ACTION: The Board resolved as follows: Upon motion of Dr. Staub, seconded by Dr. Wilkerson, it was resolved that the Board and its Executive Secretary will fully comply with all of the requirements of North Carolina law, including the provisions of G.S. 90-16 and G.S. 90-14.2 with respect to inspection of its public records and attendance at hearings which might be held by the Board pursuant to the latter statute and particularly as set forth in the temporary restraining order issued by His Honor, James H. Pou Bailey, Judge, Superior Court, under date of November 20, 1974, in the civil action entitled "The Knight Publishing Company, d/b/a The Charlotte Observer, et al v. The Members of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, and its Executive Secretary."
