Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting April 17-18, 2002.

The April 17-18, 2002, meeting of the North Carolina Medical Board was held at the Board's Office, 1201 Front Street, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27609. MISCELLANEOUS

Presidential Remarks

Dr. Pories commenced the meeting by reading the North Carolina Board of Ethics' "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder."

Health Professions Education Summit

The "Health Professions Education Summit" will be held in Washington, D.C. on June 17-18, 2002. Dr. Pories has been invited to participate by the Institute of Medicine (IOM), in coordination with the Council on Graduate Medical Education (COGME) and the National Advisory Council on Nurse Education and Practice (NACNEP). The purpose of the summit is to discuss and develop strategies for:

- (1) Restructuring the continuum of health professions education to better prepare health care professionals to practice in the 21st century health system; and
- (2) Assessing the implications of the changing health system for provider credentialing and licensing programs, and for the funding and sponsorship of education programs.

Motion: A motion passed authorizing Dr. Pories to represent the Medical Board at the Health Professions Education Summit in Washington, D.C. on June 17-18, 2002.

North Carolina Medical Society – A Perspective

Dr. Herring gave a presentation titled "*What is the Business of the North Carolina Medical Society?*" This included a brief history, accomplishments at national and local levels, current endeavors and comments from Medical Society members currently on the Medical Board (several of whom are past presidents of the Medical Society).

Evaluation of Performance

Mr. John P. Anderson, Vice President for Finance and Administration and Professor of Counseling, Wake Forest University, has been retained by the Board as a consultant to carry out an evaluation of personnel of the Medical Board. Mr. Anderson spent most of April 17 interviewing Board Members and senior staff. He stated that it has been six years since he was at the Medical Board. He continued, that he is going ask questions, listen to answers, look at the organization and provide direction. He expects to present results at the May 2002 Board Meeting.

Federation Bylaws Committee Appointment

Ms. Hunter-Buskey was congratulated for her acceptance of an appointment to the Federation of State Medical Boards (Federation) Bylaws Committee. This appointment is for a one-year term beginning April 2002. The Bylaws Committee continually assesses the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Federation.

The Policy Committee met on Wednesday, April 17, 2002, at the office of the Board. The complete report of that meeting will be reviewed by the Board at the May 2002 Board Meeting following committee review. The following item was extracted and presented to the Full Board on April 18.

Cleveland Clinic Plan of Action

The Board has been requested to accommodate a group of physicians (approximately 100) from the Cleveland Clinic (based in Ohio) who will be applying for NC licensure by having a representative of the Board go to Cleveland to conduct the license interviews, at their expense. This group plans to provide an online second opinion service in NC.

At the March 2002 Board Meeting a motion passed to "Proceed with a plan to accommodate this group by sending one or more physician Board Members, at the expense of Cleveland Clinic, to conduct personal interviews. Establish and document with the group guidelines to follow in setting up interviews (no shortcuts) before making a commitment. It was also suggested these physicians understand NC's position on telemedicine and rendering treatment. (The following motion passed at the Full Board Meeting on April 19, 2002:)

Motion: A motion passed that before any Board Member conducts licensing interviews with members of the Cleveland Clinic medical staff, a letter be sent to the Cleveland Clinic clearly stating the Board's position that no patient in North Carolina may be treated with prescription medications by a physician unless first examined by that physician.
