Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting October 20-22, 2004.

21 NORTH CAROLINA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CHAPTER 32 – NORTH CAROLINA MEDICAL BOARD

SUBCHAPTER 32F - ANNUAL REGISTRATION

21 NCAC 32F .0103 FEE

Each physician shall pay an annual registration fee ~~of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ to the Board ~~every year~~ in accordance with G.S. 90-15.1; ~~except, each physician holding a resident's training license shall pay an annual registration fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), and every physician who holds a special volunteer license shall pay an annual registration fee of ten dollars (\$10.00), and except that every physician who holds a limited volunteer license shall pay no fee.~~ an annual registration fee of \$25.00.

SUBCHAPTER 32M - APPROVAL OF NURSE PRACTITIONERS

21 NCAC 32M .0106 ANNUAL RENEWAL

(a) Each registered nurse who is approved to practice as a nurse practitioner in this state shall annually renew each approval to practice with the Medical Board no later than 30 days after the nurse practitioner's birthday by:

- (1) Maintaining current RN licensure;
- (2) Submitting the fee required in Rule .0115 of this Subchapter; and
- (3) Completing the renewal form.

(b) A nurse practitioner who fails to register as required by this section shall pay an additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the Board.

~~(b)~~ (c) A nurse practitioner with first-time approval to practice after January 1, 2000, shall provide evidence of certification or recertification by a national credentialing body.

~~(c)~~ (d) If the nurse practitioner has not renewed within 60 days of her/his birthday, the approval to practice as a nurse practitioner shall lapse.

SUBCHAPTER 32S - PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT REGULATIONS

21 NCAC 32S .0105 ANNUAL REGISTRATION

(a) Each person who holds a license as a physician assistant in this state shall register his or her Physician Assistant license each year no later than 30 days after his or her birthday by:

- (1) completing the Board's registration form;
- (2) submitting the fee required in Rule .0117 of this Section.

(b) A physician assistant who fails to register as required by this section shall pay an additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the Board. The license of any physician assistant who fails to register and who remains unregistered for a period of 30 days after certified notice of the failure is automatically inactive.

SUBCHAPTER 32S - PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT REGULATIONS

21 NCAC 32S .0117 FEES

The Board requires the following fees:

- (1) Physician Assistant License Fee - ~~one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00)~~, two hundred dollars (\$200.00), except that an applicant for a physician assistant limited volunteer license need not submit an application fee.
- (2) Annual Registration Fee - ~~seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)~~, one hundred dollars (\$100.00), except that any physician assistant who holds a limited volunteer license or who submits a statement to the Board confirming that the physician assistant is currently exclusively engaged in volunteer practice and has engaged exclusively in volunteer practice during the preceding year shall submit a reduced registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

21 NCAC 32T .0101(c) CLINICAL PHARMACIST PRACTITIONER

(c) Annual Renewal.

- (1) Each CPP shall register annually on the anniversary of his or her birth date by:
 - (A) verifying a current Pharmacist license;
 - (B) submitting the renewal fee as specified in Subparagraph (j)(2) of this Rule;
 - (C) completing the Medical Board's renewal form; and
 - (D) reporting continuing education credits as specified by the Medical Board.
- (2) A CPP who fails to register as required by this section shall pay an additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the Board.
- ~~(2)~~(3) If the CPP has not renewed within 30 days of the anniversary of the CPP's birth date, the approval to practice as a CPP shall lapse.

Change of Command

At the conclusion of the Board Meeting Dr. Herring made his closing remarks and passed the gavel to Dr Garrett who will be the new President effective November 2004. As part of his closing remarks, Dr. Herring passed out a copy of the minutes of the Medical Board's first meeting in 1859 A.D. to each Board Member. Dr. Garrett presented Dr. Herring with a mounted gavel and a framed resolution commemorating his service as the President of the Medical Board for the past year. The resolution reads as follows:

**In Recognition of the Distinguished Service Rendered by
Stephen M. Herring, MD, as President of the
North Carolina Medical Board
2003 — 2004**

WHEREAS, Stephen M. Herring, MD, of Fayetteville, North Carolina, who earned his BA degree at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, his DDS degree from the University of North Carolina School of Dentistry, and his MD degree from the Wake Forest University/Bowman Gray School of Medicine, and who did his internship in general surgery and his residency in general surgery and plastic surgery at Bowman Gray, and is certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery and holds licenses in both medicine and dentistry, has distinguished himself in his practice of medicine and has devoted himself to serving the people and the medical community of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Dr Herring was first named to the North Carolina Medical Board in November 1998 and served on the Board's Executive, Investigative, and Policy Committees, and he also served as chair of the Executive and Investigative Committees; and

WHEREAS, Dr Herring served as the Board's secretary from November 2002 through February 2003 and became president elect of the Board in February 2003; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2003, Dr Herring assumed office as president of the North Carolina Medical Board; and

WHEREAS, during his term as president, the Board enacted much needed changes to the physician assistant rules, the nurse practitioner rules, and the licensing rules and approved rules to permit qualified pharmacists to administer flu vaccines; and

WHEREAS, the Board made significant changes to its meeting schedule which has resulted in financial savings and increased staff efficiency; and

WHEREAS, due in large part to Dr Herring's efforts, the Board adopted a Position Statement entitled The Medical Supervisor-Trainee Relationship, which made clear abusive behavior in the medical education setting would not be tolerated; and

WHEREAS, Dr Herring spent countless hours preparing a North Carolina Medical Board Bench Book that will be an invaluable guide to future Board members regarding the conduct of meetings and hearings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the North Carolina Medical Board publicly recognizes the exceptional leadership that Stephen M. Herring, MD, has given the Board in his

role as the Board's president and deeply appreciates the distinguished service he has rendered the Board and the people of North Carolina; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be made part of the minutes of the Board and that a formal copy be presented to Dr Herring.
