- (7) discussion of legal implications
- (8) stipulation that treatment is to be utilized only in the absence of the availability of physicians or other practitioners who are authorized to administer the treatment

#### Proposed Board Meeting Schedule for 1982

The Board, after listening to Dr. Pagter's intention to move to Greenville County, South Carolina, adopted a motion that it finds no reason for Dr. Pagter not to continue to serve as a member of the Board of Medical Examiners.
