Approval Process for MICN Programs

The Board adopted a motion that it reaffirm its previous action; that it continue to delegate approval of MICN programs to the Office of EMS; that a proposal to revise the approval process be referred to the Office of EMS with a letter indicating that this office may, at its discretion, discuss this proposal with consultants. The Board also adopted a motion that the Office of Emergency Medical Services be requested to report to the Board in August, 1984, concerning how the proposal differs from the current MICN educational requirements. The Board of Medical Examiners adopted a further motion that the Board of Nursing be informed the North Carolina Board of Medical Examiners has once again considered the process of reviewing and approving MICN educational programs and has reaffirmed its previous action that this process continue to be delegated to the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

Report on Revisions to the Approved Formulary Accepted by the Board as Information

The Executive Secretary reported that the Joint Subcommittee recommended rewording of certain existing statements in the "Formulary" for clarification purposes.

Statement on Anorectics and Other Prescribing Problems


