
Dr. Thomas Leslie Lee was elected temporary chairman. Dr. Lee called the meeting to order and asked for nomination for president of the board. Dr. Charles W. Armstrong was unanimously elected president. The meeting was then turned over to Dr. Armstrong. The president then asked for nominations for the secretary and treasurer. Dr. Ivan Procter was nominated and unanimously elected. The president was elected for one year, the secretary and treasurer for a period of six years.

Anatomy, Embryology, and Histology	Dr. M. A. Pittman

Dr. Bonner and Dr. Parker agreed to alternate examinations on the subjects physiology and chemistry with medicine and therapeutics. Dr. Procter and Dr. Lee agreed to alternate examinations on the subjects pathology and bacteriology and gynecology and obstetrics.
