Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting November 19-21, 2003.

The November 19-21, 2003, meeting of the North Carolina Medical Board was held at the Board's Office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, NC 27609. MISCELLANEOUS

Presidential Remarks

Dr. Herring commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were reported.

He then made brief comments about how great staff and Board Member support is and his appreciation for all that Dr. Garrett has done. He announced his agenda for the Board this year: to complete the agenda; to recruit ideas, comments and concerns from Board Members, especially in regards to what direction they feel the Board should be going in; to work through the backlog of cases; and to continue to work under relaxed Davis' Rules of Order. He reminded the Board that email is potentially public information.

Reentry Into Active Medical Practice

Dr. Pories stated that many physicians encounter times when they must stay their practices for a variety of reasons that include illness, family responsibilities, military service, and

disciplinary actions by the Board. In such situations, cognitive, technical, and social skills may need to be refreshed to insure re-entry into their medical disciplines. Meeting these diverse educational needs is a complex challenge but one that is of great interest to the Board. He proposes a task force to study this issue.

Ms. Hunter-Buskey stated that these same issues affect physician assistants. She requested physician assistant representation on this task force.

Motion: (WP, EKF) A motion passed that the Board establish an ad-hoc Task Force for Physician and Physician Assistant Re-Entry that includes membership from the various parties with an interest in this project and that a report outlining the challenges and proposed solutions be presented to the Board at the March meeting in 2004. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Executive Committee of the North Carolina Medical Board was called to order at 7:35 am, Thursday November 20, 2003 at the offices of the Board. Present were: Stephen M. Financials

Mr. Celentano, CPA, presented to the committee the September 2003 compiled financial statements. September 2003 is the eleventh month of fiscal year 2003.

Mr. Celentano stated to the Committee that the Board would need to liquidate a portion of the certificate of deposit in order to pay current obligations. Dr. Moffatt wanted to be sure that this would allow the Board to meet all financial obligations going forward.

Mr. Celentano stated that this should only be a one-time transfer. Dr. Garrett made a motion to allow the staff to liquidate a portion of the remaining certificate of deposit in order to meet current obligations. This motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Dr. Garrett made a motion to accept the financial statements as reported. Dr. Moffatt seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

The September 2003 Investment Summary was reviewed and accepted as presented.

Old Business

Executive Director – Goals Document: The Committee reviewed a draft of a goals document that will be used next year to evaluate the performance of the Executive Director. The Committee made several recommendations to modify the document. Dr. Garrett made a motion to approve the goals document as modified. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

New Business

North Raleigh Hilton: Dr. Garrett made a request that the Committee recommend that staff notify the hotel, the North Raleigh Hilton, of certain items in the rooms that are not satisfactory. Mr. Henderson assured the Committee that the items discussed would be addressed.

Allied Health Committee: Dr. McCulloch updated the Committee on various items discussed during the meeting yesterday with the Allied Health Committee.

The meeting went into closed session so the Committee could discuss a matter related to personnel.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 am.
