The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met at The Velvet Cloak Inn, Raleigh, North Carolina, and Jane S. McKimmon Center, Raleigh, North Carolina, June 12-15, 1978 for the purpose of administering examinations to applicants for licensure in North Carolina, interviewing applicants for license by endorsement of credentials, and conducting other business.

Drs. E. Wilson Staub, President, Charles B. Wilkerson, Jr., Secretary-Treasurer, Bruce B. Blackmon, David S. Citron, J. J. Pence, Jr., Joyce H. Reynolds and Bryant L. Galusha were present. Also present were Bryant D. Paris, Jr., Executive Secretary, Betty Joe Barick, Assistant Executive Secretary, Diane G. Freeman and Lee A. Denney, Investigator.

Monday, June 12
2:00 p.m.

The Board convened for business and reviewing applications of those physicians applying for license by endorsement of credentials.

Following discussion regarding the role of the Board's investigator, Dr. Wilkerson moved that the Board's investigator act at the request of and for the Board of Medical Examiners only. Seconded by Dr. Citron and duly passed.

RE: Dr. Beverly Ann Olson, Greensboro, N.C. -- The Board reviewed information from Dr. Olson regarding her attempt to get her photograph certified by the dean of her medical school in Italy, which was not successful. Dr. Galusha moved that the credentials Dr. Olson presented in lieu of certified photograph from her medical school, which was a photograph certified by the Consulate of the United States in Italy, be accepted by the Board, and she be granted a license by endorsement of credentials. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.

RE: Dr. Amukutty Paulose, Bronx, N. Y. -- The Board reviewed a letter from Dr. Paulose regarding licensure in North Carolina and the Board's requirements regarding citizenship status. Dr. Galusha moved that the Board advise Dr. Paulose that they will study the G-4 visa situation; that they appreciate her letter; and request her to send a copy of her standard certificate of the ECFMG, which is a pre-requisite to taking the North Carolina examination. Seconded by Dr. Citron and duly passed.

RE: McDowell Technical Institute -- Associate Degree Program in Emergency Medical Science. The Board reviewed correspondence from the North Carolina Division of Facility Services regarding the establishment of a two-year program at McDowell Technical Institute for teaching emergency medical science. Dr. Citron moved that the Board write Mr. Gentile with the Division of Facility Services, thanking him for his letter, and advising him that the Board shares his concern that all programs training mobile intensive care technicians should be solid and have adequate clinical faculties and adequate facilities, and the Board hopes that he will succeed in getting his message across to the appropriate authorities, and the Board would like to be certain that any new programs that are begun are of such quality to assure good service to the citizens of the State of North Carolina. Seconded by Dr. Galusha and duly passed.

RE: Dr. J. F. Hulka, Professor, Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology, University of N.C. School of Medicine, Chapel Hill, N.C. -- Following discussion of Dr. Hulka's letter regarding physicians coming into the state for a 48-hour training course in laparoscopic sterilization as developed at the University's School of Medicine, the Board's attorney was instructed to communicate with Dr. Hulka about this matter.

RE: Dr. Robert L. Hines, Chapel Hill, N.C. -- applying for resident's training license: Dr. Citron moved that Dr. Hines' request be approved for a resident's training license to cover him at Dorothea Dix Hospital through July 1, 1979. Seconded by Dr. Galusha and duly passed.

RE: Dr. Don J. Fowls, Chapel Hill, N.C. -- request for resident's training license. Dr. Galusha moved that Dr. Fowls' request for a resident's training license to work at Dorothea Dix Hospital be approved. Seconded by Dr. Blackmon and duly passed.

license. Dr. Galusha moved that Dr. Crisp's request for a resident's training license to work at Broughton Hospital until July 1, 1978 be approved. Seconded by Dr. Blackmon and duly passed.

RE: Dr. Carl W. Hoffman, Lumberton, N.C., and Michael T. Newton, P.A., Lumberton, N.C. -- Dr. Blackmon moved that the proper procedures be instituted to hold a hearing concerning the approval granted to Dr. Hoffman for the use of Michael T. Newton as an assistant to a physician by the Board on August 14, 1977, and Dr. Hoffman and Mr. Newton be so advised in writing. Seconded by Dr. Reynolds and duly passed.

RE: Dr. James Joel Leonard, Lexington, N.C. -- Dr. Wilkerson moved that a letter be written to Dr. Leonard as a follow-up to his last appearance before the Board in March, 1978, outlining matters discussed at that meeting, and requesting his appearance at the August, 1978 Board meeting. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.

RE: June, 1979 Board meeting -- Discussion by the Board on holding the June, 1979 Board meeting on different dates than is currently being done, which is at the same time and place as the FLEX examination is scheduled for. Dr. Blackmon moved that the Board meet on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, June 14, 15 and 16, 1979. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed on vote of three for, one opposed and three abstaining from the vote.

Dr. Pence moved that the Board meeting be held at The Velvet Cloak Inn, Raleigh, North Carolina on the dates indicated above. Seconded by Dr. Galusha and duly passed.

RE: Dr. Alton L. Bullard, Atlanta, Georgia -- The Board reviewed correspondence regarding Dr. Bullard's temporary reinstatement of his license to practice medicine in North Carolina. All reports have not been received regarding his past year's practice and work in Georgia. Dr. Citron moved that the approval for reinstatement of his license be extended until the August, 1978 meeting, and be placed on the agenda at that time for consideration. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.

RE: Conversion -- limited to full license: The following physicians have applied for conversion of their geographically limited licenses to full North Carolina licenses: Robert C. RE: N. C. Board of Pharmacy -- Dr. Reynolds, Dr. Blackmon and Dr. Galusha met with a subcommittee from the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy at the Board of Pharmacy's request to discuss the prescribing privileges of assistants to physicians registered nurses performing medical acts, and their dispensing privileges for medication. Dr. Reynolds reported that several problems had been discussed, one of which involved assistants to physicians and nurse practitioners prescribing for controlled substances when they are not allowed to do so. Another problem involved supervision of the assistant and nurse by the physicians, and the Board of Medical Examiners' responsibility

in monitoring the work of assistants to physicians and nurse practitioners. Dr. Reynolds reported to the Board that the Board of Pharmacy, at the conclusion of the meeting of the two groups, would continue to monitor any problems encountered regarding these situations, and keep the Board advised in the future.

Dr. Martel J. Dailey, Williamston, N.C. -- application concerning Gary M. Trube. Dr. Staub moved that the application be approved on a temporary basis until the August, 1978 Board meeting, at which time the protocol which has been approved by the Martin General Hospital medical staff for use by the assistant in the emergency department shall be reviewed by the Board, with the Board reserving the right to alter the protocol if they feel it is necessary. 
