

MILITARY RELOCATION (SCRA) LICENSURE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

You are eligible for a physician assistant military relocation license (SCRA) if you meet all of the following qualifications:

- Currently hold a full, unrestricted, and active license in good standing in at least one other state, the District of Columbia, a U.S. Territory, or Canadian province.
- A license in good standing is a license that (1) has not had discipline imposed by any occupational licensing board in the last five years, (2) has not been voluntarily surrendered while under investigation for unprofessional conduct in any State, and (3) has no pending investigations for unprofessional conduct by any occupational licensing board.
- Currently a servicemember of the United States Armed Forces or a spouse of a servicemember of the United States Armed Forces.
- Have military orders or been notified of military orders for military service in North Carolina for the applicant or the applicant's spouse.
- Submit to a criminal history background check.

Please note:

- 1) A military relocation license becomes inactive at the time the license holder relocates pursuant to military orders to reside in another state, when the military orders for military services in this State expire, or when the servicemember separates from military service.
- 2) Any change in eligibility for the Military Relocation License, such as a change in military orders to another state, must be reported to the Board within 15 days.
