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MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Eben Alexander, Jr., M.D., President of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina, called this meeting to order at 8:30 p.m., August 3, 1988, at the Pickett Suite Hotel, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina.

The Board members present at this meeting included: John Thomas Daniel, Jr., M.D., Secretary-Treasurer; Charles Howard Duckett, M.D.; Harold L. Godwin, M.D.; Hector Himel Henry, II, M.D.; Nicholas E. Stratas, M.D.; F.M. Simmons Patterson, Jr., M.D.; and Mrs. Kathryn Howell Willis.

Staff members present included: Bryant D. Paris, Jr.; Don Pittman; William H. Breeze, Jr.; Robert J. Broyles; L. D. Beaver; Kathy Burke; and Sibyl Lamoreaux.

IMPAIRED PHYSICIANS PROGRAM

On August 4, 1988, the Board members discussed the Impaired Physicians' Program. Dr. Godwin reported that there is a meeting of the Impaired Physicians Program Task Force scheduled for Sunday, August 14, 1988, at 2:00 p.m. Dr. Duckett indicated that he will be unable to attend this meeting. Dr. Godwin stated that he plans to be present and the Board of Medical Examiners appointed Dr. Stratas to replace Dr. Duckett as a representative of the Board to serve on this Task Force.

Dr. Godwin reported that the North Carolina Medical Society's representatives who have served as members of a Search Committee have eliminated all but four candidates for the position of Medical Director of the Impaired Physicians Program. Dr. Godwin further stated that, during the meeting on August 14, 1988, the Task Force plans to conduct telephone interviews with these four physicians and eliminate two of the present candidates.

On August 4, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Duckett that the Board appoint Dr. Stratas to replace Dr. Duckett as a member of the Task Force; that Dr. Godwin and Dr. Stratas participate in the selection process of the Medical Director of the Impaired Physicians Program; that the Board authorize its representatives to act on behalf of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina in selecting the Medical Director of the Impaired Physicians Program; and that Dr. Godwin and Dr. Stratas present a report on the selection of a Medical Director at the October 1988 meeting.

Dr. Patterson and Dr. Stratas voted in opposition to the portion of the motion which authorizes the Board's representatives to act on behalf of the Board of Medical Examiners in selecting the Medical Director and stated that they believed the full Board should interview the applicant for this position prior to final approval of a Medical Director for the Impaired Physicians Program.

On August 7, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board accept as information a report from the Executive Secretary indicating that the Board has made its first financial contribution to the Impaired Physicians Program.

KOLLER, BRIAN RICHARD, M.D., Durham, North Carolina

On August 4, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board extend Dr. Koller's dated license for a period of two years.

ROGERS, CHARLES WILBURN, M.D., Chapel Hill, North Carolina

On August 5, 1988, at the Pickett Suite Hotel, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding the Order to Show Cause issued to Charles Wilburn Rogers, M.D.

Dr. Rogers and his counsel attended this hearing; and, at the conclusion of these proceedings, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Mrs. Willis that the Board of Medical Examiners dissolve the stay of licensure revocation for Charles Wilburn Rogers, M.D., as the Board finds that Dr. Rogers did not comply with all the conditions set forth in the Order staying the revocation.

TRENT, LEE ROYAL, III, M.D., Greenville, North Carolina

On August 5, 1988, at the request of Lee Royal Trent, III, M.D., the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding events affecting the status of Dr. Trent's license to practice medicine in this state.

Dr. Trent appeared with counsel at this hearing. At the conclusion of the proceedings, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board of Medical Examiners revoke the license previously issued to Lee Royal Trent, III, M.D.; and that the Board suspend this revocation based on Dr. Trent's compliance with the following probationary conditions:

1. Dr. Trent shall be and remain of high moral character;
2. Dr. Trent shall obey all federal and state laws;
3. Dr. Trent shall comply with all the probationary terms set forth by the court;
4. In September, 1988, Dr. Trent shall take and pass the SPEX examination;
5. As soon as the Board receives the SPEX examination results, Dr. Trent shall appear for an interview with the Board of Medical Examiners;

6. At the time of this interview, Dr. Trent shall furnish the Board with documentation of completion of Category One continuing medical education relevant to his medical speciality area; and
7. When Dr. Trent furnishes evidence of compliance with these stipulations, the Board of Medical Examiners will reconsider Dr. Trent's licensure status.

Drs. Patterson and Henry voted in opposition to this motion.

BECAN, ARTHUR FRANK, JR., M.D., Florham Park, New Jersey

On August 5, 1988, at the request of Arthur Frank Becan, Jr., M.D., the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina held a hearing regarding Dr. Becan's appeal of the Board of Medical Examiners' decision to deny his application for a license to practice medicine in this state.

Dr. Becan appeared with counsel at this hearing. At the conclusion of the proceedings, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board of Medical Examiners re-affirm its previous decision to deny Dr. Becan's application for a license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina based on the Board's finding that Dr. Becan falsified an answer to a question on the licensure application. Dr. Stratas and Mrs. Willis voted in opposition to this motion.

WATSON, NEIL ALEXANDER, M.D., Raleigh, North Carolina

On August 4, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board deny Dr. Watson's application to practice medicine in North Carolina as this physician does not meet the Board's licensure requirements, nor does he meet the qualifications for registration as a visiting professor.

ALFORD, EARL CURRY, M.D., Raleigh, North Carolina

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina interviewed Earl Curry Alford, M.D., an applicant for reinstatement of his North Carolina medical license.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board of Medical Examiners deny Dr. Alford's reinstatement application on the basis of the Board's concerns regarding:

1. Dr. Alford's current medical knowledge and
2. Dr. Alford's competency to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients.

The Board also stated that, for the Board of Medical Examiners to consider approval of Dr. Alford's reinstatement application,

1. he must pass Component II of FLEX;
2. he must pass CESAP;
3. he must submit the results of a recent physical evaluation; and
4. he must agree to obtain annually a minimum of fifty hours of Category One continuing medical education relevant to his specialty area.

ACOSTA, MELANIO DILAG, JR., M.D., Parsons, West Virginia

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina deny Dr. Acosta's licensure application based on his failure to provide complete information in answering the malpractice question on the application form, specifically this physician's failure to inform the Board of two malpractice suits which have been filed against him.

LADAGA, LUCIANO GALBIZO, M.D, Paintsville, Kentucky

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board deny Dr. Ladaga's licensure application on the basis of the following concerns:

1. Dr. Ladaga's level of medical competency as demonstrated by the standard of care he provided a patient who has filed a malpractice suit against him; and
2. Dr. Ladaga's plan to practice emergency medicine which is outside the area of his specialty training.

BRIONES, DALMACIO, M.D., Chicago, Illinois

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board deny Dr. Briones' application for licensure by endorsement on the basis of this physician's lack of medical knowledge to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients.

WATSON, SUSAN AUSTIN, M.D., Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board issue a dated license to Dr. Watson effective September 1, 1988, and expiring October 14, 1988.

UNC-W PATIENT RECORD OWNERSHIP QUESTION

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas that the Board's attorney refer this matter to the Attorney General of the State of North Carolina.

CONSENT ORDER WORDING

On August 6, 1988, the Board requested:

1. that the Attorney and the Executive Secretary for the Board of Medical Examiners research and revise Consent Order wording to include a statement indicating that, if the individual entering into a Consent Order fails to comply with any of the conditions imposed by the Board of Medical Examiners of the state of North Carolina, this individual agrees to licensure revocation;
2. that the Attorney and Executive Secretary study the ramifications of issuing temporary licenses for disciplinary reasons without accompanying Consent Orders; and
3. that the Attorney and Executive Secretary report on both of these matters at the October 1988 meeting.

PHYSICIANS HEALTH AND EFFECTIVENESS PROGRAM REFERRALS

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Alexander that the Board refer individuals to this program by letter; and that the Board of Medical Examiners place copies of these referral letters in individual files.

MEETING WITH DEAN OF UNC SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

On August 3, 1988, the members of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina discussed the following concerns with Stuart Bondurant, M.D., Dean of the School of Medicine at the University of North Carolina:

1. qualifications for Registration as a Visiting Professor;
2. questions medical schools may wish to ask residents entering training programs;
3. physicians at Medical Center Pain Clinics discharging patients and referring them to local physicians for additional controlled substance prescriptions with no indication of dates for these patients to stop taking pain medications;

4. psychiatrists at Medical Centers providing psychotherapy to residents as part of training programs and billing insurance companies for such services; and
5. meeting with Deans of various medical schools in North Carolina as individuals, rather than as a group.

Dr. Bondurant stated that when he first assumed the position as Dean of the Medical School at the University of North Carolina, he benefited a great deal from exchanging ideas with both Board members and Deans from medical schools throughout the state. He believes the Board should meet with the representatives of North Carolina medical schools as a group a minimum of once a year.

In discussing general factors influencing medical education, Dr. Bondurant stated that there is a national decline in the number of students applying to enter medical schools. He further stated that West Virginia medical schools have lowered their admission standards to fill classes; but that North Carolina medical schools have not chosen to lower their admission standards.

He commented that he believes all medical schools will begin placing a greater emphasis on the humanistic aspects of medical practice, such as the field of ethics.

Dr. Patterson stated that he believes, if Deans of Medical Schools are aware of problems involving drug and alcohol abuse among physicians at their institutions, the Deans should notify the Board of Medical Examiners of these situations. Dr. Bondurant indicated that he agrees with this reporting concept.

The President of the Board emphasized that the Board of Medical Examiners appreciates suggestions from the Deans of North Carolina Medical Schools regarding topics for articles to be published in the North Carolina Medical Society Journal. On behalf of the Board of Medical Examiners, Dr. Alexander thanked Dr. Bondurant for attending this meeting.

PRESCRIBED LEARNING PROGRAM

Dr. Duckett presented a report on this program. He explained the Prescribed Learning Program at East Carolina University will be an extension of the continuing medical education process to be utilized for teaching and evaluation purposes.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the President of the Board draft a letter stating the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina supports this program, particularly in view of the fact that the Board of Medical Examiners finds it necessary from time to time to refer physicians not only for an evaluation of their medical knowledge, but also for remedial training; and that the President also state in this letter the Board often finds it beneficial to refer physicians for continuing medical education in various speciality areas to insure that these physicians have access to current information on methods and standards of medical practice.

DECEMBER 1989 MEETING

On August 6, 1988, the Board unanimously adopted a motion to hold the December 1989 meeting at the Embassy Suite in Raleigh.

JANUARY 1989 MEETING

On August 6, 1988, the Board unanimously adopted a motion that the Board of Medical Examiners consider holding the January 1989 meeting at the Embassy Suite in Raleigh.

AUGUST 1989 MEETING

On August 6, 1988, the Board unanimously adopted a motion to consider the dates for the August 1989 meeting as an agenda item for discussion at the next meeting.

CAROLINA WOMEN'S HEALTH CENTER, P.A.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board write a letter to Carolina OB-Gyn Centre, P.A., inquiring if this corporation intends to register; and that, if Carolina OB-Gyn Centre, P.A., does not plan to register, the Board will approve a corporation name change request from Sanford Clinic for Women, P.A., to Carolina Women's Health Center, P.A.

EAST CAROLINA CARDIOLOGY ASSOCIATES, P.A.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board deny the name change to East Carolina Cardiology Associates, P.A.

DE VILLA MEDICAL EYE CENTER, P.A.

On August 8, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board deny a corporation name change request from DeVilla Medical Eye Center, P.A. to The Eye Institute, P.A.

DATA REQUEST: JORDAN AND HICKS REALTY

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that this data request not be approved by the Board.

DATA REQUEST: HEALTHCARE REVIEW CORPORATION

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that this data request not be approved by the Board.

DATA REQUEST: HEINEMAN MEDICAL RESEARCH CENTER

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that this data request not be approved by the Board.

DATA REQUEST: NATIONAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS, INC.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Stratas that this data request not be approved by the Board.

MATTOS, SANDRA, M.D., Chapel Hill, North Carolina

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that when Dr. Mattos satisfactorily completes her resident's training application, the Board is prepared to issue a training license with the understanding that the faculty at the University of North Carolina may assign to this physician whatever duties they believe her qualified to perform.

CITIZENSHIP QUESTION

On August 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that a Board member, the Executive Secretary, a Board Subcommittee, or the full Board may accept a passport as meeting one of the licensure credentialing requirements.

CLINICAL CLERKSHIP REQUIREMENT FOR FULL LICENSURE

On August 5, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board hold an administrative hearing to change its regulations omitting current clinical clerkship requirements for physicians applying for full North Carolina medical licenses.

REINSTATEMENT PROCEDURES

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board require all applicants for reinstatement of licenses suspended for failure to register

who have been out-of-state for more than two years to follow the application procedures for license by endorsement: including submitting a new application, providing all required credentials, and appearing for a personal interview.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board may, on an individual basis, waive this reinstatement requirement.

NATIONAL BOARD OF OSTEOPATHIC EXAMINERS, INC.

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Alexander and seconded by Dr. Daniel that the Board set up a meeting between representatives of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina: Dr. Citron, Consultant; Dr. Alexander; and Dr. Duckett and representatives of the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners, Inc., to discuss the most recent version of the National Board of Osteopathic Examiners' Examination for Licensure; and that the date for this meeting be either in September 1988, October 1988, or at a mutually agreeable time in 1989.

SPEX FEE

On August 6, 1988, the Board of Medical Examiners unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Patterson and seconded by Dr. Henry that the Board require a physician who takes SPEX to do so at his or her expense.

OFFICERS FOR 88/89

On August 6, 1988, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson to elect Dr. Harold Godwin as President and Dr. Nicholas Stratas as Secretary for the year November 1, 1988, through October 31, 1989.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

On August 6, 1988, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board members review the proposed application questions and be prepared to discuss them at the October meeting.

MED-STAT MEDICAL DIRECTOR

On August 6, 1988, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Medical Director of MED-STAT be interviewed informally by the Board as soon as scheduling permits.

PRESCRIBING DISCREPANCIES

On August 7, 1988, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Duckett and seconded by Dr. Patterson that investigative reports regarding deficiencies in methods of prescribing (for example, writing several medications of different schedules on one prescription) be reported to Mr. Paris and that he write a letter to the physician with a copy to the Board of Pharmacy without bringing these cases to the Board's attention.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES REPORT

Dr. Daniel, the Board's Liaison Representative to the Office of Emergency Medical Services, presented the following report to the full Board:

On August 7, 1988, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 160 initial applications and 184 recertification applications for Advanced Life Support personnel submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services. The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Daniel and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board approve the 341 Bee Sting Certifications submitted by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

NURSE PRACTITIONER SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

On August 7, 1988, the Board unanimously adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin, Chairman of the Nurse Practitioner Subcommittee, and seconded by Dr. Patterson that the Board approve the recommendations of the Nurse Practitioner Subcommittee.
