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## MINUTES

### CALL TO ORDER

Harold L. Godwin, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m., at the Pickett Suite Hotel, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina,.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Nicholas Emanuel Stratas, M.D., Secretary; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D., Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; John Wesley Nance, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Donald R. Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robert J. Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; and Betty Ann Preston.

### **BASARA, Bruno, M.D. - Tampa, Florida**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding false statements or representations to the Board made by Dr. Basara.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Patterson that Charges 1 and 2 were found to be true.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board revoke Dr. Basara's current North Carolina medical license; that he be issued a one-year temporary license; that the Board write Dr. Basara a letter of censure; that the Board receive continued psychiatric reports on Dr. Basara every six (6) months; that he obey all laws; that he formally enter into a contract with PHEP and abide by what is recommended by PHEP; that he keep the Board advised of his practice site; and that he return for an informal interview before the Board in one year.

### **BRANLY, Louis Phillip, M.D. - Harrellsville, NC**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding Dr. Branly's care of a patient at O'Berry Center, Goldsboro, and his failure to limit his practice to that facility. Dr. Branly appeared, but was not represented by counsel.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Stratas that Charges 1 and 2 were found to be true.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board revoke Dr. Branly's license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

**MELMED, John Richard, M.D. - Rockville, MD**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding action taken against Dr. Melmed in Maryland and the District of Columbia. Although duly notified, Dr. Melmed did not appear at this hearing.

At the conclusion of this hearing, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Daniel that all charges against Dr. Melmed be found to be true.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board revoke Dr. Melmed's license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

**OWENS, Robert C., M.D. - Morganton, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board summarily suspend Dr. Owens' license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

Dr. Owens has pled guilty to taking indecent liberties with a minor. Also, Dr. Owens has requested a hearing which will take place in March.

**MAHAN, Robert Gary, M.D. - Salisbury, NC**

On January 26, 1989, Dr. Mahan appeared before the Board (Dr. Godwin, Dr. Nance, Dr. Patterson and Dr. Stratas) as requested for an informal interview regarding the extension of his temporary license.

As a result of the informal interview on January 26, 1989, the Board adopted the following motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that Dr. Mahan be issued a three-year temporary license.

**MEETING SCHEDULE**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Stratas that:

1. the August, 1989, Board meeting be held at the North Raleigh Hilton;
2. the October, 1989, Board meeting be October 18-22 at the North Raleigh Hilton, with the proviso that if the meeting accommodations at the Embassy Suites prove satisfactory, the Board consider holding the October meeting there.

**MEDICAL DOCTORS OF ANESTHESIOLOGY, P.A. - Rockingham, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Nance that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Medical Doctors of Anesthesiology, P.A."

**CAROLINA FAMILY MEDICINE, P.A. - Rockingham, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Carolina Family Medicine, P.A."

**CAROLINA FAMILY MEDICAL CENTER, P.A. - Asheville, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Carolina Family Medical Center, P.A."

**TOTAL PREVENTIVE MEDICINE, P.A. - Fayetteville, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board deny the use of the name Total Preventive Medicine, P.A.

**DATA REQUEST: FLANDERS, INC. - Charleston, SC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry to deny a data request from Flanders, Inc.

**DATA REQUEST: NALLE CLINIC - Charlotte, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry to deny a data request from the Nalle Clinic.

**WOJDYNSKA, Magda, M.D. - Carrboro, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board of Medical Examiners approve Dr. Wojdynska for a nine (9) month license limited to the specific training situation at Chapel Hill provided she meets all credentialing requirements.

**BECAN, Arthur F., M.D. - Florham Park, NJ**

On January 26, 1989 the Board discussed Dr. Becan's lawsuit in which he is attempting to recover attorney's fees expended in his recent effort to be licensed.

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board instruct counsel to do whatever is necessary to defend against this suit.

**APPLETON, Derek Frank James, M.D. - Chapel Hill, NC**

On January 28, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board of Medical Examiners approve Dr. Appleton's request for extension of his VIP license until September, 1990 with the same guidelines and stipulations as was granted before. Dr. Stratas voted in opposition to his motion.

**SUTEJ, Paul George, M.D. - Chapel Hill, NC**

On January 26, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board of Medical Examiners deny Dr. Sutej's application for licensure on the grounds that he does not meet the three-year postgraduate training requirement.

**DIAMANT, Robert S., M.D. - Mt. Laurel, NJ**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Alexander that since Dr. Diamant's temporary license has been suspended for failure to register (it expired on May 20, 1988), if he should ever want to practice medicine in North Carolina his application be subject to full review.

**APPROVED FORMULARY FOR PHYSICIAN EXTENDERS**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Nance that Dr. Patterson review the proposed formulary and make a recommendation to the Board.

**BIENNIAL REGISTRATON**

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board eliminate the questions on the registration form for the next registration period. The Board will consider the reinstatement of these questions every two or three registration periods. Dr. Alexander voted in opposition of this motion.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE RULES REVIEW**

On January 26, 1989, Mr. Paris discussed the Rules Review Commission comments on the Board's regulations. The Board is in the process of drafting changes consistent with the recommendations of the Rules Review Commission.

On January 26, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that once the changes to the Board's regulations have been drafted, Dr. Godwin and Mr. Paris will review.

### **DUKE/PHEP LETTER**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board accept as information the letter from Dr. Corey of Duke regarding the PHEP program at Duke.

### **HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION (HMO) REPORTING**

On January 27, 1989 there was discussion on the disciplinary reporting procedures of HMO's.

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board ask the Attorney General of North Carolina for a ruling or interpretation in writing of the N.C.G.S. 90-14(13) as it relates to mandatory reporting of limitations of physician privileges and resignations from practice by HMO's.

### **NEONATAL EXTENDERS**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas that Dr. Godwin write a letter to Dr. Schwartz explaining avenues of approval for Nurse Practitioners and indicating that he should contact the Board of Nursing regarding program review.

### **INFORMAL INTERVIEW/HEARING PROCEDURE AIMS MEETING, REPORT OF SOUTHEASTERN REGION**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board accept the report on the meeting of the Southeastern Region of AIMS presented by Mr. Paris as information and that the Board not change its procedures with regarding to informal interviews or hearings.

## **NATIONAL BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board accept the report on this meeting as information.

## **PHYSICIANS HEALTH AND EFFECTIVENESS PROGRAM (PHEP)**

On January 27, 1989, Drs. Stratas and Patterson reported on their meeting with Dr. Vanderberry of PHEP. An article on PHEP has been prepared by Dr. Vanderberry and should be published in all professional journals in the near future. All physicians who are currently involved with PHEP have been seen by Dr. Vanderberry and there has been one physician who has been referred of whom the Board was not aware.

Dr. Vanderberry expressed his interest in attending the informal interviews of physicians who are enrolled in PHEP.

Dr. Vanderberry will present a comprehensive report to the Board at the August meeting.

## **SHAFTNER, Kimberly, M.D. - Garner, NC**

It was reported that Dr. Shaftner surrendered his license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina on December 16, 1988.

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that Dr. Shaftner be scheduled for an informal interview (split board) when time permits.

## **APA AMENDMENT**

On January 27, 1989, Dr. Stratas presented a report of the Rules hearing held on January 19, 1989.

On January 27, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board approve the amendment of its rules as follows:

- (1) The rule regarding medical education required of applicants for license by written examination is amended by deleting paragraph (3) which requires evidence of clinical clerkships.
- (2) The rule regarding medical education required of applicants for license by endorsement of credentials is amended by deleting paragraph (3) which requires evidence of clinical clerkships.
- (3) The rule regarding fees for biennial registration of physicians is amended to increase the fee from \$50 to \$70 to assist in the support of the N.C. Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program established by General Statute 90-21.22.

As a result of Dr. Combs' presence at the rules hearing, Drs. Stratas and Alexander will explore the possibility of Dr. Combs' assisting in documenting the history of the Board from 1959 forward and they will report back to the Board in March.


