

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS-WASHINGTON-DUKE HOTEL

DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA DECEMBER 10, 1940

The Board of Medical Examiners met in Durham, North Carolina, December 10, 1940, at the Washington-Duke Hotel.

Credentials of thirty-eight physicians were examined and they were granted licenses to practice medicine in North Carolina.

Dr. Jere B. Faison, a graduate of the University of Glasgow, Scotland, requested reciprocity. This matter was deferred for further investigation.

Several physicians were summoned before the Board. A man by the name of Fleming, of Williamston, North Carolina, was summoned before the Board for practicing medicine in North Carolina without a license. He left before he could be interviewed. The secretary of the Board wrote him to come to his office, to explain why he was practicing medicine in North Carolina without a license, and why he did not wait, December 10, at the Washington-Duke Hotel in Durham, after he was summoned to appear before the Board. He signed an affidavit in the office of the secretary of the Board of Medical Examiners, that he would not practice medicine in North Carolina.

Dr. Deane Hundley of Wallace, North Carolina, a graduate of Middlesex, Boston, Massachusetts, a grade B Medical school, was summoned before the Board to explain the method he used in order to get by the previous Board to take their examinations.

The Austrian physician, Dr. George R. Laub of New Bern, North Carolina, was told at the July meeting at Wrightsville Beach that he would be informed as to whether he could practice medicine in North Carolina. At the December meeting he was told not to practice medicine in this state.

At 7 P. M., December 10, Dr. and Mrs. William M. Coppridge delightfully entertained at their home and later at the Orange County Country Club, at dinner, the Board of Medical Examiners and invited guests: Dr. ~~Mc~~deB Mac Nider, professor of pharmacology at the University of North Carolina, Attorney Victor Bryant of Durham, and member of the state legislature, and Dr. Arthur H. London, pediatrician of Durham. This occasion was enjoyed by everyone present to the fullest.
