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MINUTES

**CALL TO ORDER**

Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called this meeting to order at 8:30 p.m., May 4, 1988, at the Pinehurst Hotel, Pinehurst, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D., Secretary-Treasurer; Charles Howard Duckett, M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; Nicholas Emanuel Stratas, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

**DEANS OF NORTH CAROLINA MEDICAL SCHOOLS, MEETING WITH**

On May 6, 1988, members of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met to discuss mutual concerns with the following physicians representing the medical schools in this state:

William Ewart Easterling, Jr., M.D., University of North Carolina School of Medicine,

Robert Bruce Kinney, M.D., Duke University School of Medicine,

Thomas Francis O'Brien, M.D., East Carolina University School of Medicine,

James Nicholas Thompson, M.D., Bowman Gray School of Medicine.

Members of the Board of Medical Examiners and representatives from the North Carolina medical schools discussed the following topics:

- (1) The Board's requirement that a physician extender wear an identification tag which contains the words: "physician assistant" or "nurse practitioner", rather than an abbreviation;
- (2) The Board's requirement that prevents physicians engaged in residency training programs from assuming supervisory responsibilities for physician extenders;
- (3) The Board's concern that, in Departments of Psychiatry, a Psychiatrist may provide psychoanalysis and/or psychotherapy to a physician in a Psychiatric training program and may also provide billing with a diagnosis to an insurance company;

- (4) The Board's request that a faculty member report to the Dean of a Medical school any physician exhibiting symptoms of impairment;
- (5) The Board's concern over a physician practicing in a pain clinic setting at a medical school who may discharge a patient and provide prescriptions for controlled substances which may result in a local physician's continuing to provide the patient with controlled substances indefinitely;
- (6) The Board's authority to issue special limited licenses when, in the opinion of the Board of Medical Examiners, a physician's outstanding credentials warrant this individual consideration;
- (7) Information indicating that the University of North Carolina is in the process of establishing an impaired physicians' program within its medical school and coordinate this program with the state Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program;
- (8) The Board's request that the Deans emphasize to physicians at their institutions the dangers of leaving prescription pads on desks; and
- (9) Information indicating that a pharmaceutical company has been providing physicians with unsolicited boxes of prescription pads advertising the particular company.

The Board requested the name of this pharmaceutical company. The President of the Board of Medical Examiners expressed the Board's appreciation to the representatives of the North Carolina Medical Schools for their scheduling time for, and participating in, this discussion of mutual concerns.

#### **FORMAL ACTION WORDING**

On May 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board include in each Consent Order the stipulation that the individual signing the document agrees that the content of this Consent Order is public information.

On May 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that, in the next Board Bulletin, the Board phrase each item in specific language from the North Carolina General Statutes.

**PERRYMAN, PETER HUBBARD, M.D.**, Buffalo, New York

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Alexander: that the Board issue Dr. Perryman a dated license expiring at the end of one year.

**BRANTLEY, CHARLES KENNETH, M.D.,** Raleigh, North Carolina

On May 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board extend Dr. Brantley's temporary license through July 1, 1989.

**MATTOS, SANDRA, M.D.,** Chapel Hill, North Carolina

On May 7, the Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners deny the license request of Dr. Mattos as a visiting professor and that the President of the Board advise Dr. Bondurant of this decision.

**CHELATION THERAPY**

On May 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion that it defer action on this matter.

**BRESSLER, BERNARD, M.D.,** Virginia

On May 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board accept as information a report indicating, effective April 25, 1988, Dr. Bressler has surrendered the medical license previously issued to him by the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina.

**TRANSCUTANEOUS PACEMAKERS**

On May 5, 1988, three sales representatives from firms who manufacture transcutaneous pacemakers demonstrated this equipment to the Board of Medical Examiners.

On May 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board believes it will be necessary to review more information on the use of transcutaneous pacemakers; that the Board approves the concept of a pilot study on utilizing external pacemakers; and the Board will schedule time at a later meeting to review a written report from the Medical Director of the Office of Emergency Medical Services in this regard.

## **PHYSICIANS HEALTH AND EFFECTIVENESS PROGRAM**

**PHYSICIANS HEALTH AND EFFECTIVENESS PROGRAM**

On May 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Executive Secretary communicate the following information to representatives of the North Carolina Medical Society:

- (1) The Board wishes to encourage the establishment of a Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program in North Carolina;
- (2) The Board of Medical Examiners understands that the North Carolina Medical Society will be the primary source of funding for this Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program;
- (3) The Board of Medical Examiners indicates its willingness to serve as a secondary source of financial support contingent upon:
  - (a) the Board's monetary resources,
  - (b) the Board's approval of plans for implementing the Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program in North Carolina,
  - (c) the Board's approval of the budget for the Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program,
  - (d) the Board's approval of the Medical Director for the Physicians Health and Effectiveness Program, and
  - (e) the Board's receiving information from the North Carolina Medical Society identifying the priority which this Program takes in the Medical Society's current budget and reporting methods by which other states secure funding for Physicians Health and Effectiveness Programs.

On May 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board increase its registration fee to \$70.00.

The Board also instructed the Executive Secretary to prepare for the Board of Medical Examiners' consideration a projected three year budget.

#### **PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board adopt the proposed regulations entitled "Impaired Physicians" and "Reinstatement of Suspended License."

#### **PHYSICIAN EXTENDER QUESTION REGARDING VERBAL ORDERS**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that a physician must originate all controlled substance orders. A physician extender, either a nurse practitioner or a physician assistant, may, upon receiving an order for a controlled substance from a supervising physician, simultaneously transmit this physician's verbal order to a nurse. A physician extender may write an order for a controlled substance provided that a supervising physician is also at the site to sign this order immediately. A physician extender may not independently order, either by writing or phoning, a controlled substance. A physician who supervises the extender must directly originate the order for a controlled substance.

#### **NURSES - DAY CARE CENTER**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board notify Thad B. Webster that his concerns regarding the activities of public health nurses have been resolved.

#### **ALTERNATE WORDING FOR PHYSICIANS WHO CEASE PRACTICING MEDICINE**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board approve the following alternate wording to be used in situations involving physicians who cease practicing medicine in North Carolina for other than derogatory reasons:

I hereby request that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina retire my medical license. I am no longer practicing medicine and, therefore, have no need to maintain my license in an active status.

**GARDNER, ROBERT EDWARD, M.D.**, Murphy, North Carolina

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board accept as information a report indicating Dr. Gardner surrendered his North Carolina medical license effective April 7, 1988.

**BRUCKERT, JOSEPH WALTER, M.D., Durham, North Carolina**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board deny Dr. Bruckert's request for licensure.

**KAHN, ERIC LEE, M.D., Fayetteville, North Carolina**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board issue Dr. Kahn a one year dated license; that, should Dr. Kahn advise the Board of Medical Examiners he wishes to extend this license, the Board interview him prior to approval of further licensure in this state.

**SPEX SCORES**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board accept as information a report indicating all physicians who took this examination in March, 1988, passed it.

**EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES REPORT**

Dr. Daniel presented a report on the advanced life support certification applications, advanced life support recertification applications, and bee sting certification applications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board approve these applications.

**MISCHINSKI, MATTHEW MAXMILIAN, M.D., Pinehurst, North Carolina**

At the conclusion of this interview, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board rescind the license approval previously issued to Dr. Mischinski. The Executive Secretary reported to the Board of Medical Examiners that Dr. Mischinski indicated his willingness to relinquish the licensure approval issued to him in March, 1988.

**CHECK SIGNING AUTHORIZATION**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board approve Mrs. Green to sign checks on behalf of the Executive Secretary when he is unavailable.

**MINI-RESIDENCIES**

On May 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that, in accordance with previous action regarding physicians' engaging in mini-residencies at East Carolina University School of Medicine, the Board approve the practice of medicine by physicians' engaging in mini-residency programs at the University of North Carolina School of Medicine.


