

## MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF NORTH CAROLINA

AUGUST 2, 1939 - LINVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

The Board of Medical Examiners of North Carolina met in Eseeola Lodge, Linville, N. C. on August 2nd to complete unfinished business from the June meeting. Dr. Karl B. Pace, president, called the meeting to order and Dr. Lewis W. Elias led in prayer. Dr. Karl B. Pace, Dr. Lewis W. Elias, Dr. W. D. James, Dr. Frank A. Sharpe, Dr. William M. Coppridge, Dr. J. Street Brewer, and Dr. Lester A. Crowell, Jr. were present. The minutes of the June Meeting were read by the secretary and approved. Each member of the Board brought his grades for each examination student.

All fifty seven candidates who took the examination passed and were issued licenses to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina. Those making the highest averages were Dr. Ottis Walker, 94.6%, graduate of College of Medical Evangelists; Dr. Elizabeth McCauley James, 93.9%, graduate of University of Pennsylvania; Dr. Mary Virginia Copeland, 93.8%, graduate of Tulane Medical College; and Dr. A. J. Gill, 93.4%, graduate of Duke University Medical School.
