<input type="checkbox"/>	Licensure status report	Secure a report regarding the status of licensure from at least one state, U.S. territory or Canadian province where you currently hold a full unrestricted active license for the previous five years immediately preceding the application.

<input type="checkbox"/>	U.S. citizen status/Immigration status	<p>Submit a photocopy of your birth certificate if you were born in the United States or one of its territories. If you were not born in the U.S. or one of its territories, submit a photocopy of a valid, unexpired U.S. passport.</p> <p>If you are unable to submit a photocopy of your U.S. birth certificate or passport, please provide a statement regarding your immigration status.</p>
