Minutes of the Open Sessions of the North Carolina Medical Board Meeting June 20, 2007.

The June 20, 2007, meeting of the North Carolina Medical Board was held at the Board's Office, 1203 Front Street, Raleigh, NC 27609. MISCELLANEOUS

Presidential Remarks

Dr. McCulloch commenced the meeting by reading from Governor Easley's Executive Order No. 1, the "ethics awareness and conflict of interest reminder." No conflicts were reported.

Dr. McCulloch noted that Ms. Bazan-Manson has announced her intentions to resign her seat on the Medical Board in the near future due to scheduling conflicts.

Dr. Rhyne announced that she has been appointed to the Governor's quality initiative group which will be looking at ways to measure quality of care. She will provide additional information once the Governor officially announced this project.

FSMB Emergency Preparedness Workgroup

As a medical board representative on the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) Emergency Preparedness workgroup, Dr. Rhyne reported that this group had their first meeting June 13-14 in Dallas. The workgroup is charged with developing tools for medical boards regarding best practices in disaster planning and facilitating license portability in the event of a public health emergency, natural disaster or acts of terrorism.

The group reviewed emergency preparedness plans developed by state medical boards, existing model legislation and the <u>Uniform Emergency Volunteer Healthcare Practitioners</u> <u>Act</u>, a new model uniform law addressing the issue of states allowing out-of-state medical professionals to practice in afflicted areas. The group also discussed how medical boards could help complete the FSMB's collaborative initiative with the Centers for Disease Control to develop a database of physician emergency contact information. In this regard, she referred a sample "data use agreement" to the Board for review in anticipation of being asked to provide North Carolina physician emergency contact information.

The group is comprised of eight medical board representatives from around the country and representatives from the Centers for Disease Control, the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy and the Oklahoma State Department of Health.

North Carolina Medical Society (NCMS) Leadership College Advocacy Day

Board Members introduced themselves to the NCMS 2007 Leadership College Scholars. Mr. Henderson summarized that the purpose of the NCMS Leadership College is to provide both orientation and skill development to North Carolina's future medical leaders. There are generally 15-18 participants yearly. Today's portion of that initiative is in conjunction with their Legislative Advocacy Day and Headquarters Tour in Raleigh. Today they will meet with NCMS and NCMS Foundation Staff at the NCMS headquarters, visit the N.C. General Assembly, and visit with the Medical Board to learn more about what we do.

Mauskar, Anant, MD – Houston, TX

Out of State – Texas

On June 2, 2006, the Texas Board and MD entered into an agreed order suspending his license indefinitely, staying the suspension and placing him on probation under

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numerous terms and conditions. The action was based on MD's conviction in Federal Court of conspiracy to commit health care fraud and of health care fraud, which conviction is now on appeal.
