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WORK NOTES**CALL TO ORDER**

Harold L. Godwin, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., at the Embassy Suites Hotel, Raleigh, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Nicholas Emanuel Stratas, M.D., Secretary; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D., Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; John Wesley Nance, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

BROWN, David Houston, M.D. - Lillington, NC

On June 22, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Nance that Dr. Brown be issued an extension of his temporary license for two years.

HAYES, Albert Drake, M.D. - Shelby, NC

On June 22, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Godwin that Dr. Hayes be issued an extension of his temporary license for six months.

PERRYMAN, Peter Hubbard, M.D. - Charlotte, NC

On June 22, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Godwin that Dr. Perryman be issued an extension of his temporary license until October 31, 1989 and that this license be limited geographically to Charlotte, North Carolina.

OWENS, Robert Carl, M.D. - Morganton, NC

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Nance that the Board accept as information the report concerning this physician regarding his request for reinstatement of his license and that the Board inform Dr. Owens that the Board will consider this request when his obligations to the law are completed.

PATTERSON, Ronald Halford, M.D. - Aberdeen, NC

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding charges against Dr. Patterson. Dr. Patterson was represented by counsel, Mr. Clay.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board revoke Dr. Patterson's current license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

SIGNATURE STAMP

On June 21, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board inform the physicians in the State of North Carolina that the Board feels using a signature stamp on prescriptions is not the proper thing to do. Also, the Board instructed the Executive Secretary to distribute the Board's opinion in the next Board Bulletin and to notify the deans of the North Carolina medical schools of this decision.

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE: RUBBER STAMPED SIGNATURES

On June 21, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board draft a new rule whereby all prescriptions must be manually signed, no pre-printed prescriptions or rubber stamped signatures will be acceptable.

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE: SELF-PRESCRIBING

On June 21, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board effect a rule change specifically prohibiting prescribing for one's self and family members unless there is a doctor/patient relationship complete with charts, etc.

PHEP MEETING

On June 23, 1989, Dr. Stratas reported on the recent meeting he and Dr. Patterson had with Dr. Vanderberry of PHEP. He indicated that there are 32 named physicians in currently in the program and 30 "program" people who are now reported anonymously. It was decided at this meeting that if a physician is sick enough to be require in-patient treatment, it would be reported to Drs. Patterson and Stratas who would then determine if the full Board should be told.

Of the 30 physicians who are undisclosed, there are thirteen who are already known to the Board and those names need to be disclosed. The Board has no file on eight and four of those are non-licensed individuals who have not yet applied for a license.

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Nance that the Board accept this report as information.

MEETING SCHEDULE

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board approve the following dates for upcoming Board meetings in light of the discontinuance of the June meeting: May 16-20, 1990 and August 1-5, 1990.

PIEDMONT INTERNAL MEDICINE, P.A.

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Piedmont Internal Medicine, P.A." unless it is located in the the same town as Piedmont Medical Associates, P.A.

COASTAL EYE ASSOCIATES OF NORTHEASTERN CAROLINA, LTD.

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board deny the use of the corporate name "Coast Eye Associates of Northeastern Carolina, Ltd."

CENTRAL MEDICAL & SURGICAL EYE ASSOCIATES

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Central Medical & Surgical Eye Associates."

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board accept this letter as information only.

NATIONAL BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICAL EXAMINERS

On June 23, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board has no additional comments to the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiner's reply since all comments were presented at the meeting in Greensboro, and that the Board would be glad to meet with the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners at some future date.

DATA REQUEST: MILES DIAGNOSTICS INC. - Arden, NC

On June 24, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board of Medical Examiners issue Dr. Wax a Resident's Training License.

OZERE, Rudolph Lewis - Durham, NC

On June 24, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board of Medical Examiners approve Dr. Ozere for a resident's training license.

EMS REPORT

On June 24, 1989 the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 200 initial applications and 195 recertification applications for Advanced Life Support personnel submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services (plus two duplicates). The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 324 Bee Sting Certifications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

INVESTIGATIVE STAFF NEEDS

On June 24, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Daniel to increase the Board's staff by one investigator and one secretary as proposed by Mr. Paris.

PREVIOUS BOARD MEMBERS AS CONSULTANTS

On June 24, 1989, Dr. Godwin proposed that the Board consider asking past Board members to act as consultants to the Board to assist with the growing workload regarding investigative reports, patient record review, complaints, routine licensure interviews, and other appropriate areas of responsibility.

Dr. Godwin indicated that he would write a letter to past Board members to gauge their interest in this proposal. Mr. Paris and Dr. Godwin are to report back to the Board regarding the responses and possible procedures.

PHEP REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING

On June 24, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board advance \$20,000 to PHEP from its \$80,000 contribution budgeted for 1990 in order that an Assistant Director can be hired during September 1989. The Board stressed that this is not an extra \$20,000 but is an advance which comes out of next year's budget.

The Board congratulated Dr. Vanderberry on the Program's progress to date.

MEETING INTERVIEW SCHEDULES

On June 24, 1989, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the informal interview and licensure interviews be arranged to invite all the morning interviews at 8:30 a.m. and all the afternoon interviews at 1:30 p.m. and inform them that they will be seen as they arrive.

HEARINGS SCHEDULE

On June 24, 1989, Dr. Patterson asked that the Board consider handling hearing matters as follows:

If one of the Board members is going to review the chart and not be able to sit with the Board during the hearing, then take another member off the Board during hearings, maybe up to 3 members off, to do other Board business at the same time as the hearings are being conducted.

This matter should be an agenda item for August to consider setting up this procedure for the October meeting.
