7	(1) falls within the top one two percent of those prescribing 100 morphine milligrams of morphin
8	equivalents ("MME") per patient per day; or
9	(2) falls within the top one two percent of those prescribing 100 MME's per patient per day i
10	combination with any benzodiazepine and who are within the top one percent of all controlle
11	substance prescribers by volume.
12	(b) In addition, the Department may report to the Board information regarding prescribers who have had two or
13	more patient deaths in the preceding twelve months due to opioid poisoning. poisoning where the prescriber
14	authorized more than 30 tablets of an opioid to the decedent and the prescriptions were written within 60 days of the
15	patient deaths.
16	(c) The Department may submit these reports to the Board upon request and may include the information describe
17	in G.S. 90-113.73(b).
18	(d) The reports and communications between the Department and the Board shall remain confidential pursuant t
19	G.S. 90-16 and G.S. 90-113.74.
