RE: Registration of Physicians Licensed in December

The Executive Secretary reported to the Board that some physicians have expressed concern because they would receive licenses in December and in January they would have to register these licenses. It was moved, seconded, and duly passed that they be given the option of not practicing during the month of December and that they be informed of this option when they come in for interviews.

RE: Letter from Editor of North Carolina Medical Journal

The Board reviewed a letter from the Editor of the North Carolina Medical Journal. It was moved, seconded, and duly passed that this letter be received as information.

RE: William C. Ivey, M.D., Saxapahaw, N.C.

The Board reviewed a letter from Dr. Ivey's attorney. If Barbidonna is not a controlled substance, the Board has no objection to nurse practitioners prescribing this substance.


