

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF NORTH CAROLINA

O'Henry Hotel, Greensboro, North Carolina
 July 29th., 1942, around 10:00 a.m.

The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met at the O'Henry Hotel around 10:00 a.m., July 29th., 1942. Dr. Lewis W. Elias opened the meeting with prayer. All members of the Board were present, namely: Dr. William M. Coppridge, President, Dr. J. Street Brewer, Dr. Lester A. Crowell, Jr., Dr. Frank A. Sharpe, Dr. Lewis W. Elias, Dr. K. B. Pace and Dr. W. D. James, Secretary.

Each members grades were duly recorded. The seventy-seven recent graduates were awarded their North Carolina license.

Dr. J. Street Brewer read to the Board Dr. Ham McKay's file on Dr. Kimmelstiel. It was voted unanimously to accept Dr. J. Street Brewers' report on Dr. Kimmelstiel.

Dr. J. Street Brewer was elected president of the Board of Medical Examiners to succeed Dr. William M. Coppridge, retiring president.

Dr. Lester A. Crowell, Jr. suggested Charlotte as the December meeting place. Dr. William M. Coppridge suggested Pinehurst. Dr. K. B. Pace wanted the meeting in either Raleigh or Durham. Dr. Lewis W. Elias favored Asheville or Raleigh. Dr. W. D. James and Dr. William M. Coppridge favored the December meeting to be held in Pinehurst. It was not decided upon at this time where to meet in December.

Dr. William M. Coppridge suggested to have numbers placed on the tables for each student and his photograph to be attached to his number for identification during examination.

A vote of thanks was extended to Dr. William M. Coppridge for his successful management of the years business for the Board.
