Walter Glenn Lewis, M.D., Gibsonville, North Carolina

A hearing was held before the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina upon and concerning charges and accusations preferred by the Board in the above matter at the Pinehurst Country Club, Pinehurst, North Carolina, on Thursday, May 1, 1980, at which hearing Walter Glenn Lewis, M.D., did appear and was represented by counsel. Following this hearing and the presentation of evidence, the Board adopted a motion that charge number one was not proven and that charge number two was proven; the Board also adopted a motion that Dr. Lewis' license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina be revoked.

Edward Lenoir Jones, M.D., Thomasville, North Carolina

A hearing was held before the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina upon and concerning charges and accusations preferred by the Board in the above matter at the Pinehurst Country Club, Pinehurst, North Carolina, on Thursday, May 1, 1980, at which hearing Edward Lenoir Jones, M.D., did appear and was not represented by counsel. Office of Emergency Medical Service


