### **Review of Minutes**

The minutes of the July 19, 2000, Policy Committee were reviewed and accepted.

### **Scope of Practice Subcommittee Update** (Dr Herring, Mr Saperstein and Dr Kanof)

The Subcommittee met this morning to discuss issues related to optometry and ophthalmology.

**Action:** Further discussion will be held in abeyance until the end of the period the Board has allowed for the receipt of comments on the questions involved. At that time, all available material will be reviewed and the Subcommittee will consider the pros and cons.

Because time constraints prevented the Subcommittee from addressing the complaint from a Charlotte ophthalmologist concerning pre-surgical evaluations and post-surgical care of LASIK/PRK patients by optometrists, that issue will be dealt with as part of the Committee's review of the Position Statement on the Care of Cataract Patients.

**Alternative Medicine Subcommittee Update** (Drs Kanof and Henry)

Dr Martin Sullivan, Director of Duke's Center for Integrative Medicine, was scheduled for a presentation to the Committee and the Board at noon today but canceled (for the second time).

**Action:** Dr Sullivan will not be invited again and his office has been so informed.

**Office-Based Surgery/Anesthesia: Report on Progress of Draft Position Statement** (Dr Herring)

A second version of the draft position statement was distributed for review. An exhaustive discussion of each section was undertaken, resulting in extensive suggested revisions.

**Action:** Dr Herring and Mr Breaden will make the suggested changes and bring the Mark III draft back to the next regularly scheduled Policy Committee meeting.

**Physicians Consuming Alcohol or Using Impairing Drugs While On-Call; Should a Position Statement be Developed?**

At the July 2000 Board meeting, a case was reviewed in which an OB physician was on call yet went to a wine tasting event and was impaired when called to the emergency room. The general consensus was that this was not simply a glass of wine with dinner but a clear case of impairment and extremely poor judgment. The Board should continue to review such situations on a case by case basis.

**Recommendation to Board:** That no policy statement is needed at this time.

**Robert's Rules vs Davis' Rules**

Dr Herring asked what rules the Board follows during Board meetings. Mr Watry indicated that he is accustomed to the Board's bylaws stipulating what rules the Board will follow, however this Board's bylaws do not stipulate any particular rules. Dr Barrett stated this has actually been at the discretion of the Chair (Board President).

**Action:** This will be considered as a retreat item for discussion/review in October 2000.

**Annual Review of Position Statements**

This item was tabled and consideration will be resumed at the next regularly scheduled Committee meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m., Wednesday, August 16, 2000.
