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21 NCAC 32N .0114 is proposed for adoption as follows:

21 NCAC 32N .0114 SUMMARY SUSPENSION

- 5 (a) If the Board finds that the public health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action, it may, pursuant to
- 6 <u>G.S. 150B-3(c)</u>, summarily suspend a license without a hearing or opportunity for the licensee to be heard.
- 7 (b) A motion to summarily suspend a license pursuant to this Rule shall be supported by competent evidence of
- 8 the facts alleged requiring emergency action.
- 9 (c) The Board shall consult with independent counsel prior to issuing an order of summary suspension. The
- 10 role of independent counsel shall be to advise the Board on the reliability and competency of the evidence presented
- 11 <u>in support of the motion for summary suspension.</u>
- 12 (d) An order of summary suspension shall make preliminary findings of facts indicating why the public health,
- 13 safety, or welfare requires emergency action. An order of summary suspension shall be accompanied by a notice of
- 14 charges setting out the licensee's alleged violations of G.S. 90-14(a). Upon service of the order of summary
- 15 suspension, the licensee to whom the order is directed shall immediately cease practicing in North Carolina.
- 16 (e) The Board shall, when it summarily suspends a license, schedule a hearing to occur at the earliest
- 17 practicable date, but no later than 30 days from the date of service of the order of summary suspension. The purpose
- 18 of the hearing will be to determine whether there is a preponderance of competent evidence supporting the order of
- 19 summary suspension. A hearing on the order of summary suspension may be combined with a hearing on the merits
- 20 of the notice of charges on a date mutually agreed upon by the parties.
- 21 (f) The order of summary suspension shall remain in effect until the Board vacates it.
- 22 (g) Neither an order of summary suspension nor a decision upholding an order of summary suspension is a
- 23 <u>final agency decision.</u>
