EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Stephen Herring, MD; Charles Garrett, MD; Robert Moffatt, MD; Arthur McCulloch, MD; Aloysius Walsh

The Executive Committee of the North Carolina Medical Board was called to order at 11:20 am, Wednesday December 17, 2003 at the offices of the Board. Present were: Stephen M. Herring, MD, Chair; Charles L. Garrett, MD; Harlan A. McCulloch, MD; Robert C. Moffatt, MD; and Aloysius P. Walsh. Members of the staff in attendance were R. David Henderson (Executive Director), and Peter T. Celentano, CPA (Comptroller).

Financials

Mr. Celentano, CPA, presented to the committee the October 2003 compiled financial statements. October is the last month of fiscal year 2003.

Dr. Garrett made a motion to accept the financial statements as reported. Dr. Moffatt seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

The October 2003 Investment Summary was reviewed and accepted as presented.

Old Business

401(k) Retirement Savings Plan: Mr. Celentano reviewed with the Committee the findings and opinion of Mr. Hugh Davis, an attorney with Poyner & Spruill, LLP, which states that the Medical Board is and has been eligible to maintain the North Carolina Medical Board Retirement Savings Plan for its employees. The other issue discussed was the practice of requiring contributions as a condition of employment. The Plan Document allows employees to make pre-tax "elective deferrals" of up to 15% of compensation. It is clear from the Internal Revenue Code Section 401(k)(2)(A) and Treasury Regulation 1.401(k)-1(a)(2)(i) that the contributions must be "elective" or voluntary in order to be treated as pre-tax 401(k) contributions. Therefore, effective January 1, 2004, all employees were made aware of this change and all employees are currently in the process of completing new election forms. The Medical Board is also in the process of finding a new broker to aid in administration of the plan.

Dr. Garrett made a motion to accept as information all matters discussed and for the Board to continue to make whatever changes are necessary so as to be in compliance with all applicable laws regarding our retirement plan. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Nurse Practitioner Rule Changes: Dr. McCulloch updated the Committee on various rule changes that have been drafted. The major items to be changed are the portability of title as a Nurse Practitioner and the change in term of a Temporary Approval from 18 months to 6 months.

Dr. Garrett made a motion that the Executive Committee recommend to the Board to adopt the Nurse Practitioner rule changes as drafted. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:50am.

CPP Rule Change – David Work, Board of Pharmacy Executive Director, and Betty Dennis, Board of Pharmacy Member, met with the Allied Health Committee to discuss the CPP rule change. Mr. Work explained how the additional words in the rule clarify that CPP's may prescribe controlled substances. The Allied Health Committee fully supports the changes in the CPP rules.

Pharmacist Proposed Rule for Administering Immunizations – The Allied Health Committee and the Board of Pharmacy representatives read through the proposed rule for pharmacists administering Immunizations. David Work distributed an article from the June 2002 Pharmacists Today regarding this issue. The Medical Board staff will make changes discussed at the meeting for review by the Allied Health Committee at the January meeting.

EMS Report – The EMS report was accepted as information. Dr. McCulloch spoke with Dr. Kanof about continuing to serve as the Medical Board's representative to the EMS Advisory Council, Disciplinary Committee and Compliance Committee. Dr. Kanof has accepted to continue to serve in this capacity.

Nurse Practitioner Proposed Rule Changes – A final draft of the proposed rule changes have been sent for review to all Medical Board members. A discussion by the full Board will be conducted at the Full Board meeting.
