The January 1994 meeting of the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners was held at the Board's office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, 27609. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., January 19, 1994 by John W. Nance, M.D., President. Board members in attendance were: John W. Nance, M.D., President; Harold L. Godwin, M.D., President Pro Tempore; Ernest B. Spangler, M.D., Secretary-Treasurer; Nicholas E. Stratas, M.D.; Mrs. Kathryn Willis; George C. Barrett, M.D. Charles Trado, M.D. and Mrs. Martha Walston Appointed Agents were also present in preparation for their anticipated appointment to the Board.

Minutes - November 1993 meeting

The first order of business was the adoption of the minutes from the November 1993 meeting of the Board. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Trado and seconded by Dr. Godwin to approve the minutes as presented. Dr. Stratas voted in opposition to the motion because he had not reviewed the document.

EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

Bryant D. Paris, Jr., Executive Secretary, reported that Melissa Hawkins Wilkerson, Investigative Secretary, accepted employment with a local law firm. Ms. Wilkerson left the Board's employment on November 30, 1993. Ann Goding assumed that position. Shirley Carroll, Receptionist was converted from temporary to permanent employment on January 1, 1994. It was also reported that the Board's staff had contributed \$290.00 to FIGS and donated a number of toys to needy children during the Christmas season.

Mr. Paris supplied for the Board's review minutes from the November 15, 1993 Directors' Meeting as well as a memorandum to the staff commending them on their performance during his recent illness.

Mr. Paris reported that on December 6, 1993 he attended a hearing in Wake County Superior Court regarding the confidentiality of Board records, on December 7-9, 1993 he administered the FLEX examination, and December 16, 1993 he conducted a rule hearing regarding amendments to 32B .0209, .0212, .0305, .0402 and .0706.

OPHTHALMOLOGY CODES

Mr. Paris reported that the Board received a packet of information from the Department of Medical Assistance on December 17, 1993 alerting the Board of additional some procedures for which Optometrists were approved for reimbursement. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Barrett and seconded by Dr. Godwin that Mr. Paris write the NC Medical Journal and the AMA News informing them that the above-referenced information was not received in the Board's office until December of 1993 and not in January 1991 as previously reported in their publications.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

The Administrative Committee met on January 19, 1994, at 2:30 p.m. Present were Dr. Spangler, Dr. Nance, Mrs. Willis, Mr. Paris and Ms. Meelheim. Dr. Roufail was absent.

The following issues were discussed and presented to the Board on January 22, 1994 for approval:

The position for a Complaint and Malpractice Secretary has been posted. The salary range is \$18,000 - \$19,000.

Education for Middle management will resume in February. Ms. Meelheim will contact the universities to determine if they are able to provide customized management training at the Board's office.

Insurance policies will be reviewed at the beginning of each fiscal year.

Two applicants have been interviewed for the In-House Attorney position. Plans have been made to advertise this position in the Lawyer's Weekly. A job description for the position was presented with the Board materials.

The staff has discussed preparing a list of physician consultants with the Medical Society. A motion was made by Dr. Spangler and seconded by Dr. Johnson to write Medical Boards in South Carolina, Virginia Tennessee and Georgia to determine how they use and obtain medical and management consultants. Also Dr. Stratas will supply 2 or 3 names of companies to whom request for management proposals will be sent.

Employee evaluations were discussed. Questions were raised regarding who reviews the evaluations done for the Administration. A motion was made by Dr. Barrett and seconded by Dr. Stratas that an evaluation committee be formed composed of the President of the Board and two other members with the longest time on the Board.

A motion was made by Dr. Spangler and seconded by Dr. Godwin to prioritize the Boards desires regarding a registration fee increase. In the Board's approach to the Legislature its first priority is to have a bill passed allowing for re-registration of every odd-numbered year in the amount of \$200.00. As a second option the Board would like a bill to be passed requiring re-registration every year of \$100.

It was reported that a new contract to cover staff has been signed with Carolina Physicians Health Plan for an additional 12 months. Under the new contract the benefits are improved and the cost of individual and family coverage increased by only \$4.00 per pay period.

It was reported that a workers compensation audit was performed by First of Georgia and an additional bill of \$800 was sent to the Board.

Employee changes were reported as follows: Pearlina Dowling continues to work as a temporary part-time employee, however she is working directly for the Board rather than through a temporary agency. Betty Byrd also continues to work on a temporary part-time basis.

Building renovations intended to increase the work space in an effort to better accommodate the additional members added to the Board were discussed. A motion was made by Dr. Spangler and seconded by Dr. Johnson to authorize the staff to spend \$2,000 after obtaining two estimates.

It was reported that employee safety and security is being maintained through access control by keeping the back entrances to the office locked at all times. Access to the office may only be obtained through the front entrance with clearance by the receptionist. Entry through the back entrance is done by key.

A request was made that consideration be given to the purchase of another small copier to be used while efforts are made to decide the future of the larger copier now owned by the Board.

It was reported that the accounting software package is working. Scanning of the registration applications has worked. To date all registration applications have been scanned, imported and posted to the physicians accounts. All certificates should be mailed by the end of the month. A new calendar package has been installed and classes will be held on January 26, 1994 to train all staff.

It has been determined that more disk space is need. The cost is \$1200 plus labor. CS&S has provided excellent support in the past. The Administrative committee recommended that Dr. Spangler write a letter of commendation to CS&S expressing the Board's satisfaction with the services rendered.

A financial statement for the month of December was distributed for review. It was reported the Board is within budget.

A chart documenting expenses incurred for the Board's automobiles during fiscal year 1993 was distributed for the Board's review. It was recommended that a more detailed mileage chart and maintenance schedule be developed. Ms. Meelheim developed a chart and it was also presented for the Board's review. The Administrative committee recommended that the Board investigate the possibility of leasing cars.

A letter inviting qualified independent financial auditors to submit proposals for an annual financial audit of fiscal year 1993 was distributed for review. The letter of invitation was written to include a more extensive management letter.

It was reported that approximately 80% of physicians licensed in North Carolina have registered. The entire staff has been involved in this process. The Committee made a motion to print a report of information obtained during this registration process. This report is to include correspondence and phone call logs maintained in each physician's computer file.

Don Pittman, Director of Investigations recommended that the Board not consider hiring a Physician Extender Investigator at this time. The supporting facts in his recommendation were that the cost would be out of line with the current investigative staff salaries and that the hiring of such a person might cause internal problems. The Administrative committee adopted a motion to accept Mr. Pittman's recommendation.

As a result of licensing difficulties incurred with the Graduate Medical Training License during the Spring of 1993, the decision was made to revise the Resident Training Application. After many meetings and recommendations from various sources an application package was developed. The package has been sent to the printer.

The new rosters for currently registered physicians will be in loose-leaf form this year. The Board's cost is estimated at \$11.00 per roster. The purchase price will remain at \$25.00. It was also recommended that this loose-leaf binder could serve as a depository for other materials the Board may send out during the year.

With the anticipated arrival of 4 new Board members, a lengthy discussion was held regarding the orientation process. It was determined that it is the responsibility of new Board members of review the orientation manual. The Board suggests that new members come to one to three meetings before the end of the fiscal year. A walk through mock meeting was recommended to familiarize new members with the process. It was also recommended that staff members are to be assigned to new Board members to guide them through the meeting. The Administrative committee recommended that this is the responsibility of the staff.

The Board adopted the recommendations of the Administrative Committee.

MEETING SCHEDULE

A schedule for 1994 meeting and a proposed schedule for 1995 meetings was presented for the Board's review. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Johnson to hold the March 1994 meeting at the Board's office and for accommodations to be at the Comfort Suites. Later in the meeting, it was determined that the location of the Comfort Suites was not suitable and the Board voted to obtain accommodations at the North Raleigh Hilton.

OPTOMETRIC CPT CODES APPROVED BY DMA

Dr. Nance appointed a committee of Martha Walston, Dr. Trado and Dr. Johnson to review the CPT Codes line by line which had been approved by DMA in order to reimburse optometrists.

After legal review and input from diverse medical specialists, the above committee of the Board recommended adoption of a declaratory ruling. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Johnson and seconded by Dr. Godwin that the Board adopt the declaratory ruling drafted by counsel regarding the recently expanded Optometric CPT Codes. All members present voted for the motion.

BAR RULING ON SETTLEMENTS OF ALLEGATIONS INVOLVING SEX

Mike Weddington reported that the North Carolina State Bar Ethics Committee has reversed its previous ruling. Initially, the published proposed ethics ruling stated that it was unethical for lawyers to participate in settlements of cases involving sexual misconduct against physicians whereby the sexual misconduct would not be reported to the appropriate licensing agency. The committee then reversed its decision indicating this to be ethical. After which there was another outcry of comments. Basically, the Ethics committee has reversed their decision again and has submitted it to the State Bar Council for adoption.

MEETING WITH MEDICAL SOCIETY REPRESENTATIVES

It was reported that a meeting was held on December 14, 1993 with the Medical Society. Attending the meeting were Elizabeth Kanof, MD, Don Wall, Bryant D. Paris, Jr., Diane Meelheim, Thad Wester, MD, John Nance, MD and Bill Breeze.

As a result of this meeting, the Board discussed the possibility of requesting the Legislature to identify the data which must be supplied for registration purposes. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Johnson to table any further discussion regarding this issue until the Data Base Task Force meets on March 4, 1994.

FEDERATION MEETING - NOMINATION OF BOARD MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE

The Federation meeting will be held in Washington, DC, April 28-30, 1994. It was reported that Dr. Barrett will be a teller during this meeting. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Godwin and seconded by Dr. Stratas to nominate Dr. Spangler as a representative of the Board for this meeting. The Board also adopted a motion made by Dr. Spangler and seconded by Dr. Barrett that the Board will fund Dr. Stratas' trip to the meeting. Dr. Spangler, as the official representative will have his fees paid by the Federation.

RULE HEARING - SUBCHAPTER 32B - LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE

Mr. Paris reported that a public rule hearing was held on December 16, 1993 at 9:00 am at the Board's office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, North Carolina in order to accept public comment on proposed rules as advertised in the NC REGISTER to be effective April 1, 1994. No one attended to make comments. One letter was received from Harvey Estes, M.D., regarding Rule 32B .0305 EXAMINATION BASIS FOR ENDORSEMENT. The rule was discussed and Mr. Paris pointed out that Dr. Estes' letter dealt with section (b) of Rule .0305 which was not proposed for amendment at this time. Dr. Estes' proposal should be submitted as a separate request for a new rule hearing.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Johnson to adopt the publish proposed rules and pursue more information regarding Dr. Estes' suggestion. Dr. Nance suggested that the Board review and evaluate the whole osteopathic family practice certification examination process. Mr. Paris will inform Dr. Estes of the Board's decision.

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Spangler and seconded by Dr. Stratas to adopt the following rule amendments as proposed to become effective April 1, 1994:

.0209 EXAMINATION FEE

(a) FLEX fee

- (1) The fee for both components of the FLEX written examination taken together is two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), plus the cost of test materials, due at the time of application.
- (2) If the two FLEX components are taken separately, the fee for

each component is due at the time of application for that component as follows:

- (A) for the first component, two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) plus the cost of test materials;
- (B) for the second component, one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) plus the cost of test materials.
- (b) USMLE fee - The fee for USMLE is ~~two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)~~ four hundred dollars (\$400.00), plus the cost of test materials, due at the time of the application.
- (c) Fees are non-refundable.

.0212 EXAMINATION TIMES AND LOCATION

~~The Board holds Two licensing examinations are held each year, one in June and one in December, in Raleigh, North Carolina.~~

.0305 EXAMINATION BASIS FOR ENDORSEMENT

- (a) To be eligible for license by endorsement of credentials, graduates of medical schools approved by the LCME or AOA must supply certification of passing scores on one of the following examinations:
 - (1) National Board of Medical Examiners;
 - (2) FLEX - under Rule .0314 of this Section;
 - (3) Written examination administered by an allopathic or composite state medical board which issued the original license on the basis of written examination other than FLEX from the state board which issued the original license by written examination;
 - (4) National Board of Osteopathic Examiners, all parts taken after January 1, 1990; or
 - (5) USMLE - Step 1, Step 2, Step 3 of USMLE or a combination of examinations as set out in Rule .0215 of this Subchapter.
- (b) Graduates of medical schools not approved by LCME or AOA must supply certification of passing scores on one of the following written examinations:
 - (1) FLEX - under Rule .0314 of this Section;
 - (2) Written examination other than FLEX from the state board which issued the applicant's original license by written examination together with American Specialty Board certification; or
 - (3) USMLE - Step 1, Step 2, Step 3 of the USMLE or a combination of examinations as set out in Rule .0215 of this Subchapter.
- (c) A physician who has a valid and unrestricted license to practice medicine in another state, based on a written examination testing general medical knowledge, and who within the past five years has become, and is at the time of application, certified or recertified by an American Specialty Board, is eligible for license by endorsement.
- (d) Applicants for license by endorsement of credentials with FLEX scores that do not meet the requirements of Rule .0314 of this Section must meet the requirements of Paragraph (c) in this Rule.

.0402 TEMPORARY LICENSE FEE

A fee of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) is due at the time of application. This fee is not applicable to full licensure and is not refundable.

.0706 FEE FOR VISITING PROFESSORS CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION

A fee of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) is due at the time of application. No portion of the fee is refundable.

PHP COMMITTEE REPORT

The PHP Committee chaired by Dr. Godwin and including Mrs. Walston and Dr. Trado met and reviewed cases in conjunction with Dr. Vanderberry. A written report of 27 cases was presented to the Board for review. The Board adopted the Committee's recommendation to approve the written report. The specifics of this report are not included as these actions are not public.

COMPLAINTS

The Complaint Committee chaired by Dr. Barrett and including Dr. Johnson and Mrs. Walston reported on 25 complaint cases. A written report was presented for the Board's review. After some discussion the Board adopted the Committee's recommendation to approve the report. The specifics of this report are not included as these action are not public information.

MALPRACTICE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Malpractice Committee chaired by Dr. Barrett and including Dr. Spangler and Dr. Trado reported on 47 malpractice cases. A written report was presented for the Board's review. The Board adopted the Committee's recommendation to approve the written report. The specifics of this report are not included as these actions are not public information.

EMS REPORT

In October 1993 the certification period for all advanced life support personnel was extended by two years. Additionally, the Office of EMS reported that it is implementing a revised certification system. As a result of these circumstances no certifications or recertifications were reported since the last meeting of the Board.

It was reported that 130 applications for epinephrine certificates were processed since the November 1993 meeting of the Board. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Johnson and seconded by Dr. Stratas as accept this as information.

FIRE AND RESCUE COMMISSION

It was reported that the North Carolina State Fire & Rescue Commission is circulating a letter indicating that there has been a request by the Attorney General's office regarding regulation of automatic defibrillators use by First Responders in North Carolina and also regulation by the Fire and Rescue Commission. The request is that the Fire & Rescue Commission certify fire and rescue personnel as first responders. They would then not need to be certified by the Office of EMS. This discussion will be continued at the next meeting.

SULLIVAN, John L., III, M.D., Indiana

In July 1991, September 1991 and November 1991 Dr. Sullivan requested that records from charges preferred against him in April 1985 and dismissed June 24, 1985 be expunged. The Board denied all requests. Dr. Sullivan appealed to the Wake County Superior Court in July 1992. In September 1992 the Court upheld the Board's decision not to expunge the records. In September 1993 the case was heard in the NC Court of Appeals. On December 7, 1993, the NC Court of Appeals reversed the decision of the Superior Court and directed that this case be remanded to the Board with instructions to give Dr. Sullivan a hearing. The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Johnson and seconded by Dr. Godwin to approve Dr. Sullivan's request and expunge the record on the strength of this decision. Dr. Godwin, Dr. Johnson and Dr. Spangler voted for the motion. Dr. Stratas and Dr. Barrett voted in opposition of the motion. Motion carried.

CREECH, Phillip Hugh, M.D., LA

On January 20, 1994, a Public Hearing was held regarding a Notice of Charges and Allegations dated October 8, 1992, which stated that Dr. Creech's license to practice medicine in Louisiana was revoked based on evidence that Dr. Creech engaged in a course of conduct of prescribing, dispensing or administering habit forming or other legally controlled substances in a manner other than legal and legitimate. Professional and medical incompetency and continuing or recurring medical practices which failed to satisfy the standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice.

As a result of the hearing, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Godwin to revoke Dr. Creech's medical license.

EMERSON, Timothy Joe, M.D., TX

On January 20, 1994, a Public Hearing was held regarding the Notice of Charges and Allegations dated October 8, 1992, which stated that the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ordered that Dr. Emerson's medical license be suspended indefinitely based on the findings that he engaged in contact of a sexual nature with a female child younger than 14 year old and intentionally or knowingly engaged in the sexual assault of a female child younger than 17.

As a result of the hearing, the Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Mrs. Willis to revoke Dr. Emerson's medical license.

MEDICAL MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY - George Harvey

On January 20, 1994, Mr. Harvey, representative from Medical Mutual Insurance Company, attended the Board's meeting to review the Directors and Officers policy and to update the Board members on their coverage and their responsibilities as Board members regarding confidentiality.

Mr. Harvey reviewed the policy with the present Board members and left a Error & Omission brochure with each Board member. He reported that the policy covers mistakes however, does not cover slander or liable. Mr. Harvey stressed that education and orientation of all new members is very important. Mr. Harvey highly recommended that a confidentiality statement be considered for employees to sign. He reminded Board members that information discussed during the meetings is confidential and should not be discussed outside the meetings. Mr. Harvey recommended that each Board member evaluate their personal coverage.

CONFIDENTIALITY - Statute

The Board adopted a motion made by Dr. Stratas and seconded by Dr. Johnson requesting the staff look at the statute regarding investigation confidentiality and bring back a proposal of ways to reword the statute to strengthen it.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

An Executive Session was held on Saturday afternoon. The following actions were taken as a result of this meeting. 1. A direct communication with possible management consultants for the Board with Dr. Spangler, Dr. Barrett and Dr. Nance who comprise a committee of the Board in order to pursue and study implementation a management consultant. 2. Dr. Spangler instructed Ms. Meelheim to contact MMIC and have a consultant, Steve Joyner, evaluate the Board's network system. This consultant is to make recommendations on what is lacking, where the Board stands and what it may need with regard to the computers.

SELF ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT

The Board reviewed the recommendations and comments to the Written Policies & Procedures Section of the SAI, which resulted from weekly Directors meetings.

The Federation will review the findings and probably make a report at the Federation meeting. They will divide the findings into three categories - small, medium and large Boards. The next section of the SAI is to be presented at the next meeting.
