- The certification exam has changed from annual to biannual. It would be helpful if the exam was offered more frequently, perhaps quarterly.
- Does ABCP have the records of schools which were accredited but are no longer in existence? Can these records be made available to state licensing boards and/or applicants?
- ➤ The ABCP expenses & revenue are not made available. Where does the money that is paid for tests & renewals go?
