Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting July 16-17, 2003.

The July 16-17, 2003, meeting of the North Carolina Medical Board was held at the Board's Office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, NC 27609. MISCELLANEOUS

Presidential Remarks

Dr. Garrett commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were reported. He reminded all Board Members that any time they spend at the Legislature is not Board time.

Dr. Garrett welcomed all to the North Carolina Medical Board and the new surroundings. He thanked all staff that had a part in designing and putting together the facility and thanked All Hands for getting it done. He noted that the building dedication would be in September and that Mrs. Jenny Dees, widow of Dr. John Dees, Past President of the North Carolina Medical Board, would be present for the dedication.

New Board Members – Ms. Shikha Sinha and George L. Saunders, III, MD

Dr. Garrett read the Oath of Office to Ms. Sinha and Dr. Saunders. He then welcomed and introduced Ms. Sinha and Dr. Saunders as newly appointed Board Members.

Kathryn Andolsek, MD – Proposal to Develop an Instructional Program on Physician Impairment

Dr. Andolsek, Associate Director, GME, Duke University Hospital stated she is also representing Robert Cefalo, MD, Head, Office of Graduate Medical Education, UNC Hospitals. They would like to partner with the Medical Board to develop a model instructional program on physician fatigue, impairment and patient safety. Residency programs are now required to teach faculty and residents to recognize the signs of fatigue and adopt and apply policies to prevent and counteract its potential negative effects. She and Dr. Cefalo have had conversations and are searching for funding to develop the type of program they feel necessary. This could also be used as a training tool for physician assistant students, medical students, nurse practitioner students, etc. Other groups that might find this useful would be the various medical directors in the various hospitals. She understands that many are volunteer, practicing clinicians without any formal training to recognize signs of physician fatigue. They hope to have several groups working with them and hope the Medical Board will be one of these groups. They need up front money to develop the funding proposal. They want to present the Grant Proposal to the Josiah Macy Foundation in the Fall. If successful in receiving the grant, they propose a three-year timeline during which time they would develop and implement the following: a web site; two CD ROMs consisting of common scenarios of how impairment manifests itself; one CD ROM for faculty members with teaching strategies for how to integrate the two CD ROMs with their learners; a fourth CD ROM targeted for hospital medical staffs, credentialing offices to address their recognition of and management of impairment in their settings; a workshop component; and an evaluation component. They want \$15,000 from the Board to be used for writing the Grant Proposal.

Dr. Andolsek then took questions from the Board Members. Most important would be to use the Board's endorsement in this grant presentation to the Foundation and second would be the monetary support. They are going to do something whether they get the Foundation grant or not.

The general consensus of the Board was that this is a good idea, however, upon consideration of the appropriateness of making a grant with licensee money and the Board's financial resources, the Board concluded that there would be no contribution at this time.

Motion: A motion passed to decline the request for funding.

Human Resources Director

Mr. Henderson introduced Ms. Pam Rose as the new Human Resources Director. She will be starting September 1, 2003.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Executive Committee of the North Carolina Medical Board was called to order at 11:45 am, Wednesday July 16, 2003 at the offices of the Board. Present were: Charles L. Garrett, MD, Chair; Stephen M. Herring, MD; Harlan A. McCulloch, MD; Robert C. Moffatt, MD and Walter J. Pories, MD. Aloysius P. Walsh was also in attendance. Members of the staff in attendance were R. David Henderson, (Executive Director), Hari Gupta (Director of Operations), and Peter T. Celentano, CPA (Comptroller).

Financials

Mr. Celentano, CPA, presented to the committee the May 2003 compiled financial statements. May 2003 is the seventh month of fiscal year 2003.

Mr. Celentano explained to the Committee that the Total Revenue thru the first seven months of fiscal year 2003 was 1% over the amount budgeted. Total Administrative Expenses are currently 3% over budget.

Dr. Pories made a motion to increase the amount in the Restricted Funds – Litigation account to \$2,000,000. Dr. Herring seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

Dr. Pories made a motion to accept the financial statements as reported. Dr. Moffatt seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

The May 2003 Investment Summary was reviewed and accepted as presented.

Old Business

Registration fees: Mr. Henderson handed out a chart that summarized the physician registration fees collected by other states that had a physician population of over 15,000. The information contained current registration fees to date. Dr. Garrett stated North Carolina was on the low end of the 22 states surveyed. The current average of these 22 states is just over \$200.

Renovation update: Mr. Gupta gave an update on the building renovations. He presented to the Committee that work is nearing completion. Dr. Pories made a motion wishing to formally thank the staff for all the hard work done to complete the building purchase and renovation. Dr. McCulloch seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

The dedication ceremony for the new building will occur on September 17, 2003. Mr. Henderson stated he would be sending out a proposed guest list within the next week.

New Business

2005 Board meeting dates: Dr. Garrett reviewed the 2005 Board meeting dates. The Committee reviewed the calendar and no objections or conflicts were noted. Dr. Pories made a motion to approve the 2005 Board meeting dates. Dr. McCulloch seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

Nominations of New Officers: The meeting went into closed session in order to discuss nominations for officers for fiscal year 2004. The meeting went back into open session. Dr. Moffatt made a motion to nominate Dr. Stephen Herring as President, Dr. Charles Garrett as President-Elect, Dr. Harlan McCulloch as Treasurer, and Mr. Aloysius Walsh as a member at-large of the Executive Committee. Dr. Pories made a motion to nominate Dr. Robert Moffatt as Secretary.

Human Resource Position – new hire: Mr. Henderson stated that a Human Resource Director has recently been hired. Ms. Pamela Rose will be a part-time employee who is scheduled to start on September 1. All departments are now fully staffed once again.

2004 Fiscal Year Budget: Mr. Henderson gave a brief summary of the timetable for the fiscal year 2004 budget. Dr. Garrett stated that the Executive Committee would like to have the budget available for review in September and the full Board could approve in October.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:25 pm.

NP Joint Subcommittee, 12:30pm, NCMB

JSC –Everyone from both Boards were seated. The e-mail vote on the rule to allow substitute representatives was affirmed. We had substitute members from both Boards participating in the meeting.

- NP Rule changes: The rule changes to which both the BoN and NCMB had agreed were adopted and will be moved on. Several changes proposed by the NCMB were discussed and adopted: definition of collaboration was struck; definition of primary supervising physician was replaced as proposed by NCMB, including a reference to the CPA; “method of identification” language was accepted.

- Rule changes that were proposed by the NCMB that were not originated by the JSC were tabled: deletion of the “interim status” and “temporary approval”; reinstatement of language pertaining to interruption of work due to change in nurse licensure status. These issues, and perhaps others, will be discussed at future JSC meetings with final recommendations from the committee going to both Boards.

UPDATE: When the above report was presented to the Full Board the following motion was made and passed:

Motion: (WP, RM) A motion passed that the Medical Board does not approve the proposed NP Rule changes adopted by the NP Joint Subcommittee, and that the Joint Subcommittee should consider adopting the NP Rules as modified by and previously approved by the Medical Board in their entirety.

CPP

- We discussed how to administratively manage requests for change in Status of a CPP application: i.e. addition of new back up supervising physician or expansion of a drug list. We do not feel this will require a rule change.
- Scope of practice for CPP’s was discussed. We request guidance from the Board on this issue. Currently there are 40 odd approved CPP’s. Before there is a more extensive basis of “historical precedent” we need to have clear boundaries on scope of practice that we then get agreement on from the Board of Pharmacy.

The committee reviewed minutes from the May 13, 2003 EMS Disciplinary Committee meeting and accepted as information.
