

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS
OF NORTH CAROLINA

Sir Walter Hotel, Raleigh, North Carolina
September 24-25th, 1950

The incoming Board of Medical Examiners, 1950-1956, met in joint session with the outgoing board, 1944-1950, at its final meeting at the Sir Walter Hotel, Raleigh, North Carolina, September 24-25th.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Newsom P. Battle, President, and an executive session was held. Drs. L. Randolph Doffermyre, Clyde R. Hedrick, Amos N. Johnson, James P. Rousseau, Heyward C. Thompson, and Joseph J. Combs, Secretary-Treasurer, were present.

The minutes of the organization meeting of June 19th, 1950 were approved as corrected; that Dr. Joseph J. Combs be elected to serve as secretary-treasurer of the board for six years.

Dr. Clyde R. Hedrick moved that the hospitals in the state be advised to notify residents at time of appointment that they should have limited license to practice medicine according to law; that this applies to all physicians except first year internes. This motion was duly seconded and passed unanimously.

Dr. Heyward C. Thompson moved that President Newsom P. Battle and Secretary Joseph J. Combs be elected as delegates to the February, 1951 meeting of the Federation of State Medical Boards in Chicago; that the delegates be allowed \$200.00 each in accordance with previous boards; provided, this is not sufficient to cover expenses an adjustment will be made. This motion was duly seconded and passed unanimously.

Dr. Clyde R. Hedrick moved that the next meeting of the Board of Medical Examiners be held at the Robert E. Lee Hotel, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, January 14-15th, 1951.

The board decided it would be a good idea if each member of the board would file a bibliography with the secretary.

The meeting was adjourned.
