MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Charles H. Duckett, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina called this meeting to order at 8:45 p.m., at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; David S. Citron, M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; F. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D., and Mrs. Martha Kirkland Walston.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Don Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robbie Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; Leslie Newton; and Sibyl Lamoreaux.

TAYLOR, Everette Lester, JR., M.D., Sparta, North Carolina

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Alexander that, in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, N.C. Gen. Stat. Sec. 150B-3(c), the Board summarily suspend the license to practice medicine in North Carolina previously issued to Everette Lester Taylor, Jr., M.D.

The Board of Medical Examiners directed that the Notice of Charges and Allegations and Summary Suspension be served on Dr. Taylor as soon as possible.

DAVIS, Gary Randolph, M.D., Tulsa, Oklahoma

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board prefer charges against Gary Randolph Davis, M.D., based on the action of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners; that the Board of Medical Examiners offer Dr. Davis the opportunity to sign a Consent Order based on the conditions stipulated by the Oklahoma Board; and

that this Consent Order also contain the stipulation that Dr. Davis notify the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in this state so that the Board may schedule an informal interview with Dr. Davis.

GOBER, Henry Fred, M.D., Atlanta, Georgia

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board prefer charges against Henry Fred Gober, M.D., based on the action of the Georgia Board of Medical Examiners; that the Board of Medical Examiners offer Dr. Gober the opportunity to sign a Consent Order based on the conditions stipulated by the Georgia Board; and that this Consent Order also contain the stipulation that Dr. Gober notify the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in this state so that the Board may schedule an informal interview with him.

MAERCKS, Ralph Owen, M.D., Coconut Grove, Florida

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board offer Dr. Maercks the opportunity to surrender his license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina.

REECE, Donald Brooks, II., M.D., Morehead City, North Carolina

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board write a letter to Mr. Donnelly stating: (1) Donald Brooks Reece, II, M.D., is aware of the

reason for the Board of Medical Examiners' stipulation that Dr. Reece not act as a back-up supervising physician for the medical acts performed by Physician Assistant Donnelly and suggesting: (2) Mr. Donnelly may wish to discuss this matter with him.

CARNEY, Bruce Hay, M.D., Franklin, North Carolina

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board offer Bruce Hay Carney, M.D., the opportunity to surrender his license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina..

JONES, Leland Anthony, M.D., Buffalo, New York

On August 6, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Henry that, pending a review of information concerning this physician, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina prefer charges against Leland Anthony Jones, M.D., on the basis of N.C. Gen. Stat. 90-14 (a) 6.

PAINE, Karen Nicholson, M.D., Shallotte, North Carolina

On August 7, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board inform Dr. Paine the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina has denied approval of her application for a license to practice medicine in this state; that it also inform this physician, in order for the Board of Medical Examiners to reconsider her licensure application it will be necessary for Dr. Paine to demonstrate her medical knowledge by passing the North Carolina examination for licensure (FLEX); and that it further advise Dr. Paine in addition to successfully completing this examination it will be necessary for her to appear before the Board of Medical Examiners, prior to the Board's acting upon a licensure application, in order to clarify whether or not the issues raised by the Board of Medical Examiners at the time of Dr. Paine's licensure surrender have been resolved to the satisfaction of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina.

GLACE, Charles Lawrence, M.D., Spartanburg, South Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board deny approval of Dr. Glace's licensure application on the basis of the fact that his clerkships do not meet the requirements of the applicable regulations issued by the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina.

JURIVICH, Donald Albert, D.O., Durham, North Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board deny approval of Dr. Jurivich's licensure application on the basis of the fact that he must take and pass the North Carolina examination for licensure (FLEX) in order to meet the statutory requirements for medical licensure in this state.

KOLLER, Brian Richard, M.D., Durham, North Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board issue Dr. Koller a dated license for a period of one year based upon compliance with stated conditions.

AGENDA ITEM TO BE DISCUSSED WITH DEANS AT MAY, 1988, MEETING

Dr. Alexander suggested discussing with the Deans of North Carolina medical schools, during their May, 1988, meeting with the Board, the matter of Psychiatrists in medical centers: (1) providing therapy to residents for training purposes, (2) agreeing in consultation with these residents upon diagnoses, and (3) billing insurance companies for these treatment costs.

WALING, Joseph Frank, M.D., Stone Mountain, Georgia

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board deny approval of Dr. Waling's licensure application on the basis of the fact that his clerkships do not meet the current requirements of the applicable regulations for medical licensure in the state of North Carolina.

PIETERSE-COBB, Pamela Key, M.D., Cherokee, North Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board approve Dr. Pieterse-Cobb for a two year dated license, that the Board waive her licensure fee, and that the Board of Medical Examiners interview Dr. Pieterse-Cobb prior to the expiration of this dated license.

CLAYTON, Robert Douglas, M.D., Granite Falls, North Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board deny approval of Dr. Clayton's licensure application on the basis of the fact that his clerkships do not meet the requirements of the applicable regulations for medical licensure in the state of North Carolina. The Board received notification from Dr. Clayton on September 2, 1987, that he has withdrawn his application for medical licensure in the state of North Carolina.

SMITH, Ashley Allgood, M.D., New Orleans, Louisiana

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board deny approval of Dr. Smith's licensure application on the basis of the fact that his clinical clerkships do not comply with the current requirements of the applicable regulations for medical licensure in the state of North Carolina.

HARRIS, James Linwood, M.D., Levittown, Pennsylvania

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board advise Dr. Harris the approval of his licensure application is pending his providing the Board of Medical Examiners with documentation from the Pennsylvania State Board of Medical Examiners concerning the licensure examination Dr. Harris took in this state; and that the Board further advise Dr. Harris that, if he cannot provide appropriate documentation concerning the examination upon which he bases his licensure application, he must take and pass the North Carolina examination for licensure (FLEX) in order to be eligible for medical licensure in this state.

TURNER, John, PA, Alto, Georgia

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board advise Mr. Turner the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina has reaffirmed its previous action to deny approval of his application to perform medical acts as a physician assistant in North Carolina on the basis of fraudulent answers to questions on the application form which he submitted to the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners; and that the Board further advise Mr. Turner, if he wishes to re-apply at a later date, the Board of Medical Examiners will consider his application.

KHATRI, Sat Dev, M.D., Asheville, North Carolina

On August 8, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board send a letter to Dr. Khatri stating, at the present time, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina does not have adequate information to act upon his request for reinstatement of DEA prescribing privileges.

#### PUBLIC HEALTH NURSES AT THE LINCOLN COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

IMPAIRED PHYSICIANS PROGRAM

On August 7, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson (1) that the Board philosophically agrees with the concept of the proposed Impaired Physicians Program; (2) that the Board of Medical Examiners also agrees this program should receive financial support; but (3) that the Board cannot agree to commit any funds for this program until a more definitive proposal has been developed.

#### CLINICAL CLERKSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Medical Examiners instructed its staff to inform licensure applicants in a timely fashion: (1) of the Board's requirements concerning completion of clerkships performed in the United States at institutions with ACGME approved residency programs in the areas of the clerkships, (2) of the need for providing the Board with a detailed, chronological account of all clerkships; and (3) of the fact that the burden of proof is on the applicant.


