Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting June 16-17, 2004.

The June 16-17, 2004, meeting of the North Carolina Medical Board was held at the Board's Office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, NC 27609. ## **MISCELLANEOUS**

### **Presidential Remarks**

Dr. Herring commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were reported.

### **Logistics Problems**

In order to accommodate Board Members and facilitate a smooth meeting, the Board contracts with a nearby hotel. At this meeting the hotel could not honor these reservations and had to find alternate accommodations for the Board Members. The difficulties were compounded by little advance notification resulting in Board Members finding out during evening check-in, and the distant location of the alternate accommodations. There were concerns about future contracts with the hotel.

A representative from the hotel, Ms. Hughes, spoke with the Board and explained that they had an unusual number of guests that decided to stay over their scheduled booking. She took questions from Board Members and assured them there was little chance of this ever happening again.

### **July Board Meeting Schedule**

Due to the change in Board Meeting schedule formats, Mr. Henderson took time to review the draft of the July 2004 Board Meeting schedule with and solicit input from the Board.

### **Continuing Medical Education (CME) Rules Review**

Mr. Henderson reviewed Title 21, Chapter 32R, Rules 101-104 of the North Carolina Administrative Code with the Board. These rules require all physicians with an active license to complete at least 150 hours of practice-relevant continuing medical education (CME) within a three-year period. Of the 150 hours, at least 60 must be Category 1, Educational Provider-Initiated CME. The balance of the 150 hours can be Physician-Initiated CME (Category 2). He stated that since the rules went into affect in 2001 this is the first three-year cycle that will be reviewed and audited. He indicated that the initial data-pull from registration forms revealed a larger than expected number of physicians not meeting the 150-hour three-year requirement.

Licenses not meeting the minimum CME requirements will be sent a letter with several options including but not limited to placing their license on Inactive Status. If no response is received within 90 days of the initial letter then a certified letter will be sent. After service of the certified letter they will be referred to the Investigative Department for processing and possible discipline.

Dr. Rhyne noted that Medical Review of North Carolina is sponsoring CME Quality Improvement Projects which are free. Any practitioner can log on and get credit.

### **Legislative Update**

Mr. Henderson stated that Mr. Mansfield is the Board's Legislative Liaison and, as such, has been available to the Legislature for any questions including but not limited to Senate Bill 1414, Medical Board Fees. He indicated that this bill had passed the Senate and has been referred to the House Committee on Finance.

### **Optometrists Performing Certain Injections**

A motion passed to close the session to prevent the disclosure of information that is confidential pursuant to section 90-8, 90-14, 90-16, 90-21.22 and 143-318.11(a) of the North Carolina General Statutes and not considered a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the General Statutes and to preserve attorney/client privilege.

Ms. Bason, Board Attorney, discussed legal matters regarding litigation with the Board of Examiners in Optometry in a closed session.

A motion passed to return to open session.
