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MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Charles H. Duckett, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina called this meeting to order at 8:45 p.m., at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; David S. Citron, M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D., and Mrs. Martha Kirkland Walston.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Don Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robbie Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; and Sibyl Lamoreaux.

LLEWELLYN, Charles E., Jr., M.D., Durham, North Carolina

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board enter into a Consent Order with Dr. Llewellyn permitting the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina to revoke this physician's license on the basis of unprofessional conduct and, after a period of ninety days provided his Psychiatrist, Dr. Munroe, submits a favorable report, to suspend the revocation for a period of two years based on the following probationary conditions:

1. Dr. Llewellyn shall obey all state and federal laws;
2. Dr. Llewellyn shall observe the principles of good conduct;
3. Dr. Llewellyn shall continue therapy as directed by Dr. Munroe;
4. Dr. Llewellyn shall request reports from Dr. Munroe for the Board's review at the end of one year and just prior to the conclusion of Dr. Llewellyn's probation;
5. Dr. Llewellyn shall appear before the Board at its June, 1989 meeting.
6. Dr. Llewellyn shall agree to the the Board's publicizing this action; and

7. Dr. Llewellyn shall agree to the Board's notifying the Chairman of the Ethics Committee of the North Carolina Psychiatric Association of this action;

LUCAS, Charles Clement, M.D., New York, New York

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board: (1) issue Dr. Lucas a dated license for a period of one year; (2) advise Dr. Lucas to meet with the Board of Medical Examiners prior to the expiration of this dated license; (3) instruct Dr. Lucas to notify the Board of Medical Examiners when the New York Board terminates his probation; (4) instruct Dr. Lucas to notify the Board of Medical Examiners of his practice plans prior to resuming medical practice in this state; (5) advise Dr. Lucas to practice within the mainstream of medicine; and (6) advise Dr. Lucas, if he engages in the practice of medicine in North Carolina, the Board will monitor his practice activities.

PAINE, Karen Nicholson, M.D., Shallotte,

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board advise Dr. Paine to provide a physical and Psychiatric evaluation for the Board's review at its next meeting, at which time the Board of Medical Examiners will again consider her application for licensure.

BUNCH, John Dallas, M.D., Warrenton, Virginia

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board issue Dr. Bunch a dated license for a period of one year and that it interview him prior to the expiration of this dated license."

COHEN, Clarence L., M.D.

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson that, if the Board's Attorney determines that Dr. Cohen is eligible under the statutes, the Board of Medical Examiners approve this physician for licensure.

GROSSMAN, Jon Edward, M.D., Chapel Hill, North Carolina

The Board of Medical Examiners reviewed a report indicating Dr. Grossman has entered a drug dependency treatment program. On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Patterson: (1) that the Board offer Dr. Grossman the opportunity to enter into a Consent Order with the Board of Medical Examiners specifying (1) that Dr. Grossman will surrender his medical license; (2) that the Board of Medical Examiners will issue Dr. Grossman, if he has an appointment to a Residency Training Program at North Carolina Memorial Hospital, a geographically and temporally limited license; (3) that Dr. Grossman will provide periodic progress to the Board at its request; and (4) that the Board of Medical Examiners will interview Dr. Grossman at its August, 1987, meeting.

BELL, Ronald Lee, M.D., Fairmont, North Carolina

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board summarily suspend the license of Ronald Lee Bell, M.D.

ESPINOSA, Jose Carlos, M.D., Manistique, Michigan

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Mrs. Walston and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board approve Dr. Espinosa and request him to advise the Board of Medical Examiners concerning the outcome of all four suits listed in his application, as well as any other suits which may be filed against him between now and the time he enters medical practice in North Carolina.

REINES, Eric David, M.D., Hackensack, New Jersey

On June 13, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board approve Dr. Reines for licensure with the request that he provide the Board of Medical Examiners with documentation of his medical education in Paris.

#### NATIONAL BOARD SCORES ON LICENSURE APPLICANTS

Dr. Alexander requested that the staff furnish him with

National Board scores, when applicable, on all physicians he interviews for licensure.

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board not approve this data request.

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board not approve this data request.

#### CAPP CARE, Data Request

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board not approve this data request.

#### SPECTRUM EMERGENCY CARE, INC., Data Request

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board not approve this data request.

#### SCRUB NURSE AS FIRST ASSISTANT IN SURGERY

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board refer this matter to its Attorney so that he may provide a response to the hospital indicating the Board of Medical Examiners believes this is a matter to be resolved by the hospital and the Board of Nursing.

GRACE, Eugene Vernon, M.D., Durham, North Carolina

On June 10, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board accept as information a letter from Dr. Grace.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES REPRESENTATIVES, Meeting With

Fred Glass, M.D., Jack Allison, M.D., and Ed Browning attended this meeting to discuss various concerns.

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board advise Dr. Daniel the Board of Medical Examiners has no objections to the regulation changes proposed by the Office of Emergency Medical Services and will approve whatever action he deems appropriate.

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board approve the extension and proposed expansion of the Nitrous Oxide Study for one year; that the Board of Medical Examiners request a progress report from Dr. Allison and his colleagues by the December, 1987, Board meeting; and that the Board of Medical Examiners specify this report is to include a summary of the project results to date, a reasonable projection of the numbers involved in this study, and a description of any adverse reactions which may have occurred. This motion carried by a vote of four to three.

On June 11, 1987, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett to approve all the Advanced Life Support Certification and Recertification applications and all Bee Sting Certification applications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

INFORMAL INTERVIEWS: SCHEDULING

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that, when appropriate, the Board divide into subcommittees to interview physicians informally; and that the Board member making a particular motion specify whether an individual is to appear before the full Board or a subcommittee.

DOBSON, Dean MacMillan, M.D., Seneca, South Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board offer Dr. Dobson the opportunity to enter into a Consent Order with the Board of Medical Examiners based on the action taken in South Carolina with the additional stipulation that Dr. Dobson shall notify the Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in this state so that the Board may schedule him to appear for an interview.

JAGNANDAN, Norris Rajkumar, M.D., Marietta, Georgia

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board prefer charges against Dr. Jagnandan on the basis of N.C. Gen Stat. 90-14 (a)(3).

MCDONALD, William, M.D., Madison, Florida

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Walston that the Board's attorney offer Dr. McDonald the opportunity to enter into a Consent Order with the Board of Medical Examiners in lieu of responding to formal charges; and that this Consent Order specify Dr. McDonald will surrender his North Carolina medical license.

RUBIN, Richard Bennett, M.D., Jacksonville, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board approve Dr. Rubin for a one year dated license as of January 1, 1988, and continue to monitor this physician's practice activities.

TODD, Gary Price, M.D., Waynesville, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board hold preferring charges against Dr. Todd in abeyance pending further investigation.

BERRIOS, Oswald, M.D., Carolina Beach, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr.

Alexander that the Board withdraw only the portion of the charges preferred against Dr. Berrios involving records; that the Board advise Dr. Berrios to furnish the Board of Medical Examiners with the results of physical and neurological examinations; that the Board instruct Dr. Berrios to take a multi-purpose examination; and that the Board urge Dr. Berrios to improve his record-keeping.

DEWEES, Steven Philip, M.D., Charleston, South Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Mrs. Walston and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board offer Dr. Dewees the opportunity to enter into a Consent Order in the state of North Carolina containing the same stipulations as those imposed in South Carolina with an additional stipulation requiring Dr. Dewees to notify the Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in this state.

FIRST PHYSICIANS, P.A.

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board deny this professional corporation's request to use this name on the basis that the Board of Medical Examiners is confused about the meaning of the adjective "first" and believes that this name will be particularly confusing to patients.

MANDATORY REPORTING OF CHANGES IN PA'S HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board interprets changes in physician assistants' hospital privileges to be extensions of physicians' privileges; and that hospitals, therefore, must report all changes in physician assistants' privileges to the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina.

MINUTES OF THE MAY, 1987, MEETING

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board approve these Minutes as recorded.

## REGULATION HEARING REPORT

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board accept the Executive Secretary's report on this Hearing as information, ratify the Executive Secretary's suggested second option, and adopt these regulation changes.

## PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT QUESTION: GRADED EXERCISE TESTS

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board inform Ms. Zapata the Board of Medical Examiners has consulted a Cardiologist and determines that the standard of care in North Carolina is for a physician to be in the room or immediate area when a non-physician is administering a graded exercise test.

## FNP'S, QUESTION FROM A CONCERNED GROUP OF

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners reviewed a letter from a group of FNP's, accepted it as information, and took no further action.

## KRYSTAL, Andrew D., M.D., Durham, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board accept as information a letter concerning this physician and that, if his file is complete, the Board permit him to take FLEX in December, 1987.

## ANDRINGA, Richard Cornell, M.D., Madison, Wisconsin

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board obtain two or three random urine samples from Dr. Andringa for drug screens during the next year; and that it not impose any restrictions on Dr. Andringa's licensure or prescribing privileges.

## BEAVERS, Carl Michael, M.D., Apex, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr.

Citron that, after August 5, 1987, if Dr. Beavers wishes reinstatement of his full DEA prescribing privileges, the Board of Medical endorse this request and continue to monitor his prescribing activities.

BERTELS, Norman H., M.D., Winston-Salem, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board extend Dr. Bertels' resident's training license for an additional year and interview him again informally in June, 1988.

BLACKBURN, Robert Alfred, M.D., Fayetteville, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Duckett: (1) that the Board approve Dr. Blackburn for a one year dated license; (2) that it request him to appear prior to the expiration of this dated license; (3) that it request Dr. Blackburn to provide the results of a random drug screen, together with a progress report from his treating Psychiatrist, prior to his next interview; (4) that it advise Dr. Blackburn to contact the Board's office to determine whether these reports have been submitted; (4) that the Board advise Dr. Blackburn it may also request urine samples for random drug screens; and (5) that the Board advise Dr. Blackburn of this action in writing.

AVERETT, Leland S., Jr., M.D., High Point, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Duckett: (1) that the Board offer Dr. Averett the opportunity to sign a Consent Order containing a formal reprimand for failure to supervise adequately the medical acts performed by a physician assistant; (2) that this Consent Order also provide for monitoring Dr. Averett's practice activities and reviewing his patient charts at the request of the Board of Medical Examiners; (3) that the Consent Order also contain stipulations regarding Dr. Averett's compliance with state and federal laws; and (4) that the Consent Order also contain a stipulation requiring compliance with the Regulations of the Board of Medical Examiners, particularly those covering physician assistants.

WHITE, Steven Merle, M.D., Greenville, North Carolina

On Friday, June 12, 1987, at 1:00 p.m., the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a continuation of the Hearing on charges preferred against Steven Merle White, M.D. Although, the respondent did not attend this continuation of the Hearing, his attorney was present.

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board hold a continuation of the Hearing on charges preferred against Steven Merle White, M.D., on July 18 and 19, 1987, in Greenville, North Carolina.

#### NATIONAL OSTEOPATHIC BOARD EXAMINATION

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Henry: (1) that the Board advise Mr. Donadio the Board of Medical Examiners will review the National Osteopathic Board examination; (2) that the Board request Mr. Donadio to provide enough copies of this examination for Board reviewers; (3) that the Board request Mr. Donadio to describe any significant changes or improvements in this examination since March, 1985; (4) that the President appoint two or more Board members to review this examination, possibly Dr. Alexander and Dr. Stratus; and (5) that the Board advise Mr. Donadio representatives of the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners will schedule a time to meet with representatives of the American Osteopathic Association.

BRANLY, Louis Phillip, M.D., Goldsboro, North Carolina

On June 11, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board inform Dr. Branly it will permit him to perform general medical acts which are part of his responsibilities as a Psychiatrist in an institutional practice.

#### NCAPA, Meeting With Representatives Of

On June 11, 1987, the Board met with Sandy Pearce, Marc Katz, and Bud Shelton, representatives of the North Carolina Association of Physician Assistants. The Board and the representatives of the NCAPA discussed mutual concerns, including: (1) Guidelines for Physician Assistants, (2)

Medicare Billing for Acts Performed by Physician Assistants, (3) Reporting Formal Board Actions on Physician Assistants, (4) Reporting Annually the Number of Informal Board Actions on Physician Assistants, (5) Physician Assistants' Reporting Impaired Individuals (6) National Certifying Examination for Physician Assistants, and (7) Physician Assistant Representation on the Board of Medical Examiners.

Dr. Duckett advised these representatives of the North Carolina Academy of Physician Assistants that he has appointed Dr. Henry as Chairman of a Subcommittee to study and recommend appropriate action on Physician Assistant Guidelines.

COBBLE, Clark Robert, M.D., Danville, Virginia

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board notify Dr. Cobble the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina grants him the privilege of practicing medicine in this state.

CATER, Clinton Duncan, Jr., M.D., Knoxville, Tennessee

The Board reviewed a letter from Dr. Cater. On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board write a letter to this physician: (1) thanking him for informing the Board of Medical Examiners of his activities; (2) advising Dr. Cater, if he decides to enter medical practice in this state, he should inform the Board of his practice address; and (3) further advising this physician that it will not be necessary for him to meet with the Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in this state.

WALDEN, Burt Marcus N., M.D., Symrna, Georgia

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board advise Dr. Walden he may apply to register his North Carolina medical license, but that it also advise this physician he must appear before the Board of Medical Examiners prior to entering the practice of medicine in this state.

IMPAIRED PHYSICIANS PROGRAM

Dr. Citron commended the members of the Board who have worked for an an improved Impaired Physicians Program in this state and mentioned that Board of Medical Examiners' funds should not be encumbered without approval.

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board accept as information a report concerning this physician.

GUESS, George, M.D., Asheville, North Carolina

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board accept a report on the status of the Board's appeal as information and that the Board of Medical Examiners request its attorney to notify all Board members when the Judge schedules a hearing on the Board of Medical Examiners' appeal.

ROGERS, Charles Wilburn, M.D., Chapel Hill, North Carolina

On June 12, 1987, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board accept as information a report concerning this physician.


