom Adams' Concerns

The Board adopted a motion that the Board's Attorney convey the Board's wishes to Tom Adams concerning the possibility of forming an "umbrella" or "super" Board. The Board adopted a further motion that Mr. Adams be advised the Board will be glad to discuss this matter with him but the Board is opposed to this concept and considers its function is to regulate the practice of medicine not to regulate other health professions.

Temporary Licenses

Elmer R. Cano, M.D. - granted temporary license limited to the Radiation/Oncology Department at Duke Medical Center, to include the VA Hospital in Durham, North Carolina, for a period of one year.



Letter of Appreciation to be Written to Audrey Booth, R.N.

The Board adopted a motion that Ms. Booth be written a letter to be signed by the President of the Board expressing the Board's appreciation for her years of dedicated service as a member of the Joint Subcommittee.

August, 1982, Board Meeting

The Board adopted a motion that this meeting be held August 12, 13, 14, and 15, 1982, at the Hyatt House in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

Location and Dates of 1982 Federation Meeting

The Executive Secretary reported to the Board that this meeting will be held in New Orleans, Louisiana, on May 13-16, 1982.

Donald Ralph Coffman, M.D., Norlina, North Carolina

A continuation of a hearing was held at the Hyatt House, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, at 1:00 p.m., Friday, August 21, 1981, at which hearing Dr. Coffman did appear and was represented by counsel. The Board adopted a motion that a decision on Dr. Coffman's hearing be postponed, and that he be requested to appear before the Board at the October, 1981, Board meeting.

Statement of Rights

The Board adopted a motion that the first time a physician appears for an informal interview before the Board a statement of rights be read to the individual except in instances when the Board wishes to make an exception to this policy.

Harold R. Hoke, M.D., Charlotte, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that the proper procedures be instituted to prefer charges against Harold R. Hoke, M.D., that he be so notified in writing, and that he be advised he will be given a hearing on such charges that will be presented against him.

Gyan H. Kej, M.D., Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina

Dr. Blackmon reported to the Board that he had been working with Dr. Kej, that Dr. Kej has been learning about problem-oriented record keeping, that he has made an effort to begin dictating entries on patient records, that Dr. Kej has been striving to improve his penmanship, and that Dr. Blackmon and Dr. Kej have been in frequent contact. The Board adopted a motion that this report be accepted as information.

Emergency Medical Services

Dr. Baker and Mr. Eddinger appeared before the Board to discuss mutual concerns. The Board adopted a motion that the office of Emergency Medical Services make whatever arrangements are necessary to hold a hearing on (1) a proposed amendment to Mobile Intensive Care Rules and Regulations to allow either Esophageal Obturator Airways or Esophageal Gastric Tube Airways to be utilized at the discretion of the individual Medical Directors, (2) a proposed amendment to the Mobile Intensive Care Rules and Regulations to allow the Board of Medical Examiners to authorize study projects involving exceptions to the rules and regulations, and (3) a proposed amendment to the Mobile Intensive Care Rules and Regulations stating that when a physician is in attendance his orders take precedence over all EMS protocol within the limits of the current regulations. The Board adopted a further motion that this hearing be held before the October, 1981, Board meeting and that Dr.



Sullivan preside as hearing officer. The Board also adopted a motion that EMS, Dr. Baker, and the Director of the EMS Program be instructed to promulgate a directive to all EMS personnel stating that when a physician is in attendance his orders take precedence over all EMS protocol within the limits of current regulations, that this directive be approved by the Board and prepared for Dr. Baker's signature, and that copies of the directive be sent to medical directors of all programs, regional and area medical directors, and to the presiding officers of all local medical societies. The Board adopted a motion that it interprets "in attendance" as meaning acceptance of responsibility on the part of a physician for an individual as a patient. The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Baker be requested to develop a proposed drug list to be utilized by EMS personnel for the Board's consideration at the October, 1981, Board meeting. The Board adopted a further motion that the office of EMS be requested to report to the Board at its October, 1981, meeting on the implementation of House Bill 1223.
