MINUTES

Call to Order

Jack A. Koontz, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina called this meeting to order at 9:00 p.m., Friday, June 6, 1986. Board members present at this meeting include: Charles H. Duckett, M.D., Secretary-Treasurer; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; David S. Citron, M.D.; John T. Daniel, Jr.; Thomas E. Fitz, M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; and Mrs. Martha Kirkland Walston. F. M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D., Board member elect, also attended portions of this meeting.

Staff members present include: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Don Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Kathy Burke; and Sibyl Lamoreaux.

Incomplete License By Endorsement Files

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Fitz that, if an applicant fails to explain affirmative answers to routine questions in writing, the file is incomplete and will not be considered by the Board until the applicant furnishes written explanations.

Brewer, Thomas Edmund, Jr., M. D.

The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a continuation hearing on charges preferred against Thomas Edmund Brewer, M.D., at 2:30 p.m., Saturday, June 7, 1986. Dr. Brewer and his attorney attended this continuation hearing. At the conclusion of the continuation hearing, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion that it finds Charges 1, 2, 3, and 4 to be true; and that there is insufficient evidence to find Charges 5 and 6 to be true. The Board unanimously adopted a motion that it enter an Order stipulating:

1. The Board revokes Dr. Brewer's license for the period of one year.
2. The Board may consider a licensure application from Dr. Brewer at the end of one year provided that during this

time period he has continuously been in an unlicensed status and that:

- a. he has violated no state or federal law;
- b. he has been of good moral character;
- c. he has complied with all probationary terms imposed by the court; and
- d. he has not consumed any controlled substances other than those which may have been prescribed by another physician or dentist.

Bullock, Thurman Munroe, Jr., M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Fitz that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina prefer charges against Dr. Bullock on the basis of inability to practice medicine with a reasonable degree of skill and safety to patients and unprofessional conduct; that the Board offer Dr. Bullock the opportunity to sign a Consent Order stipulating: (1) he will refrain from all use of alcohol; (2) he will appear before the Board of Medical Examiners prior to engaging in the practice of medicine in North Carolina; and (3) he understands failure to comply with these conditions constitutes grounds for revocation of his license to practice medicine in this state. The Board unanimously adopted a further motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Fitz that, if Dr. Bullock does not agree to enter into a Consent Order, the Board of Medical Examiners hold a hearing on the charges preferred against him at its August, 1986, meeting.

Reece, Donald Brooks, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina prefer charges against Donald Brooks Reece, M.D., on the basis of his failure to comply with the conditions of a Consent Order, specifically this physician's failure to review and countersign physician assistant chart entries within twenty-four hours of physician assistant/patient contact.

Cotton, Peter Benjamin, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina offer Dr. Cotton the opportunity to apply for registration as a visiting professor.

Stuelke, Richard Gaylord, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that it extend Dr. Stuelke's temporary license until the Board of Medical Examiners can hold a hearing at its August, 1986, meeting on the charges preferred against this physician.

Bunch, John Dallas, III, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners hold in abeyance action on this physician's licensure application; that it complete an investigation of this physician's activities from medical school to the present; that the Board offer him the opportunity to withdraw his application for licensure in the state of North Carolina, and that, if this physician wishes to pursue licensure, the Board require Dr. Bunch to appear for another interview. As Dr. Bunch declined to withdraw his licensure application, the Board informed this physician that it will complete an investigation and will inform him of any future action.

Thomas, Edward Thurston, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion to waive the photograph requirement and to approve Dr. Thomas for a one year dated license. The Board also unanimously adopted a further motion that, if Dr. Thomas obtains the standard certificate of ECFMG on the basis of his having passed FLEX or on the basis of passing the ECFMG, the Board approve him for permanent licensure.

Russ, Zack, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Fitz that the Board of Medical Examiners accept as information a response from Dr. Russ to the charges preferred against him, that the attorney for the Board answer Dr. Russ' inquiries in an appropriate manner, and that the Board proceed with the hearing.

Clerkships, Public Hearing on

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners hold a public hearing on a proposed regulation change requiring all licensure applicants to comply with clerkship requirements, that the Board hold this public hearing at the October meeting, and that the Board of Medical Examiners effect these regulation changes no later than January, 1987.

Case, David Lawrence, M.D.

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Citron and seconded by Dr. Duckett that, pending receipt of further information, it hold action on this application in abeyance; and that, after the Board obtains this additional material, it request Dr. Case to appear for another interview.

Physician Assistant Subcommittee Report

Proposed Legislation

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Fitz that the Board of Medical Examiners accept as information correspondence regarding proposed legislation and that the Executive Secretary respond to correspondence concerning this matter appropriately.

Limited Licensure for FLEX Applicants

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Fitz and seconded by Dr. Alexander to table a discussion on issuing licenses limited to practice sites and time periods to physicians who wish to avail themselves of two opportunities to pass FLEX.

Fee for Resident's Training License

After discussion, the Board unanimously adopted a motion to accept a report concerning this matter as information.

Chiropractic Orthopaedist, Phoenix

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Fitz and seconded by Dr. Koontz that the Board of Medical Examiners write a letter stating this problem is properly a matter between Dr. Phoenix and the Board of Chiropractic Examiners and further stating that the Board of Medical Examiners has no statutory basis for involvement in this issue.

Zentner, Reid - Chiropractor Referral

The Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Executive Secretary communicate with the Attorney General regarding the status of this matter.

Electrolysis

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Fitz and seconded by Mrs. Walston that the Board of Medical Examiners write a letter stating the Board has reviewed the proposal on electrolysis and has decided to take no action on this matter.

Physical Therapy Question - Roper

The Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Koontz and seconded by Dr. Citron that the Board of Medical Examiners has no statutory authority to act on this matter.

Specialty Board Certification

Death Certificates, Signing

The Executive Secretary reported that a physician assistant may pronounce death, but a physician must sign a death certificate. The Board also discussed, in a nursing home, pronouncing death and processing death certificates is a local option matter.

Approved Formulary

The Board of Medical Examiners discussed prescribing birth control pills as it relates to the Approved Formulary, approving a specific request for an exception to the Approved Formulary, and abolishing the Approved Formulary. The President instructed that the staff obtain reactions from extenders, the Board of Pharmacy, and the Board of Nursing on this matter and report these reactions to the Board at a future meeting.

Professional Directories, Inc., Data Request

Mrs. Walston, Chairperson of the Physician Assistants Subcommittee of the Board of Medical Examiners, presided during this meeting. Representatives of the North Carolina Association of Physician Assistants present were: Dan Vetrosky, Mark Katz, John Bolles, and Wayne Von Seggan. Mrs. Walston stated that last year the Board of Medical Examiners and representatives of the North Carolina Association of Physician Assistants decided to meet on an annual basis. She indicated that the Board has no agenda for this meeting.

Representatives of the Association of Physician Assistants distributed drafts of a proposed Informational Booklet for physician assistants.
