

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF THE STATE OF NORTH
CAROLINA IN RALEIGH at the SIR WALTER HOTEL - JUNE 19 - 23, 1939

The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina met June 19 - 23, 1939 in the Sir Walter Hotel in Raleigh, N. C. for the endorsement of credentials and examinations. The meeting was called to order by the president, Dr. Lewis W. Elias. All the members were present. Dr. Lewis W. Elias, Dr. W. D. James, Dr. Karl B. Pace, Dr. Frank A. Sharpe, Dr. William M. Coppridge, Dr. J. Street Brewer, and Dr. Lester A. Crowell, Jr. After the treasurer's report and the minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, Dr. Karl B. Pace was unanimously elected president of the Board for the ensuing year.

The following twenty-nine candidates were passed upon by the Board of Medical Examiners to practice medicine and surgery in North Carolina through the endorsement of their credentials and were to receive licenses.
