

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF NORTH CAROLINA  
 Sir Walter Hotel, Raleigh, North Carolina  
 June 22-26, 1942

Dr. William M. Coppridge called the meeting of the Board of Medical Examiners to order at 9:00 O'clock Monday Morning June 22, in the Sir Walter hotel, Raleigh, N. C. Dr. Lewis W. Elias opened the meeting with prayer. Doctors William M. Coppridge, J. Street Brewer, Lester A. Crowell, Jr., Frank A. Sharpe, Lewis W. Elias, Karl B. Pace And Dr. W. D. James were present.

Dr. Fred Leinbach and Dr. Hamilton McKay of Charlotte appeared before the Board requesting that Dr. Paul Kimmelstiel be licensed to practice medicine in North Carolina. The Board decided to defer act upon Dr. Kimmelstiel until December 1942. Dr. Crowell moved that all discussion on Kimmelstiel be taken up at the December meeting.

Dr. Charlotte F. Walker was not granted license to practice medicine in North Carolina. She is a graduate of the University of Vienna. License was not granted to any graduate of a foreign school.

A committee from New Hanover, County Medical Society, Wilmington, N. C., doctors Frank Highsmith, Dr. Sam Carrington spoke against licensing foreign graduates.

Dr. Garrett D. Gardner of Asheville, N. C., appeared with Attorney Dixon. His license was revoked at this meeting for violation of the Harrison Narcotic act. His license number was 1926, issued June 6, 1908. Dr. Gardner had served a sentence.

Dr. Frank V. Taylor of Murphy, North Carolina appeared before the Board of Medical Examiners to plea for restoration of his narcotic license privilege. Narcotic privilege was granted.

Dr. J. S. Brown of Hendersonville, N. C. and Dr. W. P. Coppedge of Candor, North Carolina appeared before the Board of Medical Examiners for violation of the Harrison Narcotic Act. Their Narcotic license privilege was revoked.

Dr. Karl Moore of Newton Grove, N. C. appeared before the Board of Medical Examiners. At this meeting it was decided that it would not be necessary for him to appear again. He was not using any more morphine for his dysentery.

Credentials of 41 physicians were examined and they were granted license to practice medicine in North Carolina.

At 2:00 O'clock P. M. June 22, 131 students were registered for examination, 71 took either the last half or all four, 60 took the first half.
