The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met at The Hilton Inn, Raleigh, North Carolina, June 14-17, 1976 for the purpose of conducting examinations for licensure, interviewing applicants for license by endorsement of credentials and conducting other business.

Drs. Charles B. Wilkerson, Jr., Secretary-Treasurer, David S. Citron, Bryant L. Galusha, Jr., J. Jerome Pence, Jr., Frank Edmondson, and E. Wilson Staub were present. Dr. Vernon W. Taylor, Jr., President of the Board, was absent from this meeting due to illness. Also present were Bryant D. Paris, Jr., Executive Secretary, Mr. Lee Denney, Ms. B. Joe Cooke, and Mrs. Diane Freeman.

Monday, June 14

The Board convened for business and reviewing credentials of applicants for license by endorsement of credentials.

RE: Dr. Maurice Bakaleinik, Staten Island, N.Y. -- The Board reviewed Dr. Bakaleinik's request for special consideration for license by endorsement of credentials as he has not taken the FLEX examination and does not hold certification by an American specialty board and he is a foreign medical graduate.

Dr. Pence moved that Dr. Bakaleinik's request for special consideration for license by endorsement of credentials be denied, but he be advised that he can apply for the FLEX examination in North Carolina as a route to licensure in this state. Seconded by Dr. Edmondson and duly passed.

RE: Insurance coverage for Board employees -- Increased cost in employer contributions for Blue Cross/Blue Shield for insurance coverage, effective October 1, 1976.

Dr. Edmondson moved that the Board continue paying the same percentage of the monthly premium for Blue Cross/Blue Shield coverage for health insurance for Board employees as is done for state government employees. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.

RE: License certificates -- change in wording requested. Dr. Staub moved that the change in wording on the license certificates for female physicians to indicate the feminine gender when applicable be approved as presented by the Executive Secretary. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.

RE: License by endorsement -- interview procedures. The Board discussed possible changes in the interview process for applicants for license by endorsement of credentials which would involve individual interviews by a Board member when applicable. No action taken on this matter at this time.

RE: Meeting with representatives of SBI, DEA and N. C. Attorney General's office: Mr. Sidney S. Eagles, Jr., Assistant Attorney General, N. C. Department of Justice; Mr. Haywood Starling, Director, State Bureau of Investigation; Mr. Keith Bulla, Special Agent, State Bureau of Investigation; and Mr. Jack Bulla, Assistant Regional Director of the Baltimore, Maryland office of the Drug Enforcement Administration, appeared to discuss with the Board the activities of the Diversion Investigative Unit work of these agencies, which have been working together regarding the use of licit and illicit controlled substances.

RE: Registered nurses performing medical acts and assistants to physicians -- drug formulary. Dr. Pence reported on this Board's subcommittee's meeting with the Board of Pharmacy subcommittee and the subcommittee from the Board of Nursing regarding the drug formulary being drawn up as the guideline for assistants to physicians and registered nurses to write prescriptions. The new formulary for assistants to physicians and registered nurses to use in writing prescriptions which was presented to the Board for approval will not list in detail all drugs permitted, but will state that all drugs are permitted which are a part of the standing orders for that practice, with certain exceptions, which will be listed, such as:

No controlled substances

No parenteral preparations except insulin

All remaining exceptions relate to various classes of drugs, such as:

Antihistamines

Anti-infective agents

Anti-neoplastic agents, etc.

Under each of these categories, exceptions have been listed that are not considered safe for registered nurses and assistants to physicians to prescribe.

A copy of this formulary will be sent to supervising physicians of assistants and registered nurses performing medical acts with a cover letter explaining how this formulary was arrived at, and which will indicate other criteria by which prescriptions may be written, such as:

- (1) Every prescription written must be entered on the patient's chart and countersigned by the supervising physician within 72 hours;
- (2) Prescriptions will be valid for no longer than a 90-day supply or can be written for no more than 100 dosage units, whichever is less;
- (3) No refills on a prescription written by an assistant or registered nurse; every refill will have to be authorized specifically by an individual, i.e., that assistant or registered nurse by telephone, or some other means, so that a record will be made in the chart that a refill has been issued.

The formulary will be circulated with a statement that if any physician has any questions about which drugs are included in each of these groups, he can call his pharmacist for the answer. Pharmacy Board will be sending this out to all pharmacists in the state and telling them that these drugs are grouped according to the American Society of Hospital Pharmacists formulary.

Upon the subcommittee's recommendation of approval of the formulary and guidelines as drawn up by the three committees from the Board of Pharmacy, Board of Medical Examiners and Board of Nursing, Dr. Galusha moved that the formulary be approved as presented, with a copy of same to be sent to each Board member and any request for additional new drugs to be added to the formulary to be reviewed by the three committees before being approved by the Board. Seconded by Dr. Pence and duly passed.




