The January 1995 meeting of the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners was held at the Board's office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, NC 27609. The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m., January 25, 1995 by Walter M. Roufail, MD, President. Board members in attendance were: Harold L. Godwin, MD, President Pro-Tempore; Ernest B. AGENDA

The following agenda items were discussed and adopted by the Board.

A calendar of the 1996 Board meeting dates was presented and accepted as information.

The Board reviewed information regarding the upcoming Federation meeting. Dr. G. Barrett, Dr. Roufail, Mr. Howe, and Dr. Spangler will be attending the meeting.

Dr. G. Barrett was appointed as the voting delegate for the NC Board of Medical Examiners.

F. Danford Burroughs was sworn in as a Board Member, his term is to expire October 31, 1997. Dr. E. Spangler, MD, Mr. D. Howe, and Mr. W. VonSeggen, PA were reappointed to the Board. All terms are to expire October 31, 1997.

Mr. Bryant Paris, Jr. reported that physician profiles are now being obtained electronically from the AMA. The Board accepted this as information.

The Board reviewed formal actions taken since the previous meeting. The Board accepted this as information.

Mr. William Breeze reported on legislative activity. The Board accepted this as information. Mr. Breeze also discussed physical therapists performance of electromyography. The Board agreed to accept suggestions by Dr. H. Godwin and Dr. W. Roufail to discuss this as an Action Item at the March Board meeting.

Mr. William Breeze discussed the issue of Podiatry-definition of the foot, as discussed in November Board meeting. He reported on the operating on the ankle, and where the foot stops and the ankle begins. His report included a letter from Dr. Frank H. Bassett, III. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. Spangler, seconded by Mr. P. Saperstein to adopt Dr. Bassett's letter.

The Board reviewed a memo by Mr. Breeze which outlined the Attorney Generals's opinion concluding that the because the Utilization Review "is not diagnosing, operating on, prescribing for, administering to or treating any ailment, injury or deformity" that person is not practicing medicine. Thus, the reviewer does not need a license to practice medicine. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. H. Godwin, seconded by Dr. E. Spangler to accepted this as information.

The Board reviewed a memo prepared by Mr. W. Breeze regarding Licensure of Respiratory Therapist-Survey of States. Mr. Breeze will advise if legislators request an opinion on this issue. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. H. Godwin, seconded by Dr. E. Spangler to accept this as information.

A motion was passed to close the session to consult with the Board's Attorney in order to preserve the Attorney-

Client privilege between the attorney and the Board.

A motion was passed to return to open session.

A motion was passed to close the session to take disciplinary actions against persons holding licenses or certificates while meeting with respect to individual holders of such licenses or certificates.

A motion was passed to return to open session.

Formal Actions executed since the November 1995 meeting - The Board reviewed and accepted as information 20 cases. A written report was presented to the Board for review. The specifics of this report are not included as these actions are not public information.

Policy Committee Report

The following information was reported by the Policy Committee and adopted by the Board. It was agreed that the Committee would change its name from the "Ethics and Policy Committee" to the "Policy Committee". The committee reviewed its charge: to consider matters that do not fall within the charges of other committees. It will also consider any other matters of interest to the Board such as developing by-laws, and other matters of policy or general applicability. By design, this committee should assure consideration of any issue and assure continuity of those issues before the Board. This committee should consider the impact of new legislation on Board actions and activity. This committee is not an ad-hoc committee but it will assume matters and concerns of the Board that previously have been assigned to adhoc committees. the Board accepted this as information.

The Committee considered the possibility of meeting with representatives from the North Carolina Medical Society, the Deans, the Legislators, etc.

The Committee committed to meeting at times other than at the Board meetings. The next meeting is scheduled for Saturday, February 18, 1995, at 10:00 a.m., in Charlotte, North Carolina. Dr. Barrett agreed to notify the members of the specifics of the location of the meeting.

The Committee will consider development or reconsideration such as policy statements, boundary issues, and anorectic medication. In considering the review of Board policies the question arose as to whether or not the Committee should consider existing policies or the development of future policies. The Committee agreed on developing a hierarchy from old and new issues. Major items included abandonment, issues related to managed care, staff is to gather information from other organizations regarding abandonment to be distributed prior to the next meeting.

The Committee then discussed draft by-laws and the fact that by-laws articulate what the Board does, its operations and the duties of its officers.

The Board accepted as information.

The Committee discussed Quality Assurance. It was pointed out that the Federation had suggested that Boards become involved in this issue. Mr. George Styles was mentioned as a grant writer who may assist in the development of a QA program and the potential of data gathering would be a foremost necessity. The possibility of gathering markers and indicators from the Board's data will be considered. Continuing study is necessary. Also to be considered is cost and intrusiveness of direct involvement in quality assurance. Dr. Barrett was encouraged to continue his efforts to investigate this issue through meetings with Dr. Estes and Mr. Berstein.

EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

On Tuesday, December 6, 1994, mid morning Mr. Paris received a phone call from two applicants for Step III of the USMLE indicating that they had been advised to take the exam at East Carolina Medical School. When they

arrived they found no one there to administer the exam. They indicated that they had not received notification that the exam site had been changed to Bowman Gray School of Medicine. After numerous phone calls to the National Board of Medical Examiners, the Federation in Texas, candidates and others, arrangements were made to allow the applicants to drive to Raleigh to take the first day of the USMLE. The exam was administered in the afternoon and with the assistance of Joy Cooke and Michelle Lee. Mr. Paris remained with the candidates during the evening until day one of the exam was concluded at 8:14 p.m. The two candidates completed the exam in Winston-Salem on Wednesday, December 7. Dr. W. Roufail suggested that a letter be written to the Federation requesting a letter of apology to the two applicants.

Mr. Paris reported on past and present procedures and by-laws concerning the election of Presidents to the Board. This topic is to be reported at the March 1995 meeting by the Policy Committee.

Years ago the Board only elected the President and the Secretary-Treasurer. Then a few years ago, the Board decided to elect a President-Elect so that, if the President was unable to serve then the President-Elect could fill that void. Then, within the past year or so, the Board has elected a President Pro Tem to step in, in the absence of the elected President.

The Board accepted this as information.

On Thursday, December 15, 1994, Mr. Paris attended an open house at the Pharmacy Board in Carrboro. Later that same day, he attended a retirement reception for Dr. Thad Wester, the Deputy State Health Director. Dr. Wester is the current President of the North Carolina Medical Society. The Board accepted this as information.

Mr. Paris reported that we have obtained a computer modem. We can now communicate electronically with the AMA to receive Physician Profile data. We have implemented the same verification process through the Federation of State Medical Boards. The Board accepted this as information.

Mr. Paris was asked to set a meeting with the Deans. Mr. Paris reported that he had called Dr. Hallock, the Dean at East Carolina, and discussed with his secretary the possibility of the Deans meeting with the Board at the next second or third meeting.

As instructed by the Board at its last meeting, Mr. Paris surveyed all states regarding the one year, two year, three year post graduate training requirement for licensure. Mr. Paris reviewed the 1995-96 "Exchange", published by the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, Inc. Table 22 of that publication indicated that US or Canadian grads who were applying for initial license were required to have certain number of years of graduate medical education.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

The contract with Health Source - Employee Health Care, was renewed for 1995. The account representative met with staff on January 5, 1995, to review any changes. The contract amount was lower than last year with increased benefits.

The telephone traffic report reviewed. The amount of incoming and outgoing calls has increased. The voice mail system is to be clarified with instructions for exiting and for accessing the system with rotary dial telephone.

The Modem Access to Verification Data Survey was reviewed. Ms. Meelheim indicated that the estimated cost of the subscription will be \$750.00 per subscriber. The staff is to implement system and to bill prospective subscribers.

The Management is to purchase a new server and use the old server as a workstation. The Board accepted this as information.

Copiers will need to be purchased in the next fiscal year. The staff is calling for preventative maintenance visits in addition to routine maintenance the week before high volume periods. Review all preventative maintenance plans for future Operation Committee meetings.

Lassiter Presort did not mail registrations as instructed and mislead the staff as to when the registration forms were mailed. Staff is in the process of locating another mailing service. Bids have been requested from four services.

Review mail as focus for the next Operations Committee meeting.

The 1994 Balance sheet, Financial statement and Audit report were reviewed.

The staff to work with Mr. James and Mr. Jackson to create a uniform language and presentation of the financial statements and the audit.

Investment proposals from A.G. Edwards, Prudential, BB&T, Alex Brown & Sons were reviewed. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. E. Spangler and seconded by Mr. D. Howe to have BB&T manage our investment accounts.

Mr. Linwood Jackson, of Lynch & Howard, CPA, presented the audit at the meeting during an executive session. The Board accepted the audit report as information.

PHP 501(c)(3) received an advanced ruling on August 24, 1993 - December 31, 1997. It now qualifies as a 501(c)(3) corporation. The Board accepted this as information.

The Board discussed the Federation meeting attendance. The staff is to purchase and circulate the tapes from the Federation meeting to Board members and staff.

The *Bulletin* is scheduled to be sent out in February. The Board accepted as information.

Staff is to obtain samples of Expense Forms from other regulatory Boards for the Board to review. The Board accepted as information only.

Dr. Spangler requested that the proposal for long range plans be expanded to include the policy issues which the Board should address. Staff was instructed to include a two year plan and a six year plan which should be proactive and include content which will enhance medical care in the state as well as employee benefits, staff education and patient education. The Board accepted as information.

MISCELLANEOUS

Ms. Meelheim gave an update regarding the present MD registration.

The Board adopted a motion by Dr. E. Spangler, seconded by Dr. H. Henry, to send a reminder to all physicians not currently registered as soon as possible.

Mr. VonSeggen requested that when legislative issues are addressed, that the Board not forget to include Physician Extenders. The Board accepted as information only.

Dr. Easley resigned from the Midwifery Joint Committee leaving a vacancy. At the recommendation of Mr. Paris, the Board reviewed the qualifications of Robert Eugene Granger, MD from Durham. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. C. Trado, seconded by Mr. D. Howe to appoint Dr. Granger to the Midwifery Committee.

Jim Wilson presented a thirty minute report regarding the Regulatory
of the Board and the difference between a Rule and an Opinion of the Board.
The Board accepted the report as information only.

Functions

Dr. Robert C. Vanderberry, Jr. reported on the NCPHP budget and expenditures from 1994 and the proposed budget and expenditures for 1995. The Board accepted it as information.

The Communication Ad-Hoc Committee will discuss whether or not a Communication Committee is needed. This is to be discussed at a future Board meeting. The Board accepted this as information only.

The Board adopted a motion by Dr. D. Burroughs and seconded by Mrs. M. Walston to approve the report.

A motion was passed to close the session to take disciplinary actions against persons holding licenses or certificates while meeting with respect to individual holders of such licenses or certificates.

A motion was passed to return to open session.

EMS along with Dr. Nicholas Benson will solicit input from several EMS Medical Directors throughout the State, as well as involve the State EMS Advisory Council in the development of a draft of guidelines for EMS Medical Director for review by the Board. The Board accepted as information.

The MCMS Disaster and Emergency Medical Care Committee is presently working on a document that addresses the interaction of a physician with EMS personnel while at the scene of a traumatic or medical emergency. Proposed documentation was presented for the Board's review. The Board accepted as information.

Mr. Ed Browning was present prior to the discussion of Automatic External Defibrillation to answer questions. Dr. Burroughs reviewed the issues of first responders being authorized to use automatic defibrillation. It was reported that the Office of EMS would prefer to have another level of EMTs. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. D. Burroughs, seconded by Dr. E. Spangler, to ask the Advisory Counsel of EMS to give the Board a recommendation.

A motion was passed to close the session to investigate, examine, or determine the character and other qualifications of applicants for professional licenses or certificates while meeting with respect to individual applicants for such licenses or certificates.

A motion was passed to return to open session.

LICENSURE COMMITTEE

A motion was passed to close the session to investigate, examine, or determine the character and other qualifications of applicants for professional licenses or certificates while meeting with respect to individual applicants for such licenses or certificates.

A motion was passed to return to open session

Jim Wilson suggested rewording of Board Rule .0210 because it leans toward discrimination. The reason for filing this rule originally was to help facilitate applications from N.C. medical graduates.

We have recently been advised by the Federation that 4th year medical graduates will not qualify to take Part III of USMLE because their M.D. degree will not be awarded by the exam application deadline. Sections of the rule (.0210) are therefore no longer needed. The Board instructed the staff to proceed with steps for the repeal of the rule as follows: Change the wording of rule .0210 (exam deadline) to read "All application materials must be in the Board's office at least 90 days prior to the written examination"; deleting the remainder of the rule to be in compliance with the Federation of State Medical Boards.

AMA and Federation's Electronic Networking - As part of the credentialing process for license applications, the staff requests an AMA profile and a Federation data search on every physician who is sent an application package.

In return the AMA sends us a hard copy profile for the file and the Federation advises us whether any action has been taken against the physician by governmental agencies/military. A modem and software have been installed with the hopes of accessing these organization's data banks to save some time in receiving the information and to cut costs. However the AMA's system will not allow us into their data files, but we can make request through E Mail, they will do the search and reply by E Mail. The Federation's setup is not as user friendly at this time and makes the process more complicated. We will continue to send these inquiries as we have in the past until some changes are implemented. The Board accepted this as information.

Information on Canadian Specialty Boards still has not been received (requested twice). Dr. Johnson agreed to handle this task. The Board has previously discussed the possibility of accepting Canadian Board Certification as equivalent to American Medical Special Board certification, upon review of the criteria for the Canadian Boards.

A motion was passed to close this session to take disciplinary actions against persons holding licenses or certificates while meeting with respect to individual holders of such licenses or certificates.

A motion was passed to return to open session.

LICENSE COMMITTEE REPORT


