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### Call to Order

Thomas E. Fitz, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called the meeting to order at 8:00 p. m., Thursday, August 11, 1985. Board members present at this meeting are: Jack A. Koontz, M.D., Secretary-Treasurer; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; David S. Citron, M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, M.D.; Charles H. Duckett, M.D.; Rose Pully, M.D.; and Mrs. Martha Kirkland Walston.

### AGENDA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

#### Optometrists' Violation of Medical Practice Act

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners refer this matter to the Attorney General for the purpose of resolving the differences between the two Boards. The Board adopted an additional motion made by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners inform the Attorney General that the Board believes the acts in question constitute the practice of medicine.

#### Administrative Procedures Hearing

The President of the Board of Medical Examiners, Thomas Edmunds Fitz, M.D., presided at this hearing held at 9:00 a.m., Sunday, August 11, at the Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina. No one appeared to speak regarding the proposed regulation changes: (1) to change the Board's regulations to conform to statutory provisions of Chapter 739 of the General Assembly of North Carolina, Session 1985, by: (a) increasing fees for resident's training license, license by endorsement, and limited license; and by (b) changing regulations regarding postgraduate training requirements for licensure; (2) to delete the regulation regarding special limited license to work in state mental hospital while applying for FLEX exam; and (3) to change regulations to conform both to current statutes and to Board policy and to correct typographical errors.

The Board recommended the following amendments to the proposed regulation changes:

Page 1: hyphenate "rule-making."

Page 2: Change "Grade A Medical Schools" to "AOA or LCME approved medical schools."

Page 3 (3): Insert "or."

Page 4 .0104: add "section"

Page 4 .0105: insert "at least" before "75."

Page 5 0106: insert "of State Medical Boards" after "Federation."

Page 5 0111: insert "within seven years" after "Component I."

Page 6 0113: change "foreign medical graduates" in this section and throughout the proposed regulation changes to "graduates of medical schools other than those approved by the AOA or LCME."

Page 6 0113 last paragraph: change "foreign medical graduates" to "such graduates."

Page 3: include in all CAPS: "BURDEN OF PROOF OF MEDICAL EDUCATION IS ON THE APPLICANT."

Page 8, 0201: include wording added to Page 3.

Page 10, 0208: include "at least 2 x 2" before "photograph."

Page 10, 0208: include "or the application withdrawn" after "declined."

Page 11, .0209: underline "must"; include "Failure to present this card constitutes an incomplete application" after "interview." Also, in the information which the Board sends to applicants who are not citizens of the United States include the following statement: "The application is complete only when the physician presents his Alien Registration Receipt Card to the Board."

Page 11, .0212: change "Applicants" to "Each applicant." Add "ever" before "been." Delete "whether current or not." Change last sentence in the first paragraph to: "This information must be mailed directly from other state Boards to the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners."

Page 12, .0213: As noted earlier, change "foreign medical graduates" to the appropriate designation.

Page 15, 0508: DPM's will appear before the full Board to be interviewed.

Page 16, 0605: Visiting Professors will appear before the full Board to be interviewed.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners approve the proposed changes in the rules and regulations as amended with instructions that, after coordinating the amended changes with the Board's attorney, the staff file these proposed changes in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act and furnish this information in an appropriate manner to applicants for licensure. The President declared the hearing concluded at 10:10 a.m.

#### Public Hearing on Clinical Clerkships

The Board adopted a motion that the staff, with all haste and as rapidly as possible, institute proceedings to hold a hearing on regulatory provisions for residents' training licenses; that the staff advertise this hearing appropriately; and that the Board change its regulations to require all applicants for residents' training licenses who have graduated from medical schools not approved by the AOA or the LCME to furnish evidence that they have satisfactorily completed clinical clerkships required by their medical schools at teaching hospitals in the United States with residency programs in the areas of the clinical clerkships.

#### Sykes, John Richardson, M.D.

The Executive Secretary contacted the eight Board members by telephone and Thomas E. Fitz, M.D.; Jack A. Koontz, M.D.; Charles H. Duckett, M.D.; Rose Pully, M.D.; Mrs. Martha Walston; David S. Citron, M.D.; Eben Alexander, M.D.; and John Daniel, M.D., voted in favor approving Dr. Sykes' application for a resident's training license.

#### Bennett, John Robert, M.D.

The Executive Secretary contacted the eight Board members by telephone and Thomas E. Fitz, M.D.; Jack A. Koontz, M.D.; Charles H. Duckett, M.D.; Rose Pully, M.D.; Mrs. Martha Walston; David S. Citron, M.D.; Eben Alexander, M.D.; and John Daniel, M.D., voted in favor of approving Dr. Bennett's application for a resident's training license.

#### Charlton, Warwick Anthony, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett that the Board of Medical Examiners approve Dr. Charlton's postgraduate training and issue him a license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina.

#### Hanham, William, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners instruct its attorney to prepare a Consent Agreement for Dr. Hanham's signature containing the following stipulations:

1. that he surrender his Schedule 2 and 2N prescribing privileges;
2. that he participate in an active, structured continuing medical education program; and
3. that he take and pass Component II of FLEX by the date of the August, 1986, Board meeting;

Berrios, Oswald, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners instruct its attorney to prepare a Consent Decree for Dr. Berrios' signature containing the following stipulations:

1. that he surrender his Schedule 2 and 2N prescribing privileges;
2. that he participate in an active, structured continuing medical education program; and
3. that he take and pass Component II of FLEX by the date of the August, 1986, Board meeting;

FLEX Applicants and New Legislation

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners request an opinion from the Attorney General concerning this matter and that the Board inform FLEX applicants it has requested an opinion from the Attorney General of the State of North Carolina concerning the effect of the new legislation on their applications.

Form Letters

The Board requested that the staff provide a form letter section for Board members' notebooks.

Emergency Medical Services, Meeting with Representatives of

The Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel that the Board approve these proposed changes with the following modifications:

- (1) To be certified as an MICN, an individual must complete the Emergency Nurse Education Program to include ACLS and BTLS materials.

- (2) EMT-Intermediate Advanced certification entitles EMS personnel to prescribe Lydocaine, Atropine, Sodium Bicarbonate, and Epinepherine.

Guilford County Study Project

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners approve this study project for a period of two years and strongly recommend that Guilford County alternate the cases randomly.

Charlotte Memorial Hospital Study Project

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners approve a study project using the pharyngeal-tracheal lumen airway at Charlotte Memorial Hospital for a period of one year with the request that the Board receive a report on this study project at the end of a year.

Letters to be Sent to Judy Seamon, R.N., and Judy Johnson, R.N.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander that the Board of Medical Examiners approve the proposed response to Ms. Seamon, that the Office of EMS prepare a similar response to Ms. Johnson; that the letter to Ms. Seamon include a statement indicating the Office of Emergency Medical Services mailed a hearing notice to the home address of each MICN in North Carolina; that this letter include an additional statement to the effect that the Board of Medical Examiners believes 39% to be a commendable response; and that the Office of EMS furnish the Board with a copy of the response it prepares to Ms. Johnson.

Magee, Archibald Carter, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners inform this physician it has denied his request for reinstatement of his North Carolina medical license.

Martin, Howard C., M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander that the Board of Medical Examiners prefer charges against this physician based upon immoral and dishonorable conduct, indecent assault, and adultery.

#### Ophthalmologists/Optometrists

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners notify all licensed Ophthalmologists in North Carolina, the Ophthalmologists' Association, and the North Carolina Medical Society that it has come to the attention of the Board of Medical Examiners that there are a growing number of situations in North Carolina in which ophthalmologists have entered into arrangements with optometrists whereby the optometrists refer to the ophthalmologists patients for cataract surgery and that following such surgery these patients are then returned by the ophthalmologists to the care of the referring optometrists for post-operative care and following. Because it is the view of the Board that such post-operative care and following constitutes the practice of medicine, the practice of permitting persons who are not licensed to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina to provide such care is specifically disapproved by the Board.

Carlan, Susanne Stanley, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners not approve Dr. Carlan's request for licensure reinstatement.

FLEX Fee for Separate Components

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett that a regulation be adopted to provide, if a physician takes FLEX components separately, the Board of Medical Examiners will charge a fee of \$250.00 for Component I and a fee of \$250.00 for Component II .

Thomas, John Evans, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett that the Board of Medical Examiners issue this physician a temporary license for a period of one year and that the Board request Dr. Thomas to appear for an informal interview prior to the expiration of this temporary license.

Outer Banks Medical Center

The Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that it approve Thomas John Byrne, M.D., to act as a back-up supervising physician at the Outer Banks Medical Center, but that it not approve Thomas Janney Roberts, M.D., to supervise medical acts performed by a physician extender at this practice site.

Cabarrus County Health Department

The Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board send the following letter to Dr. Buoni:

At its August, 1985, meeting, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina reviewed your letter dated June 7, 1985, concerning physicians' countersigning chart entries of nurse practitioners.

As a result of its review, the Board advises you that a nurse practitioner's chart entries documenting the performance of nursing acts do not require countersignature by a physician; however, when a nurse practitioner performs a medical act, physician supervision is necessary and must be documented by countersignature.

The Board of Medical Examiners cannot exempt you from the risks involved in the supervision of nurse practitioners. If you have questions about these risks, the Board suggests that you consult your attorney. If you do not wish to follow regulations, you should relinquish your supervisory responsibility for nurse practitioners and so advise the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners.

Suppal Sushir Kumal, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners initiate the proper procedures to invalidate Dr. Suppal's examination because of irregularities during the administration of the FLEX, and that the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners report this matter to the Board of the Federation of State Medical Boards.

Mansoor, Azra, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Pully that, after consulting with its attorney, the Board of Medical Examiners inform Dr. Mansoor that the Board does not have the authority to reimburse her for travel expenses.

Barron, Elaine Margaret, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett that the Board of Medical Examiners notify Dr. Barron that her medical education does not meet the Board's requirements.

Ekelund, Lars C., M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Pully that the Board issue Dr. Ekelund a license limited to the University of North Carolina and Duke University Medical Center and hospitals affiliated with these institutions.

Desai, Mina C., M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander that the Board inform this physician she needs to complete two additional years of postgraduate training to be eligible for licensure.

Levitt, Stephen, M.D., Data Request

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners not approve this request.

August, 1986, Meeting

The Board adopted a motion that the Board hold this meeting at the Raleigh Hilton beginning August 7, 1985.

Energy Medicine Institute

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Pully that the Board of Medical Examiners refer information concerning this institute to the Attorney General.

Eastern Carolina Eye Specialists, PA

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners advise Dr. Christensen, before the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners can make a decision on the request for approval of a corporate name, it must know the geographical location of this practice. The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners further advise Dr. Christensen, upon receipt of additional information, the Board will act upon his request.

Lay, William R., III, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners approve the issuance of a resident's training license to Dr. Lay for a period of one year and that the Board of Medical Examiners request a letter from the Chairman of the Department of Psychiatry prior to the expiration of this temporary license.

Sebel, Peter Simon, M.D.

The full Board interviewed this physician and issued him a visiting professor's certificate of registration.

Ludgrove, T. W., M.D.

The full Board interviewed this physician and issued him a visiting professor's certificate of registration.

Seghal, Pragma, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners not approve Dr. Seghal's application prior to this physician's taking and passing FLEX.

Rigdon, Henry Lewis, M.D.

Dr. Daniel interviewed this physician who has applied for license by endorsement of credentials. He stated that he is a recovering alcoholic. Dr. Rigdon told the Board that he plans to work at the Charlotte Treatment Center. He stated that he has abstained from alcohol for almost four years. "There were times I took drugs when I could not get alcohol." Dr. Rigdon stated he became addicted to narcotics in 1955 and went for treatment in 1959. He indicated that he became an alcoholic at sixty-three and that he is now seventy-two. Dr. Citron asked Dr. Rigdon if he realized that his work at Charlotte Treatment Center will be emotionally demanding. Dr. Rigdon responded, "I want to pass my serenity on."

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners issue Dr. Rigdon a temporary license for a period of one year limited to the practice of medicine within the Charlotte Treatment Center; and that the Board request him to appear prior to the expiration of this temporary, limited license.

Rubin, Richard Bennett, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners issue this physician a temporary license for a period of two years until Registration in 1988, to expire February 1, 1988, at which time he should contact the Board if he wishes to extend his licensure.

Glaser, Marilyn Knoll, M.D.

The Board adopted a motion that it issue Dr. Glaser a two year temporary license; that the Board advise her to request Dr. Clark and Dr. Bullen to provide progress reports during this two year period; that the Board inform Dr. Glaser it is her responsibility to request licensure extension; and that, if she does so, the Board interview Dr. Glaser prior to the expiration of this temporary license.
