Induction of New Board Members

Dr. Reynolds: Do you, Thomas E. Fitz, M.D., Jack Koontz, M.D., and Frank N. Sullivan, M.D., accept the position as a member of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina and agree to perform the duties of this position to the best of your ability?

Certificates of Licensure

The Board adopted a motion that future certificates of licensure to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina issued in the name of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina will bear the printed facsimile of the signatures of all the members of the Board except that of Thomas E. Fitz, M.D., Jack Koontz, M.D., and Frank N. Sullivan, M.D. Drs. Fitz, Koontz, and Sullivan are authorized to affix their signatures to the certificates of licensure hereafter issued by the Board, which signatures shall constitute certification in the name of the Board that the licensees to whom the certificates are issued have duly met the qualifications and requirements for issuance of licenses to practice medicine in North Carolina.

Edward R. Polk Spicer, M.D., Salisbury, North Carolina

Patients in Nursing Homes with Chronic Brain Syndrome

Dr. Blackmon discussed with the Board the problem of grossly confused patients in nursing homes. The Board adopted a motion that the Board's attorney be requested to determine whether this is a problem for the Medical Society or for the Board of Medical Examiners, and that if the attorney determines this matter is within the jurisdiction of the Board it be recommended to the North Carolina Department of Mental Health or to the Department of Justice to provide nursing homes with locks and fences.

Philip Arzt Kees, M.D., Raleigh, North Carolina

The continuation of the hearing was held at the Pinehurst Hotel, Pinehurst, North Carolina, on Thursday, January 15, 1981, at 9:00 a.m., at which hearing Dr. Kees did appear and was represented by counsel. The hearing is to be continued according to a schedule yet to be determined.

John Hulon Cox, M.D., Winston-Salem, North Carolina

The Board reviewed a letter from Dr. Cox. The Board adopted a motion that no action be taken concerning Dr. Cox's request for the reinstatement of his medical license. Further the Board indicated that it is still awaiting a report from Dr. Grant and is also requesting a list of the continuing medical education courses taken by Dr. Cox.

Proposed Corporation Name: Physicians for Women, Ltd.

John Stanford Noell, M.D., Raleigh, North Carolina

The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Noell be issued a temporary license for a period of one year to practice in a supervised environment approved by the Board, that he appear before the Board again in six months, and that, upon receipt of a release signed by Dr. Noell, Dr. Blackley be furnished with information concerning the status of Dr. Noell's license in North Carolina.

James R. Hughes, M.D., Goldsboro, North Carolina

Dr. Hughes appeared as requested. The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Hughes be commended on the progress he has made and that he be requested to appear before the Board again in one year.

Patricia Goodhall-Gunn, Islington, Ontario

The Board reviewed a request from Dr. Goodhall-Gunn to waive the standard certificate of ECFMG as a prerequisite to her taking the FLEX examination in North Carolina. The Board adopted a motion that the requirement for holding a standard certificate of ECFMG be waived and that Dr. Goodhall-Gunn be allowed to take the FLEX examination in North Carolina.

January, 1982, Meeting

The Board adopted a motion that the January meeting be held at the Pinehurst Hotel and that whenever possible board meetings be scheduled for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday rather than Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

George Altamont Little, M.D., Baltimore, Maryland

The Board reviewed a recommendation from the Board's attorney that Dr. Little not be requested to surrender his license voluntarily at this time because of the possible adverse effect of this action on Dr. Little's satisfactory probationary status in Maryland. The Board adopted a motion that this report be accepted as information, that the recommendation of the Board's attorney be followed, and that the Board's attorney request Dr. Little's attorney to inform the Board if Dr. Little wishes to practice in North Carolina.

Request for Addition of Electrical Defibrillation by EMT-Intermediate


The Board reviewed a request to allow EMT-I's to perform electrical defibrillation. The Board adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners does not believe that EMT-Intermediates have sufficient knowledge to perform defibrillation and that the Executive Secretary research the APA to determine how this matter should be handled.

Delays by EMS Personnel in Transmitting Patients to Hospitals

The Board adopted a motion that Dr. Pagter call Bob Bailey to inform him that the Board is concerned about these delays and believes that this matter should be solved in Raleigh rather than on the local level, and that Bob Bailey be requested to report his action on this matter to Dr. Sullivan so that it may be reported to the Board at the next meeting.

Medications Approved for use by EMS Personnel

Dr. Reynolds reported to the Board on a request of Dr. Stringer's to modify the list of medications approved for use by EMS personnel. 
