Physician Assistant Relief Sites Policy

The Board agreed that the staff may develop a form which can be processed administratively to approve a physician assistant to work in a second site for relief of another approved physician assistant who is on vacation or sick leave for a period not to exceed ninety days.

Extensions of Duties or Additional Practice Sites Policy for Physician Assistants

The Board indicated that routine requests for extensions of duties or approval at additional practice sites when physician assistants are not changing primary supervising physicians may be approved administratively; however, the Board of Medical Examiners further indicated that, if the request is unusual or requires medical evaluation, it should be presented to the Board.

The Board indicated that a request dated August 9, 1984, from this physician be approved and further indicated that proceedings or action in this matter be postponed indefinitely.
