The Board reconvened at 2:00 p.m.

RE: High Point Medical and Neurological Group, Inc. -- The Executive Secretary advised the Board that application for a professional association in the name of High Point Medical and Neurological Group, Inc. has been received. After consideration of information presented, it was moved, seconded, and duly passed that the requested name not be approved because it is so similar to the corporate names in use that it would be confusing and misleading.

RE: January, 1980, Board Meeting -- It was moved, seconded, and duly passed that the Board meet in Pinehurst in January, 1980.

RE: Dr. Theodore R. Clark, Pinehurst, N.C. -- Dr. Clark discussed the Physicians' Health Effectiveness Program with the Board. Dr. Citron asked Dr. Clark how the Board could help with this program. He answered that he felt his committee and the Board of Medical Examiners should work hand in hand. Dr. Clark indicated that he would like the Board to pick up where his committee stops, and that he wished to clarify the mechanics of notifying the Board regarding a physician in trouble. The President of the Board stated that the Board would leave the method of notification to Dr. Clark's discretion and expressed appreciation for the work his committee is doing to assist impaired physicians.

RE: Emergency Medical Services -- Robert W. Bailey, Assistant Chief, Office of Emergency Medical Services; the Medical Advisor, Office of Emergency Medical Services; and Mr. Harmelink, Deputy Chief, Office of Emergency Medical Services, circulated information to the members of the Board concerning the different classifications of personnel covered by the Office of Emergency Medical Services. These classifications include Emergency Medical Technician, Emergency Medical Technician-IV, Mobile Intensive Care Technician, and Mobile Intensive Care Nurse. The Board discussed the different types of personnel, their training, and job functions. The President of the Board thanked Mr. Bailey and his staff for their discussion of emergency medical services.

RE: Dr. William L. Giles, East Bend Medical Clinic, East Bend, N.C. --
 The Board reviewed information concerning the East Bend Medical Clinic. It was moved, seconded, and duly passed that the Executive Secretary be instructed to send Dr. Giles a copy of the Board's "Commentary"; that Dr. Giles be advised he or one of the other supervising physicians for Mr. Barker is required to have daily telephone communication with the physician's assistant, with a record kept of the conversation; Dr. Giles or one of the other supervising physicians is required to review all patient charts of patients seen since the last telephone review; that Dr. Giles or one of the other supervising physicians is required to visit the clinic site not less frequently than every seventy-two hours.


