Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting of June 14-16, 2006.

MISCELLANEOUS

Presidential Remarks

Dr. Moffatt commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were noted.

MINUTE APPROVAL

Motion: A motion passed that the May 17-19, 2006, Board Minutes are approved as presented.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT

BARBER, Robert Anthony, DO

On March 1, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Barber with unprofessional conduct for practicing below the minimum standard of practice for failing to document prescriptions in patient charts, prescribing long term use of anxiolytics/hypnotics without exploring alternatives and other prescribing irregularities.

Dr. Barber was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

BARR, John Findley, MD - Cleveland, NC

On February 28, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Barr with unprofessional conduct for failing to adequately supervise his physician assistant by failing to uncover that his PA was ordering extensive testing without medical or clinical indications, and improperly billing the insurance providers.

Dr. Barr was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

BASILI, Richard Louis, Jr., MD

June 16, 2006

On April 26, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Basili with being unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety after being diagnosised as suffering from psychosis and having delusional thought patterns and failing to respond to the Board.

Dr. Basili was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Katherine Carpenter.

BOARD ACTION: The Medical Board found the following: 1. Dr. Basili committed unprofessional conduct; 2. Dr. Basili failed to respond to a Board order; and 3. Dr. Basili is unsafe to practice due to a mental abnormality. The Board therefore ordered that Dr. Basili's license be indefinitely suspended and that Dr. Basili is not permitted to apply for re-licensure unless he has been evaluated by NCPHP.

BOTWRIGHT, Gene Robert, MD

On Mach 10, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Botwright with being unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety as the result of substance abuse and unprofessional conduct for providing a false or misleading statement in explanation of his positive drug screen.

Dr. Botwright was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006

BRODERSON, Joe Thomas, MD

(Out of State)

On May 2, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Broderson as the result of action taken by the Kentucky Board in which an Order of Emergency Suspension was issued based on a report that Dr. Broderson prescribed large quantities to MS Contin (morphine sulfate) to a few patients.

Dr. Broderson was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued.

CAGGIANO, Christopher J., PA-C

On February 28, 2006, the Board charged Mr. Caggiano with unprofessional conduct for ordering extensive laboratory testing which were not medically indicated or justified on several patients, billing insurance for test not done, allowing patients to refer to him as "Doctor," and forging his supervising physicians name on patient's charts as if the physician had read and cosigned the chart.

Mr. Caggiano was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

COYNE, Mark – Stoney Creek, NC

Dr. Coyne was charged with unprofessional conduct, for ordering test that may not have been clinically indicated and aiding and abetting in the unlicensed practice of medicine by relying on an unlicensed physician's interpretations. A Motion to b Continue was granted.

Dr. Coyne was represented by Ed Hollowell. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

DONALDSON, Brian Robert, MD (Out of State)

On December 22, 2005, Dr. Donaldson entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Alaska Board in which Dr. Donaldson would enter into a therapeutic relationship with a psychiatrist to monitor his mental health as well as agreeing not to treat female patients without a female chaperone.

Dr. Donaldson was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Katherine Carpenter.

The hearing was continued

FOULKS, Carl Alvin, MD - Fayetteville, NC

On May 15, 2006, the NC Medical Board charged Dr. Foulks with unprofessional conduct based on information that on or before approximately September 2005, Dr. Foulks closed his practice and left the state. Further, it appears that he did not provide his patients with sufficient advanced notice or information regarding obtaining their records.

Dr. Foulks was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Katherine Carpenter.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

GHEN, Mitchell, MD – Lundrum, SC (Out of State)

On January 26, 2006, Dr. Ghen was charged engaging in the unlicensed practice of medicine for interpreting tests for a NC physician while not possessing a North Carolina medical license.

Dr. Ghen was represented by Denise Stanford. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

GREER, Michael Edward, MD – Seattle, WA (Out of State)

In October 2005 the Washington Medical Board through an Agreed Order, suspended Dr. Greer's medical license for five years, the suspension was stayed provided Dr. Greer complied with the restrictions and requirements of the Agreed Order, based on findings that Dr. Greer failed to act in a prudent manner in his management of a patient labor and delivery and that he prescribed medications without medical justification to 5 patients.

Dr. Greer is not represented by counsel. The Board is represented by Todd Brosius.

The hearing was continued to

JEMSEK, Joseph, MD – Hunterville, NC June 14-15, 2006

Dr. Jemsek was charged with unprofessional conduct for treating patients A-E for Lyme disease without any historical, physical, serological or other laboratory evidence.

Dr. Jemsek was represented by Jim Wilson. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

BOARD ACTION: One year suspension, stayed upon conditions that will be determined at the July Board meeting.

KLEPACH, Garron Lewis, Jr., MD (Out of State)

Dr. Klepach was reprimanded and fined by the Virginia Board for failure to submit information to update his practitioner profile and with entering into a Consent Order with the Michigan Board for failing to report the Virginia discipline.

Dr. Klepach was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Katherine Carpenter.

The hearing was continued

LOCKE, Charles John, MD

(Out of State)

On July 19, 2005, the New York Board entered into a surrender order with Dr. Locke, in which the Board accepted Dr. Lock's surrender as long as he did not contest he charges which the Board alleged that the prescribed large amounts of controlled substances not justified by the medical conditions of Patients A and B.

Dr. Locke was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Todd Brosius.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006

LOZANO, Joseph John, MD – Pisgah Forest, NC

On December 15, 2005, the Board charged Dr. Lozano with 3 counts of unprofessional conduct for violations of patient-physician boundaries and prescribing controlled substances without appropriate documentation in patient's charts.

Dr. Lozano was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Brian Blankenship.

The hearing was continued to July 21, 2006

PERDIKIS, George, MD

(Out of State)

The NC Medical Board charged Dr. Perdikis based on action taken by the California Board, whereby Dr. Perdikis' medical license was placed on probation upon findings of gross negligence, repeated negligent acts, acts on incompetence and acts of dishonesty.

Hearing scheduled for June 14, 2006, at 8:00am

Dr. Perdikis was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Todd Brosius.

PRESNELL, Tammy, PA – Reidsville, NC

Dr. Presnell was charged with unprofessional conduct for self-prescribing samples of Ultram and for self-treating and diverting hydrocodone prescriptions for a purpose other than it was intended. PA Surrendered her license.

Dr. Presnell was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

RUIZ, Estaban Alfonzo, MD (Out of State)

On March 9, 2006, the Board charged Dr. Ruiz with having a Final Order entered by the Florida Medical Board in which Dr. Ruiz was fined, issued a letter of reprimand, ordered to perform 50 hours of community service and an additional 4 hours of CME in the area of risk management based on allegations that Dr. Ruiz failed to follow up with appropriate diagnosis and treatment following an abnormal CT scan with a possible liver malignancy.

Dr. Ruiz was not represented by counsel. The Board was represented by Marcus Jimison.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

UEDA, Robert Kazuo, MD – N. Canton, OH

On April 28, 2006, the North Carolina Medical Board denied Dr. Ueda's application based on an action taken by the Florida Board incorrectly answering several questions on his Florida application and failing to disclose probation in postgraduate training. Additionally, the Board found that Dr. Ueda was placed on probation during medical school and took the USMLE Step 3 multiple times before passing.

Dr. Ueda was represented by Mary Wells. The Board is represented by Brian Blankenship.

The hearing was continued to August 16, 2006.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Lustgarten, Gary James MD

CASE SUMMARY: In November 2003 the Board suspended Dr. Lustgarten's license for one year. Wake County Superior Court Chief Resident Judge Donald Court affirmed the Boards one-year suspension of Dr. Lustgarten's license. Dr. Lustgarten appealed to the Court of Appeals. Oral arguments were heard in March 2006.

The Court of Appeals has now reversed the Superior Court's order affirming the one-year suspension imposed by the Board against Dr. Lustgarten and ordered that disciplinary proceedings against Dr. Lustgarten be dismissed.

BOARD ACTION: Motion passed not to pursue a petition for discretionary review in the North Carolina Supreme Court.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE:

House Bill 2021

Thom Mansfield and Brian Blankenship gave the Board an update on the status of House Bill 2021. They also asked that the Board vote to approve their recommendation that HB 2021 be amended to include a self-reporting requirement for licensees for certain arrests or indictments, specifically:

- (1) Any felony arrest or indictment.
- (2) Any arrest for driving while impaired or driving under the influence.
- (3) Any arrest or indictment for the possession, use, or sale of any controlled substance.

BOARD ACTION: The Board supports amending House Bill 2021 to acquiare the above-described self-reporting.

EXPERT WITNESS TESTIMONY

The Board discussed the possible need for a Position Statement regarding medical expert testimony. The Board voted in favor of referring the issue to the Policy Committee for study and possible development of such a position statement.
