## MINUTES

### CALL TO ORDER

Harold L. Godwin, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called this meeting to order at 8:30 p.m., November 30, 1988, at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Nicholas Emanuel Stratas, M.D., Secretary; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D.; Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; John Wesley Nance, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Donald R. Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robert J. Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; and Betty Ann Preston.

### ALFORD, EARL CURRY, M.D. - Harlan, Kentucky

On December 2, 1988, at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding Dr. Alford's appeal of the Board's decision to deny approval of his application for a license to practice medicine in this state. Dr. Alford was represented by counsel.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board adopted a motion (by a vote of 7 to 1, with Dr. Godwin voting against the motion) made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that Dr. Alford be granted a temporary license with conditions as set forth by the Board.

### TOPE, JOHN JEFFREY, M.D. - Aiken, South Carolina

On December 2, 1988, at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing on charges preferred against John Jeffrey Tope, M.D., dated June 9, 1988.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board revoke Dr. Tope's license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina and that the DEA be notified of this fact.

### SARVOTHAM, S.S., M.D. - Grundy, Virginia

On December 2, 1988, at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding Dr. Sarvotham's appeal of the Board's decision to deny his application for a license to practice medicine in this state.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson that Dr. Sarvotham be granted a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

### **SPECIAL LICENSURE REQUESTS - VIP PROGRAM**

On December 2, 1988 the Board adopted a motion by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Patterson that individuals applying for licensure under the VIP program should, in addition to submitting the required letter from the Dean, submit a formal VIP application and appear before the Full Board for a licensure interview.

### **MEETING WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM DUKE MEDICAL SCHOOL**

On November 30, 1988, members of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met with Drs. William Bradford and Ralph Corey of Duke Medical School to discuss various items relating to the VIP program, use of questions similar to the ones used by the Board for applicants to the training program, impaired physicians programs, etc. The Board provided the doctors with copies of the new questions the Board adopted.

The Duke RTL program at the VA Hospital in Asheville was discussed. Duke has set up a Duke-affiliated interns and residents program at the VA Hospital in Asheville. However, the medical license reads Duke/Asheville and this facility has a separate recruiting program.

After much consideration and as a result of the meeting with the representatives from Duke, on December 1, 1988 the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that a letter be drafted and sent to all North Carolina medical schools that each dean or chief of the hospital be requested to design, implement and inform the Board of Medical Examiners by March 1, 1989 of the following:

1. A standard of reporting disciplinary actions to the Board as already required by our statutes;
2. Establish a PHEP program to include faculty, staff, interns, residents and others as they may see fit.
3. This program is to be affiliated with and consistent with NCPHEP in its execution and implementation.

This letter shall be hand-carried by Mr. Paris for discussion at each facility.

**PHYSICIANS AND SAMPLE MEDICATION**

On December 1, 1988, there was considerable discussion on physicians receiving sample medication and the potential for the abuse of same. It was noted that all controlled drugs must be inventoried by the physician. The Board adopted a motion by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Patterson that Dr. Alexander publicize the regulations concerning this subject in an upcoming issue of the Medical Journal. Also, a report of this nature should be included as soon as practical in the Board's bulletin, and a letter should be sent regarding this subject to all practicing physicians in the State of North Carolina.

**KILGORE, LARRY CHARLES, M.D. - Fayetteville, North Carolina**

Dr. Kilgore has now surrendered his license and is at Charter Northridge Hospital seeking treatment for his chemical dependency.

**RETIRED PHYSICIANS**

On December 1, 1988, there was considerable discussion on the matter of "retired" physicians still practicing medicine in the State of North Carolina. These are physicians who have notified the Board that they are retired and whose license has been "suspended" for failure to

register. Mr. Paris indicated that once the Board receives notification that a physician is retired and not renewing his license, a letter is sent thanking him for their service, placing his license in a "retired" category and informing him that he cannot practice medicine. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Stratas the this issue and a copy of the letter sent to retired physicians should be placed on the January agenda for further discussion.

### **MEETING WITH PHEP REPRESENTATIVES**

On December 1, 1988, the Board was joined by representatives of the NCPHEP, Drs. Wilmer Betts, Charles Vernon and Robert C. Vanderberry, Jr. (the new Medical Director of the program). Dr. Godwin acknowledged the need for confidentiality for those physicians who seek treatment from PHEP. To this end, Drs. Stratas and Patterson will review each case that is received by PHEP and will determine if, in their discretion, action needs to be taken by the Board.

Dr. Betts stressed the importance of both the Board and the Medical Society working together with PHEP to make it a success. Dr. Godwin commented that PHEP should not feel that reporting impaired physicians to the Board is comparable to throwing them to the wolves. He then described the many grades of limited licenses (i.e., limited to time, geographical areas, etc.).

Dr. Godwin asked what Dr. Vanderberry's plans were to publicize the "official" opening of PHEP. Dr. Vanderberry indicated that he plans to visit each medical society in the state. Dr. Patterson commented that he would like to have the lay persons in the state made aware of PHEP. Dr. Stratas also suggested that all medical schools, organizations, HMO's and solo practitioners be made aware of the services of PHEP. Dr. Godwin expressed the Board's desire for Dr. Vanderberry to assist in drafting Consent Orders when appropriate. Dr. Vanderberry requested that when the Board refers a physician to PHEP that it send along some background information to aid in treatment. The Board needs to have the physician sign a release to do this. Dr. Stratas commented that he, Mr. Paris, Dr. Vanderberry and Mr. Weddington will meet to discuss this matter further before the next Board meeting.

### **MAHAN, ROBERT GARY, M.D. - Salisbury, North Carolina**

On December 1, 1988, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Daniel that Dr. Mahan's temporary license be extended to January 31, 1989.

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Nance that the Board approve a corporation name change request from Carolina Psychological Associates, P.A. to Carolina PSYCH Associates, P.A.

**DATA REQUEST: M & M LEASING - Reno, Nevada**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Henry that this data request not be approved by the Board.

**DATA REQUEST: COASTAL CAROLINA COMMUNITY COLLEGE - Jacksonville, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that this data request not be approved by the Board.

**UNINSKY, ELIANE, M.D. - Sanford, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board accept Dr. Uninsky's letter voluntarily relinquishing her temporary license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

**WOJDYNSKA, MAGDA, M.D. - Carrboro, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board deny Dr. Wojdynska's application for a temporary resident training license on the basis that she has not completed the necessary clerkships.

**FEDERATION OF STATE MEDICAL BOARDS**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board nominate Dr. Duckett to the Federation's FLEX Board and that the Board, collectively and individually, do all that this necessary to aid Dr. Duckett's election.

**HMO'S**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board advise all HMO's, PPO's and other collective care institutions that they are subject to the same reporting procedures as others in the State of North Carolina under N.C.G.S. 90-14.13.

**STUELKE, RICHARD GAYLORD, M.D. - Durham, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board adopted a motion to extend Dr. Stuelke's temporary license for one year.

**LIPSEY, JOHN CRAWFORD, M.D. - Greensboro, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board adopted a motion to extend Dr. Lipsey's temporary license for one year.

**STAMLER, ARTHUR ALAN, M.D. - Carrollton, Alabama**

On December 2, 1988, after a review of the information, the committee, consisting of Board members Dr. Alexander, Dr. Nance, Dr. Stratas and Mrs. Willis, voted to issue to Dr. Stamler a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in North Carolina.

**BARRON, BRUCE JOSEPH - Spruce Pine, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board grant Dr. Barron a six-month temporary license, limited to the Blue Ridge Hospital System in Spruce Pine, North Carolina.

**WATSON, NEIL, M.D. - Raleigh, North Carolina**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board reaffirms its prior decision denying licensure for Dr. Watson, but that it would consider an RTL for him should he meet the necessary criteria.

**LEONHARDT, HANNAH V., M.D. - Danville, Virginia**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Mrs. Willis and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board issue Dr. Leonhardt another three-year license limited to the practice of Pathology.

**BRENDLINGER, DIRCK, M.D. - Richmond, Virginia**

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that Dr. Brendlinger be denied a license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

**REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSES SUSPENDED FOR FAILURE TO REGISTER**

On December 2, 1988, there was discussion of physicians whose licenses were suspended for failure to register. Dr. Patterson expressed his concern that physicians may be practicing medicine without a license. Mr. Paris indicated that notices are sent to physicians informing them they are not eligible to practice medicine.

On December 2, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the licenses be reinstated for those physicians as submitted.
