Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting April 18-19, 2007.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

### **Presidential Remarks**

Dr. McCulloch commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were noted.

Dr. McCulloch led the Board in taking a minute of silence reflecting on those that lost families in the tragedy at Virginia Tech.

### **State Ethics Training**

On Wednesday, April 18, 2007, Mr. Frank L. Perry, Education Director, State Ethics Commission, gave a presentation on the new State Ethics Act, with particular emphasis on its relevance to public servants such as Medical Board Members. Attendance at this program satisfies the education requirement of the Act. Also attending were several members of the North Carolina Physical Therapy Board, the North Carolina Board of Dental Examiners and the North Carolina Pharmacy Board. ### **Consumer Access to Physician Information (CAPI) Task Force Report**

Dr. Norins stated that in January 2007 the Board adopted the CAPI Task Force recommendations in principal and he would like to see the Board move forward with these recommendations.

**Action:** The President ordered that this report be included in the May Board Book materials for a Full Board discussion. The Board's consensus will then be put on the Board's web site.

### **Rule Adoption – Authority to Prescribe**

The proposed rule adoption was published in the NC Register, Volume 21, Issue 13, pages 1147-1148. A public hearing was held on February 13, 2007. The comment period ended on March 5, 2007. The Board received one letter from the NC Board of Nursing, requesting a minor revision to paragraph (b).

The following rule was presented with amendments from the original published rule.

#### **21 NCAC 32B .1001 AUTHORITY TO PRESCRIBE**

- (a) A license to practice medicine issued under this Subchapter allows the physician to prescribe medications, including controlled substances, so long as the physician complies with all state and federal laws and regulations governing the writing and issuance of prescriptions.
- (b) A physician must possess a valid United States Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") registration in order for the physician to supervise any other health professional (physician assistant, nurse practitioner, clinical pharmacist practitioner) with prescriptive authority for controlled substances. The DEA registration of the supervising physician must include the same schedule(s) of controlled substances as the other health professional's DEA registration.
