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MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Harold L. Godwin, M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m., at the Holiday Inn-Airport, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: Nicholas Emanuel Stratas, M.D., Secretary; Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D.; John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D., Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; John Wesley Nance, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Donald R. Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robert J. Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; and Betty Ann Preston.

FISCHER, Joal, M.D. - Charlotte, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing on the notice of automatic revocation of the medical license of Joal Fischer, M.D., dated July 12, 1989. Dr. Fischer was represented by counsel, Jonathan Wallas.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, on October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board revoke Dr. Fischer's license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina for a period equal to the sentence handed down by the court; that said revocation be suspended for the same duration; that Dr. Fischer is to obey all laws; that Dr. Fischer submit a report once a year from the Chiefs of Staff at all hospitals in which he practices; and that Dr. Fischer keep the Board informed of his practice site and whereabouts.

DEAR, Guy de Lisle, M.D. - London, England

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing at the request of Guy de Lisle Dear, M.D. regarding the Board's denial of a license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina. Dr. Dear was represented by counsel, Robert Clay.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, on October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board deny Dr. Dear's application for licensure based on the fact that he does not have three years of postgraduate training as required by statute.

HAMILTON, James Greene, M.D. - Durham, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing on the notice of automatic revocation of the medical license of James Greene Hamilton, M.D., dated August 23, 1988. Dr. Hamilton was not present at this hearing.

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board revoke Dr. Hamilton's license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina.

PHEP SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

On October 18, 1989, Dr. Stratas presented a report of the PHEP Subcommittee. He indicated that he and Dr. Patterson met with Dr. Vanderberry and reviewed 31 program cases, sixteen of which the Board has requested release of the physicians' names. The procedure now used was discussed and a written procedure was presented. Dr. Stratas indicated that anonymity needs to be broken when:

1. a physician has been hospitalized
2. when there is possible or probable impairment in practice.

One or both of the PHEP Subcommittee members will review the files to see if the Board has an ongoing file on the specific physician. If there are no prior complaints and if the case report seems benign to the subcommittee, then the case will not be reported to the full Board. The question was raised if the above-mentioned procedures would abrogate the Memorandum of Understanding now in effect. The Board was assured that it would not.

On October 18, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board table the decision on the additional \$20,000 funding for PHEP and that the Board receive a financial report from the North Carolina Medical Society and the Medical Society Foundation by the December meeting for review by the PHEP Subcommittee. After the review of said financial report, the PHEP Subcommittee will decide whether a representative from the two aforementioned organizations should be scheduled to address the Board.

MEETING SCHEDULE

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the dates for the October 1990 meeting be October 3-7, 1990.

TRIANGLE OBSTETRICS & GYNECOLOGY, P.A. - Raleigh, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board deny the use of the corporate name "Triangle Obstetrics & Gynecology, P.A."

CENTRAL CAROLINA PHYSICIANS FOR WOMEN - Sanford, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board approve the use of the corporate name "Central Carolina Physicians for Women."

DATA REQUEST: SHAW AFB - Sumter, SC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board approve the data request of Shaw AFB.

DATA REQUEST: LANDCO DEVELOPMENT & REALTY - Cary, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board deny the data request of Landco Development & Realty.

DATA REQUEST: CHARLOTTE RADIOLOGY - Charlotte, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board deny the data request of Charlotte Radiology.

DATA REQUEST: HEALTH POINT CORPORATION - Winston-Salem, NC

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board deny the data request of Health Point Corporation.

DATA REQUEST: PARTNERS NATIONAL HEALTH PLANS - Irving, TX

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board deny the data request of Partners National Health Plans.

HOSPITAL MANDATORY REPORTING

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board send a reminder to the Chiefs of Staff of all hospitals, etc., of the mandatory reporting procedures.

UNC - FEES FOR PHYSICIAN TESTIMONY

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board inform the Legal Department at UNC that it is not a matter to be considered by the Board and that they should consult with their attorney.

SURRENDER OF MEDICAL LICENSES

On October 19, 1989, Mr. Paris presented a report of the procedures of other Boards in accepting or not accepting the voluntary surrender of a license by a physician who is having difficulty with the Board. As noted at the last meeting, Georgia does not accept such surrenders. However, both South Carolina and Virginia follow the same procedure that is now in effect in North Carolina.

Dr. Patterson indicated that physicians in difficulty who are allowed to voluntarily surrender their licenses are never held accountable for their actions.

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that no physician who is under investigation by the Board for an offense be allowed to surrender his license to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina, without the majority of the Board agreeing to said surrender. If the Board agrees to accept said voluntary surrender, the reasons for the surrender will be publicized.

PAST BOARD MEMBERS AS CONSULTANTS

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Patterson that no action be taken on the subject at this time, and that the Board will continue to think about the possibility of utilizing past Board members as consultants.

RESPIRATORY CARE PRACTITIONERS

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board deny the request from Duke University regarding the licensing of respiratory care practitioners.

ECU GRANT FOR VIDEO TAPE

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board accept as information the report on the grant from ECU for the video tape regarding drug seeking behavior.

CLINICAL ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM REPORT

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board accept as information Dr. Nance's report on the clinical enhancement program.

REGISTRATION OF LICENSURE APPLICANTS

On October 19, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Mrs. Willis that applicants be registered upon the action of the Board; that applicants do not have a choice to postpone licensure until after the January 1990 Board meeting to avoid paying the registration fee; and that the Board not change the current procedure.

BOYD, Arthur B., M.D. - Durham, NC

On October 20, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board deny Dr. Boyd's request to take Component I of FLEX in December since the deadline registration is past.

VICE-PRESIDENTIAL POSITION

On October 20, 1989, discussion was held on the creation of the post of Vice President of the Board and the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Nance and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the position of Vice President of the Board be created. Dr. Godwin asked that the Nominating Committee (Dr. Alexander and Mrs. Willis) meet to determine a candidate.

On October 20, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Stratas that Dr. Patterson be elected Vice President of the Board.

There was discussion as to whether this position would be a stepping-stone for the position of President, but it was stressed that there was to be no assumed progression to the position of President.

ELEMENTS OF A MODERN STATE MEDICAL BOARD - A Proposal by Dr. Citron

On October 18, 1989, Dr. Citron presented his proposal entitled "Elements of a Modern State Medical Board." He indicated that the proposal was in response to a request by the Bureau of Health Services for a development of a design of a modern medical licensing board. Dr. Citron reviewed several key areas of his proposal and indicated that each should be considered on its own and in the context in which it is provided. There is nothing in the proposal about disciplinary actions, licensure, etc. The proposal only deals with the board itself.

Dr. Citron indicated that he wanted to let the Board know that the North Carolina Medical Practice Act is a model for other states to follow. Dr. Alexander commented that he thought that this matter should be brought to the attention of the AMA. When asked by Dr. Godwin if he wanted the Board to take any action on this information, Dr. Citron said he just appreciated the opportunity to share his thoughts with the Board.

HEARING PROCEDURE

On October 20, 1989, it was reported that a quorum needs to be present at all hearings. On December 1, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that no Board action in this regard is needed and that it will be at the discretion of the Executive Secretary and staff determine if a change in the current procedure could be facilitated.

EMS REPORT

On October 21, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 81 initial applications, 91 recertification applications for Advanced Life Support personnel, and 11 duplicates as submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services. The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 219 Bee Sting Certifications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

EMS application forms - The request to extend the period of time that EMS applications are active from six months to 12 months was approved.

Temporary EMS certification - The request to grant temporary EMS certification in special circumstances was approved. (Dr. Godwin voted no.)

Orders to the field by non-physician/non-MICN personnel - Regarding the request that RNs be allowed to relay the doctor's order to the field, the Board adopted a motion that this be allowed with the modification that the RN must say it is the order of the doctor or MICN and that the EMS regulations be changed to reflect this, if necessary.

Co-signing MICN orders - The Board members discussed that MICN orders now need to be signed within 72 hours and that if an alternate ER doctor signed, phone documentation could be given within 72 hours but actual ambulance report could be mailed to get co-signature by the originating doctor or MICN. The proposed change by the Office of EMS was approved.

ADJOURNMENT

On October 21, 1989, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Henry and seconded by Dr. Nance that the Board adjourn this meeting.
