

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS
OF NORTH CAROLINA

Atlantic Hotel, Morehead City, North Carolina
July 27th-29th, 1945.

The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met at the Atlantic Hotel, Morehead City, North Carolina, July 27th-29th, 1945.

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Charles W. Armstrong, president. Drs. M. D. Bonner, Thomas Leslie Lee, Roy McKnight, Paul G. Parker, M. A. Pittman, and Ivan Procter were present.

The grades of all examinees were reviewed by the board. Only one examinee failed to make a passing grade: Joseph H. Robinson, Jr. #111. The secretary was instructed to give the associated press the names of the two highest examinees taking the four year examination, as well as all of the examinees who passed.


The matter of Dr. Charles Ross Deeds' license by reciprocity was considered. After much discussion on two points Dr. Deeds was granted a license, five votes in the affirmative, two in the negative. The discussion centered around the advisability of granting license to a physician from a B grade medical school but when the matter of the personal qualifications, record, and attainments of the applicant were considered the board felt that he was entitled to license in North Carolina.

The date of the next meeting of the board was set for December 29th, 1945, in Raleigh, N.C., at the Sir Walter Hotel.

Dr. Roy McKnight reported on the case of Dr. Vandonselear's alleged practising medicine without a license. Dr. McKnight was asked to investigate this case in the regular manner and report the same to the Board of Medical Examiners.

The meeting was adjourned.
