

MEETING OF BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF NORTH CAROLINA SIR WALTER HOTEL-JUNE 16-20 1941 RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA

Dr. Frank A. Sharpe called the meeting of the Board of Medical Examiners to order at 9:00 0'clock, Monday morning June 16 in the Sir Walter Hotel, Raleigh, North Carolina. Dr. Lewis W. Elias opened the meeting with prayer. Doctors William M. Coppridge, J. Street Brewer, Lester A. Crowell, Jr., Frank A. Sharpe, Lewis W. Elias, Karl B. Pace and W. D. James were present.

Dr. K. B. Moore was summoned before the board, upon the advice of the Bureau of Narcotics to explain his imfraction of the narcotic laws. It was thoroughly discussed and decided that he should report to the Board at each annual meeting in June.

Dr. Joseph D. Hough appeared before the board to obtain a North Carolina license by reciprocity. This was not granted; he is a graduate of a foreign school.

Dr. Paul Kimmelsteil also appeared before the board at this time requesting reciprocity with Virginia. The board of Medical Examiners heard the Mecklenburg delegation in behalf of Dr. Paul Kimmelsteil. Reciprocity was not granted; he is a graduate of a foreign medical school.

Miss Hunter R. N., who is confining her work to electrolysis was advised she could do this type of work if sponsored by a local physician.

Credentials of 40 physicians were examined and they were granted license to practice medicine in North Carolina.

At 2:00 0 clock $P \cdot M \cdot$ on June 16, 108 students were registered for the examination. Fifty-six took the first half of the examinations and fifty-four took either the last half or all four.
